Meticulous craftsmanship. Classic and contemporary designs. Tiffany & Co. has spent 160 years of its nearly two-century history designing and handcrafting some of the world's most revered sports trophies at its hollowware workshop in Rhode Island.

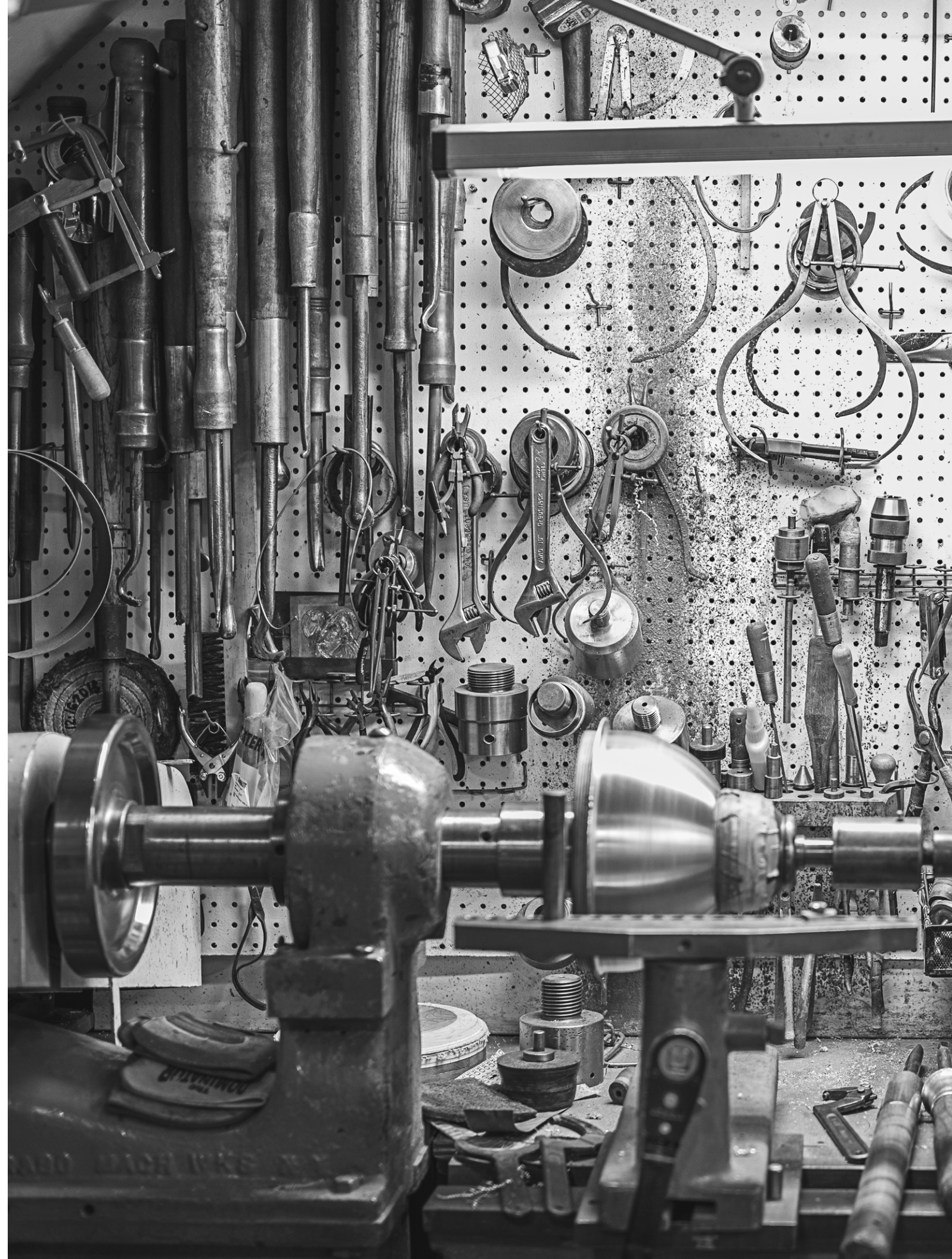


Hollowware: A Solid Legacy

In 1851, Charles Lewis Tiffany entered an exclusive partnership with prominent silversmith, John C. Moore, to manufacture silver hollowware. Around this time, the U.S. adopted the jeweler's standard for silver—925 parts per 1,000—enhancing Tiffany's growing reputation for excellence. Upon opening his hollowware workshop in Manhattan, Mr. Tiffany commissioned silversmiths or "Tiffany Makers" to handcraft trophies, beginning with the Woodlawn Vase in 1860.

While the workshop has moved from Newark and Parsippany, New Jersey to its current location in Cumberland, Rhode Island, many of the techniques from a century ago are still used today. Each trophy is stamped with "TIFFANY & CO. MAKERS," "Ag925" to denote sterling silver and an individually registered serial number.

