



Price of a barrel of oil fell \$1.59 to \$54.26

Wholesale price fell 1p to
113.01p per litre

Pump price rose 0.18p to
120.23p per litre

#### Diesel

Wholesale price fell 0.02p to
114.73p per litre

Pump price fell 0.06p to
122.25p per litre

#### Our view on prices

"The agreement between OPEC and non-member countries seems to be holding firm for the time being which is not good news for motorists. For prices at the pumps to come down again we would need the oil price to reduce and the pound to make up some of its lost ground on the dollar.

"Given the global oil production situation and a weaker pound all we can really hope for at the moment is some continued price stability."
