Delta Light® at Euro luce 2015

A new Lighting Bible and some eye-catching newcomers

Good news for inspiration seekers. Delta Light presents the 11th edition of the Lighting Bible. A new catalogue that features a contemporary take on a few archetypes, miniaturisation of LED lighting, new materials, new applications, new shapes and lots of extensions for existing series. All in-house manufactured designs, unveiled for the first time from 14 through 19 April at Euro luce in Milan.

A new Lighting Bible, new collections presented in a new stand concept at Euro luce, and a thoroughly revamped and expanded showroom. Creativity is everywhere at Delta Light. The Western Flanders based manufacturer of architectural lighting is exhibiting a wide range of innovations. From miniature recessed luminaires with powerful light output, to archetypical lighting forms with a modern twist and a major expansion of product families. The new catalogue has over 30% new product references... Should it be any surprise that the Lighting Bible has grown to over 1,100 pages of inspiration?

Super-Oh – Floating black ring

Big and bold. But never overpowering. The Super-Oh is made up of a slim black ring that comes in multiple versions. Thanks to the wide range of options, the Super-Oh is perfectly suited to high spaces such as reception areas in offices or hotels, as well as in lofts or elegant, historic city houses.

De Super-Oh is available in three different diameters: 1.700, 1.200 and 700 mm with 8, 6 or 3 LED modules, respectively. These highly compact power LEDs are incorporated inside the ring, with minimal glare thanks to the inset position of the light source. Despite the spot lighting inside the rings, the effect on the ground or work surface is a diffuse and even lighting.

In addition to the LED version, the Super-Oh is also available with 10, 7 or 5 E27-fittings, in which case the bulbs are clearly visible. It is a nod to the type of bulbs found on make-up mirrors for actors and artists. The lamp is suspended from the ceiling by three virtually invisible steel cables. The Super-Oh is perfectly at home on its own, but can also be used in compositions, with various rings suspended above, next to or through one another.

Spy – timeless design in a range of sizes

The successful Spy series is barely a year old. But it's already getting a major expansion. There are new recessed and surface mounted variations, which makes the series ideal for both new construction and renovation projects. They come in small and large formats, from mini to maxi. And now, there's also a Spy on track and different profile modules for the Splitline.

In addition to the recessed versions Mini Spy, Spy ST and Spy Trimless, Delta Light now also offers surface mounted versions in various formats and diameters. From a solitary version to a rectangular base holding 1, 2 or 3 flexible tubes. For the surface mounting fixtures, Delta Light uses an asymmetrically positioned hinge that allows the Spy to be tilted up to 90° and rotated up to 350°. What's unique about this hinge is that the device's slim tube shape remains uninterrupted, giving it a sleek look with full adjustability.

A noteworthy newcomer is the Midispy Trimless: a compact tube that can be completely or half sunk into the ceiling using a kit for recessed mounting. Another option with this kit is surface mounting, so that the Midispy presents itself like a curious object peeking from the ceiling, able to 'spy' up to 350° around the room. Also new is the Maxi Spy, a sizeable spot for commercial use, with an output of up to 3,000 lumens. To enhance the versatility of the Spy family, there are also numerous accessories such as a honeycomb, various lenses and black, white or gold inserts.

Phar – like a lighthouse

Think of it as a distant cousin of the Tweeter On. The Phar has the same spherical top and can be just as easily rotated in all directions. But it has a more rugged look thanks to the black casing and the Fresnel lens in front, just like a lighthouse.

The concentric rings of the Fresnel lens give the Phar the glamour of a theatrical spotlight. Aside from the decorative aspect, this lens also generates a powerful and evenly focused beam of light in 35°, in consistent width from the lens to the object illuminated. The high mobility of both the base and the adapter (355°) as well as the round head with the Fresnel lens (90° tilt and 355° rotation) make the Phar an extremely versatile and functional spot.

The Phar is available in a track version and is ideal as lighting for shops, hospitality settings or in monumental lofts with high ceilings.

Montur – a sleek take on a classic

With the completely new series Montur, Delta Light offers a highly original interpretation of an archetypical concept: a light source that is contained within the framing of a 3D square or rectangular shape. The Montur is available in indoor and outdoor versions, as a ground, wall or ceiling fixture, with LED clusters from 6 to 14 watts or filament-LED lamps with a rustic look. The series integrates beautifully in both country-classic and contemporary homes, and is suitable for hotels and public buildings as well.

The Montur not only breathes new life into a classic concept, it also adds a detailed element of refinement. The sharply profiled framing in aluminium is utterly devoid of welding seams. For both the indoor and outdoor versions, there is a choice of finishing with either hand pressed transparent or opal glass. The opal glass version contains a milky, cone shaped core, with a transparent glass surface, creating a pleasantly diffused light that gives the lamp extra cachet.

The indoor version of the Montur is also available as an open cube, with one or two bulbs, or in a rectangular shape with a powerful LED cluster concealed behind a protective cover in polycarbonate.

By using them as outdoor fixtures, you can extend your lighting style into the garden or parking area. The outdoor versions are available in the same models as the indoor ones, but always feature a protective cover in glass or polycarbonate. There is also a bollard version, with a choice of various heights and colours. The Montur is perfectly able to withstand all weather conditions: the outdoor fixtures have a protection level of IP65.