Designing and crafting more than 65 custom trophies each year, Tiffany & Co. is the world's authority in hollowware and has been for over a century and a half.



Football

Tiffany has created some of the most esteemed trophies for the National Football League (NFL) since 1959.

The Vince Lombardi Trophy

Awarded each year to the champions of the Super Bowl, Tiffany & Co. has proudly created the Vince Lombardi Trophy since 1967. Named after the legendary Green Bay Packers coach and NFL executive who led the team to victory at the first two Super Bowls in 1966 and '67, the sterling silver design recalls a regulation-sized football.

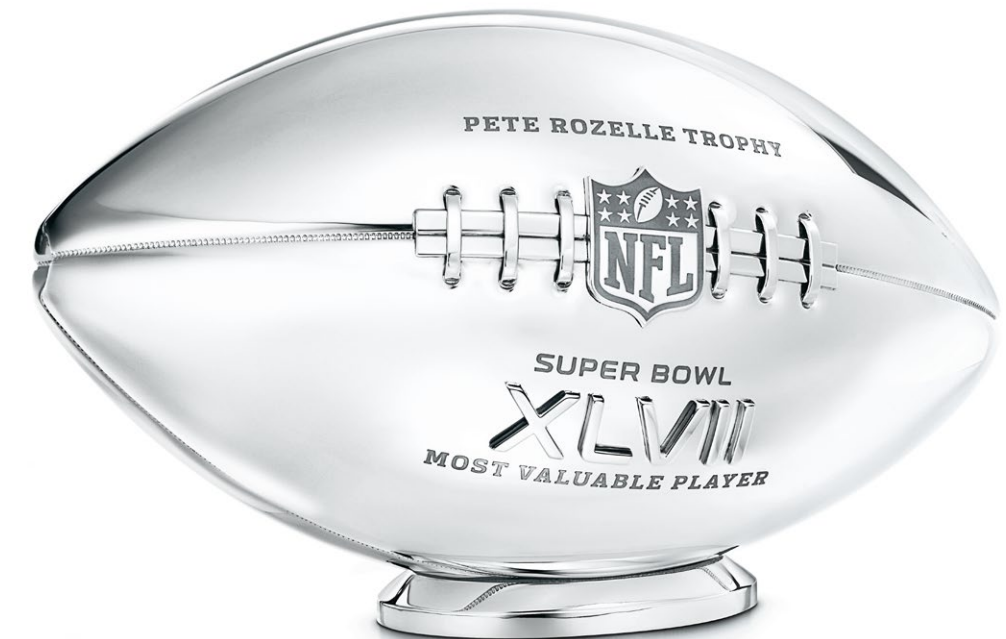
The Pete Rozelle Super Bowl[®] MVP Trophy

Basketball

Since 1977, the National Basketball Association (NBA) has commissioned the House to create its coveted awards. Tiffany & Co. redesigned the suite of trophies in 2022.

