

Uplace Machelen: facts and figures

What: a world of experiences under one roof, bringing together in one place what people like to do in their free time, setting in motion the reconversion of the Canal Zone.

Surface area: 190,000 m² of experience

- **PUBLIC AREA**: roof gardens, plazas, streets, squares
- RELAXATION:
 - opportunities for active sports and relaxation, amusements for children, fitness and wellness facilities
 - o 10-screen cinema
 - 3,000-seat theatre
- 50 BARS and RESTAURANTS serving cuisine from all over the world and sky bar in the tower
- **OFFICE SPACE**: in the landmark tower and throughout the rest of the project
- Open **RETAIL shopping street**:
 - 300 on-trend brands, concept stores and new brands that are not yet present on the Belgian market
- HOTEL: international trendy, lifestyle hotel with 180 rooms

Activities: management by own intendants' team

- Traditional seasonal activities
- Product launches
- Themed events
- Large and small concerts, classical and modern
- Temporary exhibitions

Architecture: an authentic 'town within a town' designed by Benoy

- **Benoy:** internationally renowned firm of architects with offices in London and Newark (UK), Hong Kong, Shanghai and Abu Dhabi
- Architecture that refers to the rich industrial past of the region, with a strong emphasis on local authenticity. A 'town within a town' feeling is created by the various neighbourhoods, squares, streets and open spaces. The facilities on offer are clustered by life phases: teenagers, young professionals, families and active senior citizens. A great deal of attention is being paid to environmentally friendly building and green management.

Where:

- **11-hectare site in Machelen**, next to the Vilvoorde viaduct on the Brussels ring road.
- Southern part of the 'Machelen-Vilvoorde industrial zone' reconversion area.



Mobility: perfectly connected and accessible

- Central location for the whole of Belgium
- Entry and exit on the Brussels ring road in the immediate vicinity
- Extensive parking facilities (6,000 places)
- A **GEN station** (*Gewestelijk Expresnet* regional express network) is being built 150 m away. The centre of Brussels can therefore be reached in just 10 minutes.
- **Various bus routes**, including a shuttle bus along the project that goes to and from Vilvoorde station and Zaventem Airport.
- Tram connection between Jette and Zaventem, with a stop right in front of Uplace
- The creation of **new cycling infrastructure** (for which permits were granted) to and along our project and a large, secure bicycle shed as part of the project encourages bicycle use as much as possible.

With respect for the environment: zero-emissions target project

- WATER:
 - 6,600 m³ buffer basin, the size of 12 swimming pools, recovers rain water to meet over 50 % of the water consumption needs (± 25 million litres a year).
- GREEN ROOFS as public space, approximately 6,000 m² (a football pitch).
- ENERGY:
 - Heat pumps and use of the latest techniques to reduce CO² emissions
 - Maximum use of natural light brings energy savings of 2.4 million kWh/year or the consumption of 685 families
 - Maximum use of LED lighting (less consumption and less waste) plus presence detection and naturalillumination.
- WASTE: maximum waste sorting (paper, cardboard, glass, etc.) => over 30 % reduction in residual waste.
- TRANSPORT: maximum use of transport via rail and water.