Fifty-5 – playing with light and perspective

For the second time, Delta Light is offering a wall fixture based on a 3D-drawing, an optical illusion. Following the Forty-5, it's now time for the Fifty-5. An eye-catcher that is not easily captured in words. The Fifty-5 invites you to use your own creativity and make compositions with other Fifty-5's. Ideal for a playful effect in the living room, in a restaurant or to add a distinctive touch to the reception area of a company or hotel.

The Fifty-5 is available in a black or white versions, including a black, white or gold insert to enhance the optical illusion. The combination of a power LED with a softening lens, combined with the specific outline of the Fifty-5, creates a well-defined pattern of light upwards and a more diffuse light effect below.

Small and mighty – barely visible LEDs

A new trend in the Lighting Bible 11 is certainly miniaturisation: fixtures that are engineered to be so small that you barely notice them. As a complement to the Soft Ceiling concept launched in 2014, Delta Light now presents tiny recessed lighting in various series, in which the form and presence of the fixture is subordinate to the light effect.

In the Soft Ceiling concept, it's all about maximum comfort on the eyes and minimal glare, whereby Delta Light focuses on both the specific positioning of the light source as well as lenses, reflectors and accessories.

In the Lighting Bible, the Mini Reo, Mini Diro, Mini Deep Ringo and Micro Deep Ringo stand out thanks to their minuscule design. Small as they may be, some of the series can generate up to 800 lumens, making them extremely functional. The result is a barely visible opening in the ceiling, from which an astounding amount of light emanates. Ideal for creating accents and as a fully integrated architectural lighting solution.

Gibbo – the return of the glass globe

A fresh touch in the Delta Light range is the use of handblown glass globes, a new decorative eye-catcher that combines warm tints and materials with the latest LED technology.

The Gibbo is a suspended fixture with a base positioned at an angle so that the globe appears to be rolling away. The glass is handblown and is available in transparent, opal or amber tinted versions. The golden brown colour gives the Gibbo a warm presence, which is attractive in compositions above tables and in interiors with warm accents and materials. The base for the Gibbo is available in black or white.

The glass globes of the Gibbo are also incorporated in the new Tweeter Fix series from Delta Light. In this way, you can perfectly coordinate the suspended lamp with the wall and ceiling lighting, to ensure consistency and charm throughout the interior.

Flac – a versatile flat pendant lamp

The Flac combines the minimalism of LED lighting with the presence of a pendant fixture. An extremely flat white disk with an opening in the middle from which the light emanates in a 15° beam. Perfect for use above a dining table or desk. On the top of the disk a LED strip provides a powerful up-lighting effect. The power supply is discreetly built into the top of the lamp, making it virtually invisible.

The Flac offers the option of "trimless suspension". The power cable and suspension are then seamlessly concealed in the ceiling for an even more elegant finishing.

Snap-in modules – for a sleek and uncluttered ceiling

The Snap-in module system is a new, modular lighting solution. A snap-in LED module for the classics Rodi, Grid In and Grid On. Suitable for ceiling recessed and surface mounted use. You can also extend the Snap-in look with a custom-made Finnline profile.

What is exceptional about this module is that the mechanical components for tilting and rotation are completely concealed from view. This offers maximum freedom of movement at the same time as preserving a harmonious and uncluttered ceiling. The Snap-in gives you maximum freedom. You install the main device and then snap in the desired modules. The modules are available in different colour temperatures and colour renderings (CRI), with finish in black, white and chrome.

Soft Dim – dimmable like a halogen lamp

Delta Light now offers various LED ceiling recessed devices with Soft Dim technology. This puts an end to the common objection that dimming LEDs maintains the same colour temperature. With Soft Dim, not only is the light intensity dimmed but the colour temperature as well. Just like with halogen lamps. The user experiences this as a smooth, gentle transition from 2.700 to 1.800K.

The Soft Dim technology is new in The Lighting Bible 11, and is incorporated in familiar Delta Light families such as the Reo, You-Turn, iMax, Deep Ringo, Carree and Minigrid.

Dreve – a beacon of light amid the greenery (designed by Dirk Wynants)

Dreve – what they call a driveway or drive in Western Flanders – instantly gives away the perfect application for this lighting. This outdoor fixture is eminently suitable for installation along a walkway or footpath in a green setting.

During the day, Dreve is a subtle, architectural pillar that blends into the surroundings. After dark, Dreve becomes a beacon that leads the way and illuminates the surroundings. This is done by distributing the light in three different ways: first, a broad diffusion upwards, thus lighting both the trunks and foliage of trees. A walkway is instantly transformed into an enchanting, illuminated corridor. In addition, some of the light is diverted downwards in order to light the path. And finally, Dreve also illuminates itself, making it a clearly visible beacon. What's remarkable is that all three forms of lighting are powered by a single light source, which makes Dreve a highly efficient design. The galvanised steel gives Dreve a robust, no-nonsense look that ages subtly and beautifully, to blend even more harmoniously into the environment, for decades to come. Dirk Wynants brings the same characteristic style to his own design furniture collection Extremis: innovatively multifunctional, discreet and sustainable in every way.