The NBA Larry O'Brien Championship Trophy

Presented to the winning team of the NBA Finals, Tiffany & Co. has crafted the 24k gold vermeil, sterling silver and wood trophy since 1977. Named after former NBA Commissioner Larry O'Brien, the trophy was first awarded in the 1977 NBA Finals. In 2022, Tiffany & Co. unveiled the latest iteration of the trophy, which features a streamlined design and two tiers at the base engraved with all previous champions and including room for the next 25 champions.

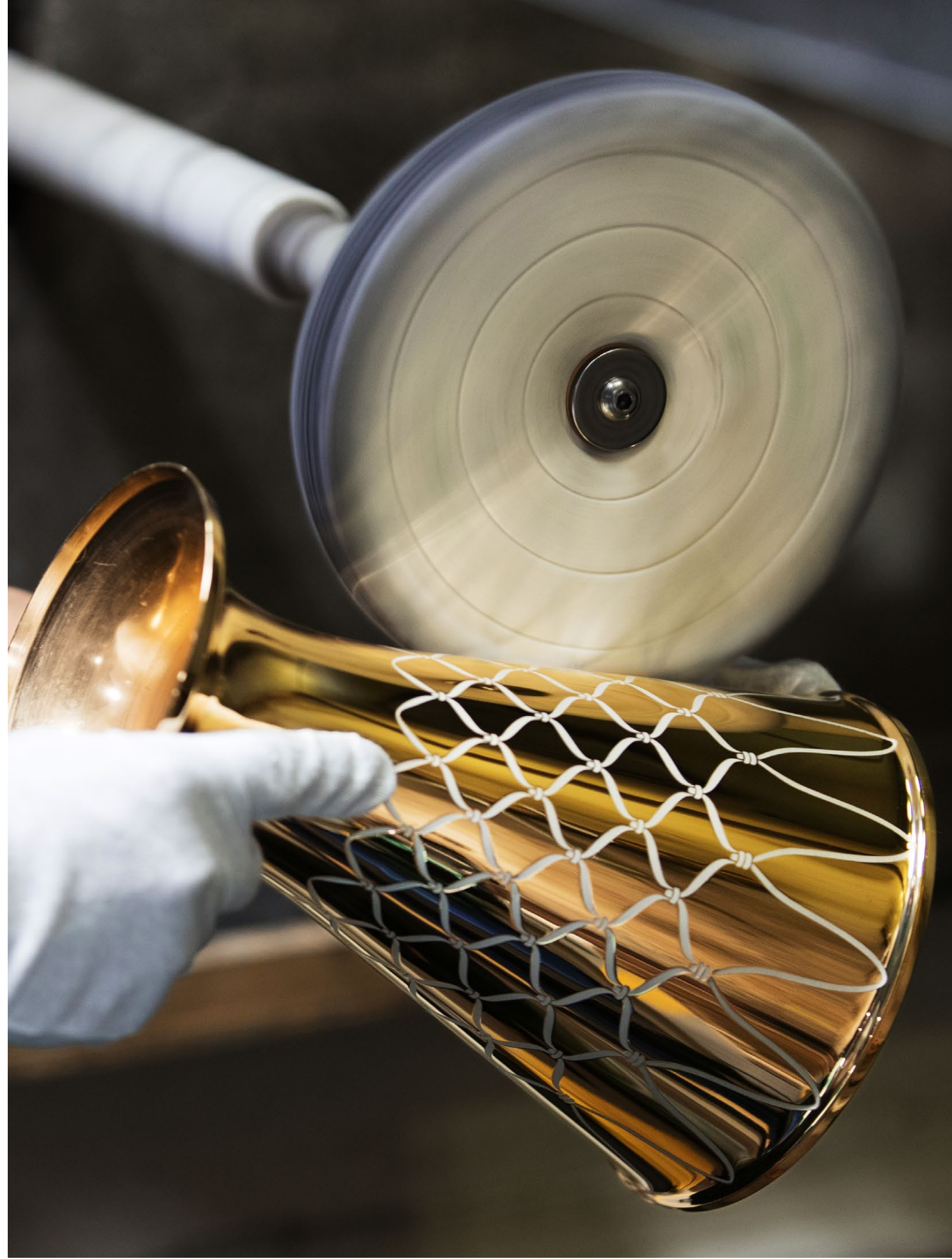

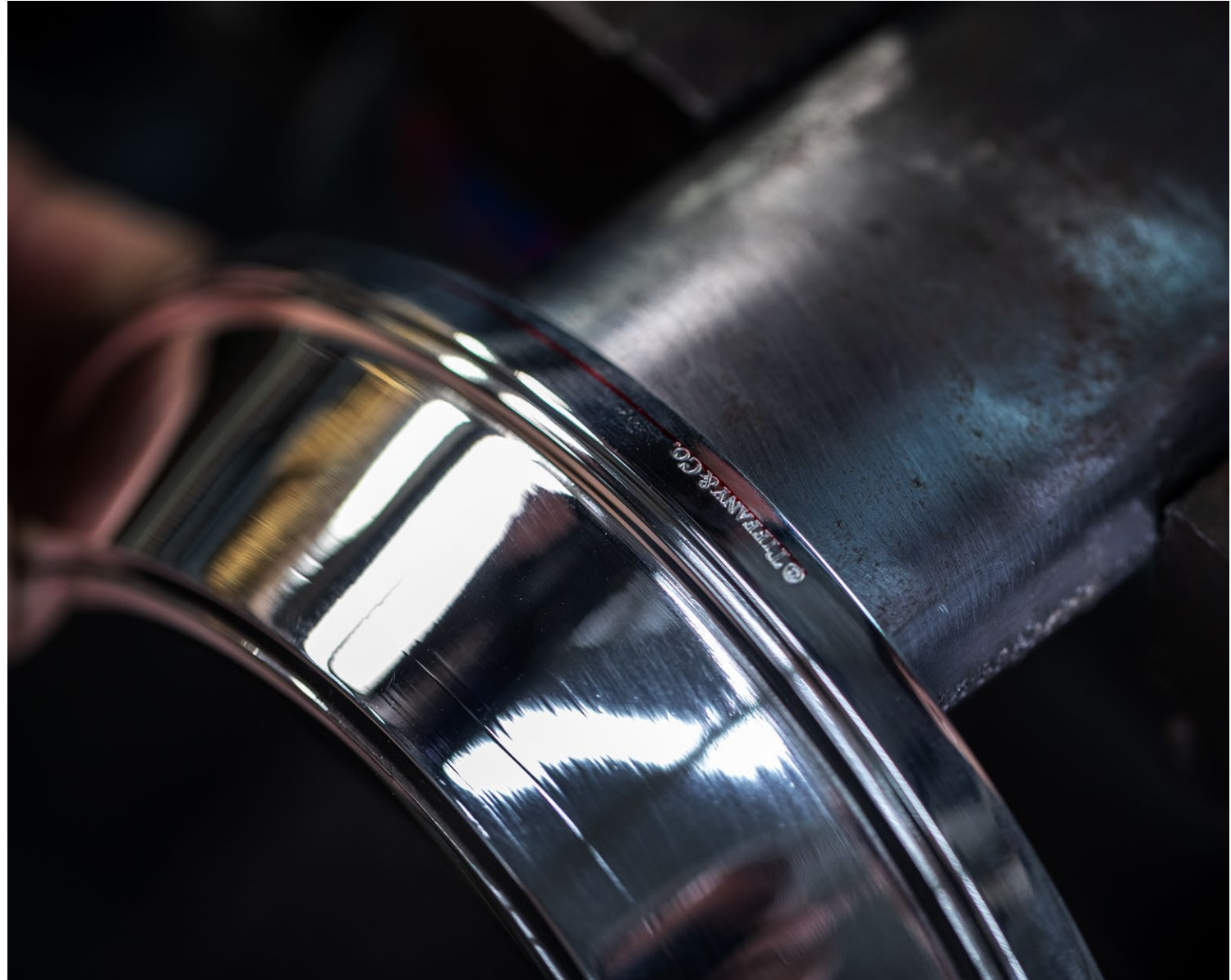

