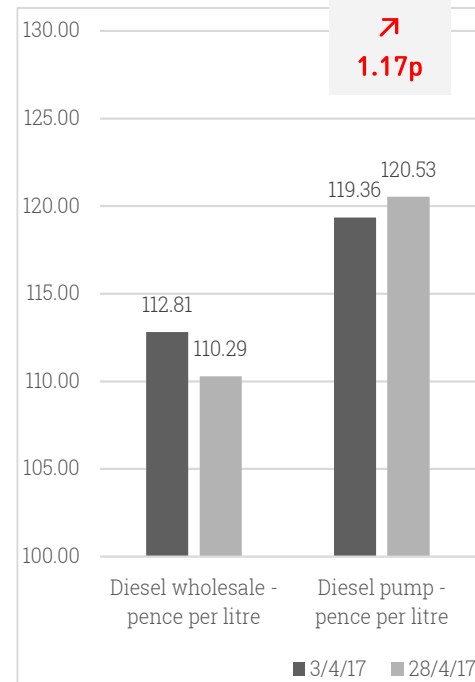
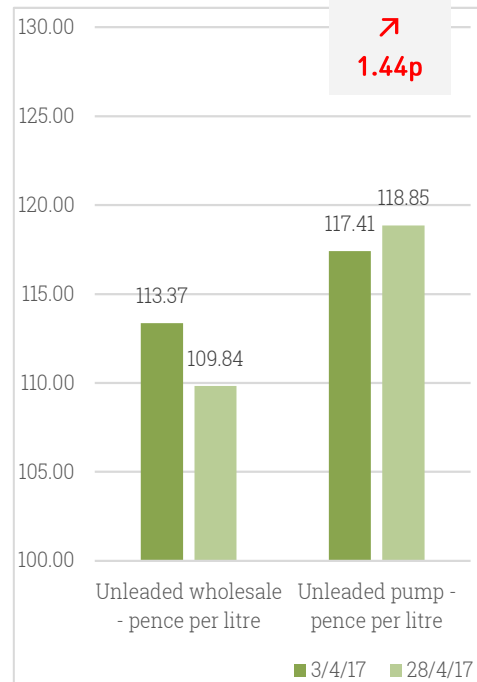
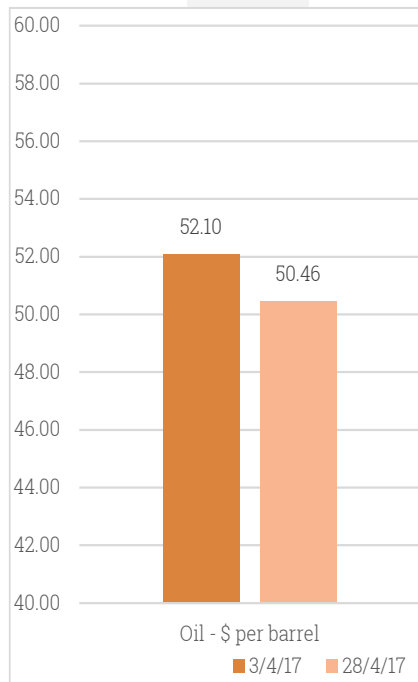


UK fuel prices report

Petrol and diesel price changes in April 2017



Our view on prices

"April wasn't a good month for fuel prices but motorists have every right to expect an early May petrol and diesel cut from retailers of 2p a litre at the very least.

"Accurately predicting what is going to happen with fuel prices in the next month is as difficult as long range weather forecasting. That said, we know a cut is overdue and beyond that it is widely reported that there is still a glut of oil despite the Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries and some non-OPEC partners deciding to reduce their output.

"From the UK motorist's perspective we need oil to remain in oversupply and the pound to stay the same or get stronger against the dollar to avoid fuel prices creeping up in the coming weeks and months."
