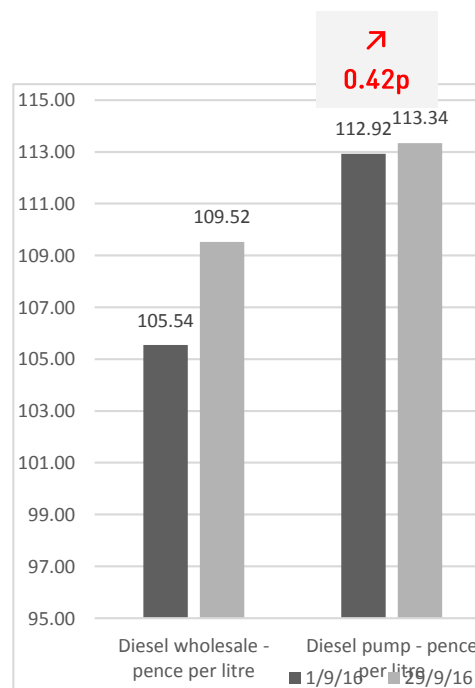
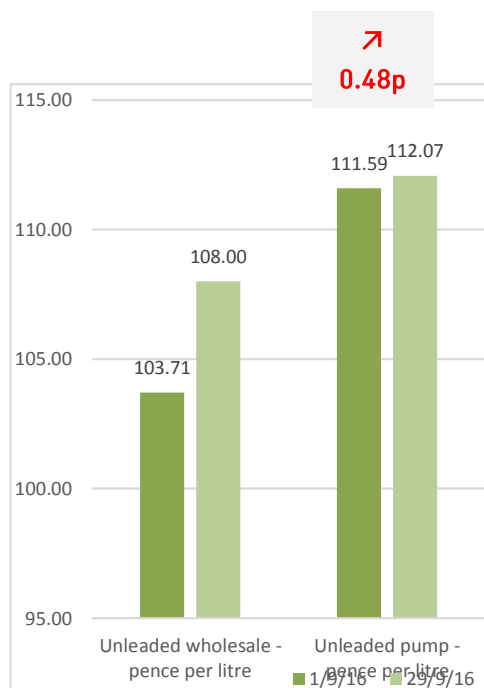
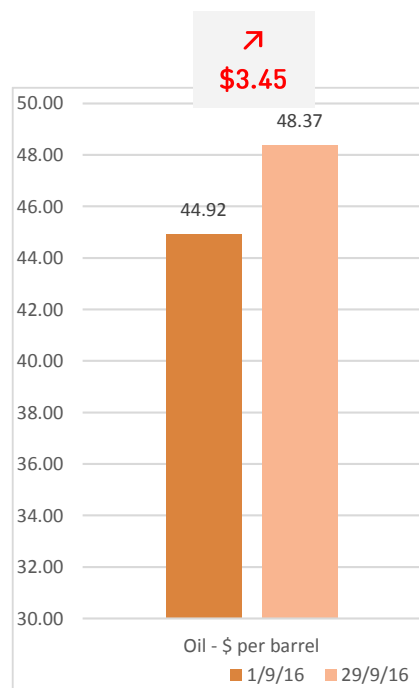


## UK fuel prices in September 2016



### Two week price predictor

from 1 October 2016

→ Unleaded — little change expected

→ Diesel — little change expected

### Our view on prices

"A higher oil price, combined with a weakening pound, is forcing up wholesale fuel prices.

"The wholesale price of diesel is now nearly 9p higher than it was at the start of August, and petrol 7.4p higher. The effect of this to date has been gradually rising pump prices.

"While we don't envisage an immediate hike in prices in October, a lot depends on how markets react to the recent OPEC production cut announcement."

### Unleaded

Wholesale price **rose 4.29p to**  
**108p** per litre  
  
Pump price **rose 0.48p to**  
**112.07p** per litre

### Diesel

Wholesale price **rose 3.98p to**  
**109.52p** per litre  
  
Pump price **rose 0.42p to**  
**113.34p** per litre

Tax currently makes up **69%** of the  
price of a litre of unleaded or diesel

Current tax: fuel duty (57.95ppl) and VAT at 20%