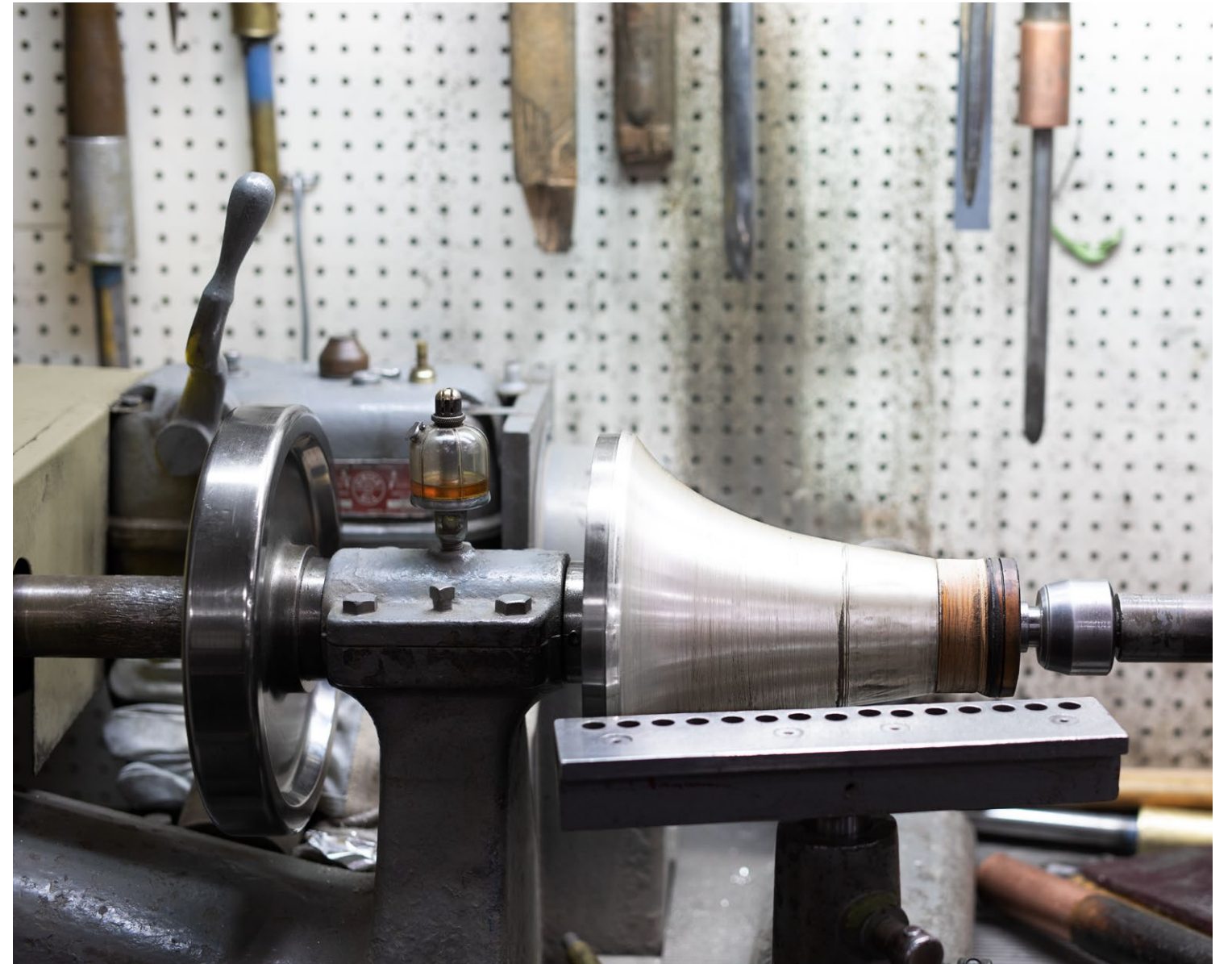

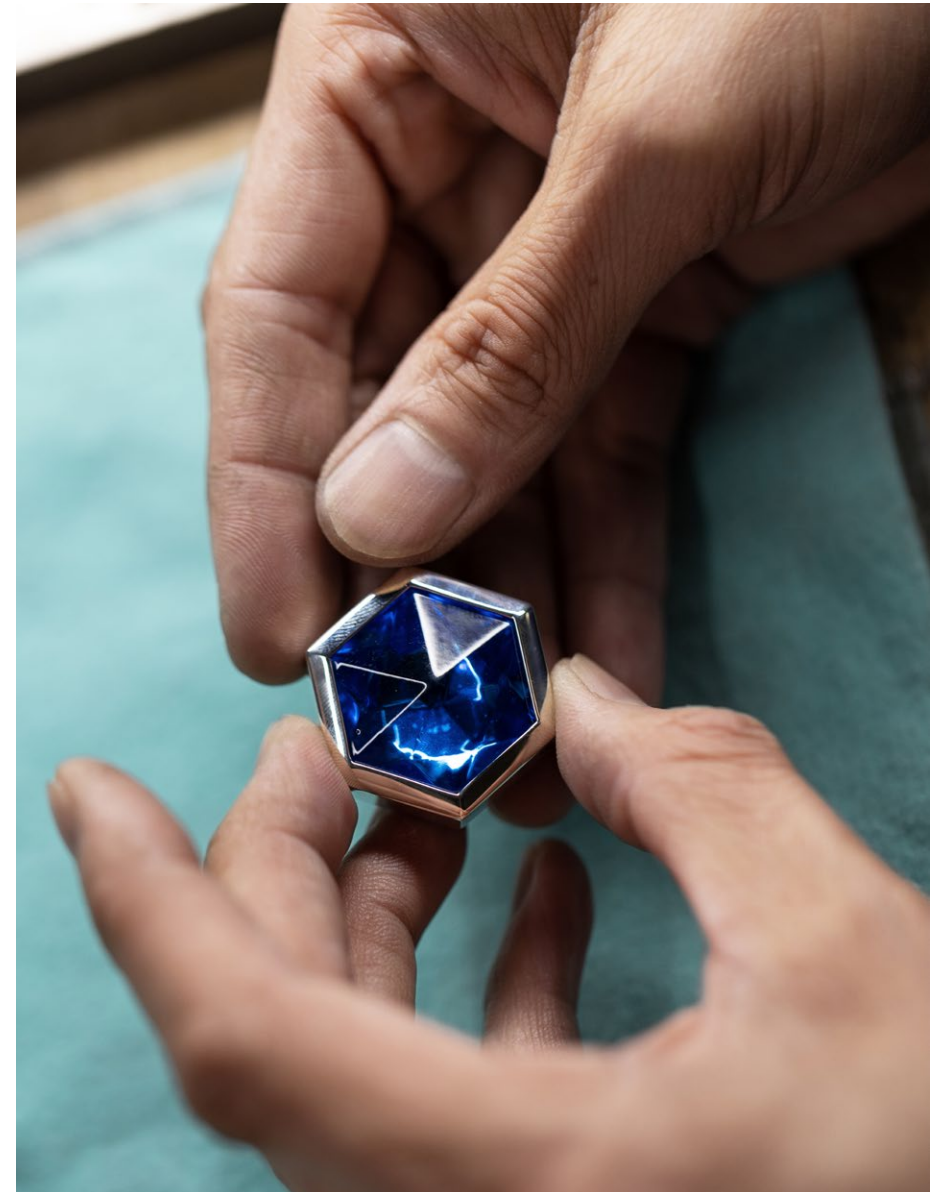

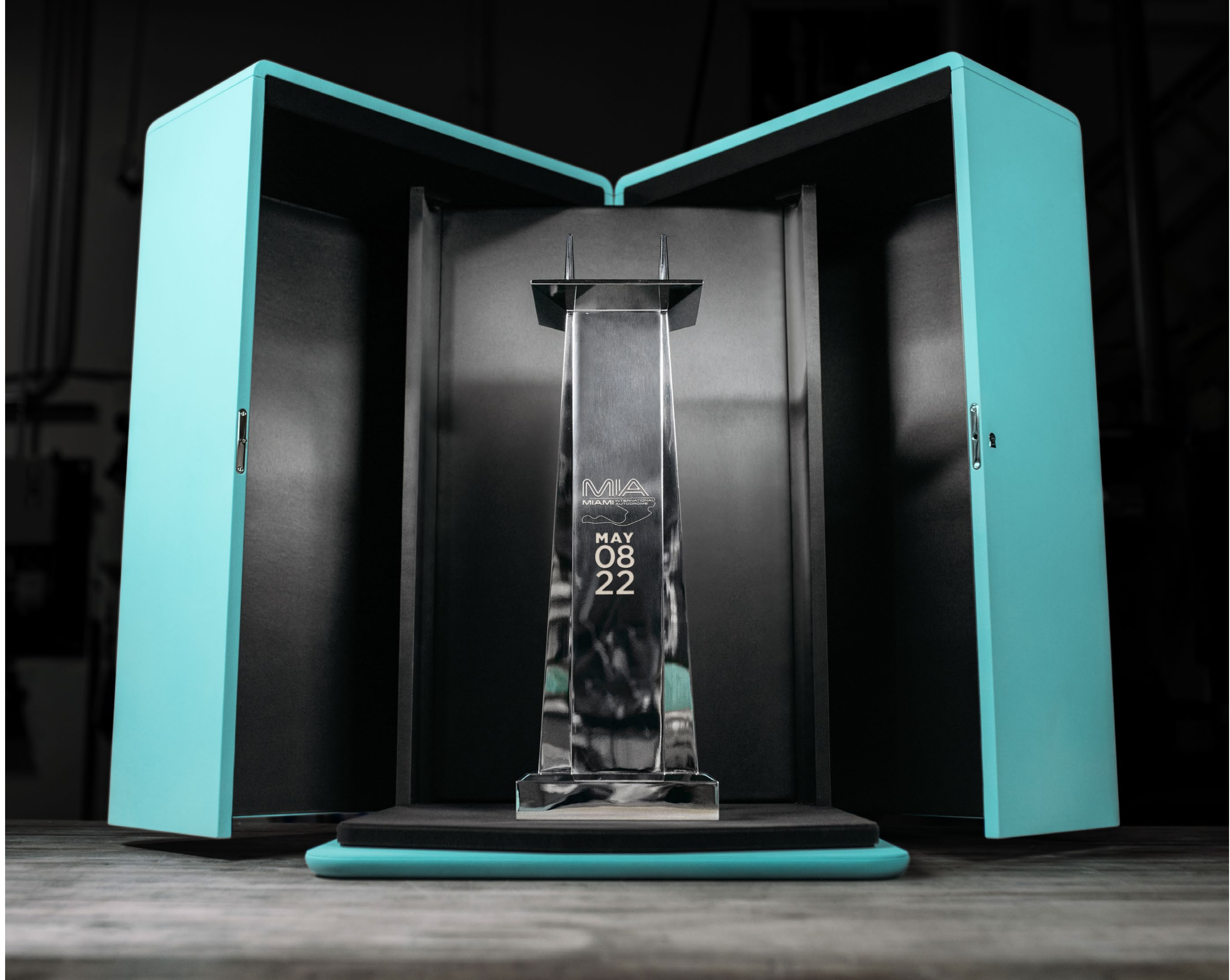
