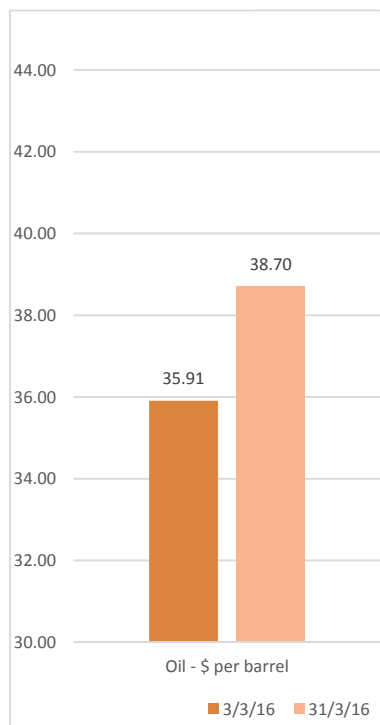
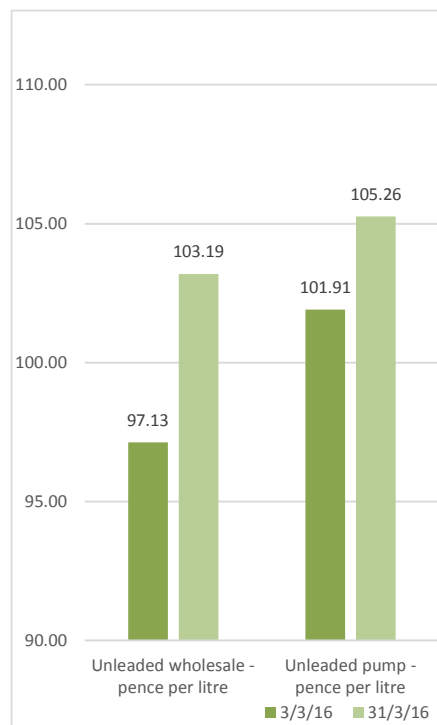


## UK fuel prices in March 2016



### Crude oil

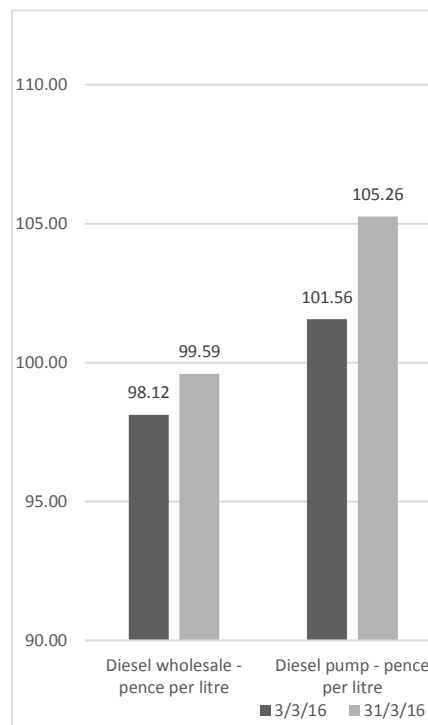
Price of a barrel of oil **rose**
