1. CFL Trends & Highlights Heading Into Week #7:

- **Historic Comebacks from 10+ down:** Winnipeg's late comeback was one of the most stunning in CFL history in that it combined three elements in one: **1) Down by 10 points or more, 2) Done entirely in the final 3:00 of the game, 3) Completed by a last play score.** Add to that scenario that it required an onside kickoff and you get one of the greatest comebacks to win in league history.

The closest parallel to last week's comeback was also executed by Winnipeg over Montreal on **October 17, 1999** with most of the circumstances the same, down by 10, last play TD and with the late scoring starting with just **0:59 left**. Here are the specific comebacks in CFL history over the 25 years since **1992** where clubs **trailed by 10 or more points late** and won:

- **Largest Win Margin:** The Stampeders defeated Hamilton last week 60-1 to post a club record and the 3rd-largest winning margin in league history. Their 59-point edge in the 4th Quarter was the largest lead that any club had had in a game in the last 2 years.

- **Most consecutive 300+ passing games (9):** The CFL record for most 300+ games in a row is 9 set by **Sam Etcheverry** in 1956 and matched by **Kent Austin** of Saskatchewan in 1991. **Anthony Calvillo** reached 8 games in a row in 2012 as did **Mike Reilly** for Edmonton across 2015-16. Ricky Ray became the 9th player in CFL history to make it to 6 games running joining also Kerwin Bell (1998), Danny McManus (1999), Henry Burris (2007), Bo Levi Mitchell in 2016.

- **5-0 Starts:** Edmonton has started 2017 at 5-0 and become the **25th team in CFL history** to do so. Across the 1948 to 2016 seasons, this happened only 4% of the time (24 times in 602 team seasons). Here are some historical observations on 5-0 starts:

Among the 24 teams to start 5-0 ...

- None has ever missed the playoffs
- 14 out of the 24 extended their run to **6-0** at least (58%); the other 10 lost in their bid to reach 6-0 (42%)
- 14 went on to play in the Grey Cup (58% of the time) and ...
- 7 of those 14 clubs at 5-0 went on to **WIN** the Grey Cup (29% of the time)
- Only Calgary in 1971 failed to reach 10 wins after their 5-0 start (but they rebounded to win the Grey Cup anyway)
- Calgary has started 5-0 the most times since 1948: **6 times** (1948, 1949, 1971, 1991, 1993 and 1995)
- Montreal is next at **5 times** (1977, 2000, 2002, 2004, 2006; 4 times in 7 year span)
- Others: BC 4x (1981, 1985, 2005 & 2007), Edmonton 3x (1961, 1980 & 2011), Saskatchewan 2x (2008, 2013), Hamilton 2x (1958, 1961), Toronto 1x (1960), Winnipeg 1x (1960)

- **0-5 Starts:** Hamilton has started out 0-5 but there is hope. Since 1948, 32 clubs have begun a season losing their first 5 games but three did manage to rebound and make the playoffs: Winnipeg 1955 (7-9), Ottawa 1959 (8-6) and most recently BC 1969 (5-11). Hopeful also is the tendency to turn it around at Game #6 ... of the 32 teams at 0-5, 15 won their sixth game to avoid 0-6.

1. CFL Trends & Highlights Heading Into Week #7:

- **Downfield Passing 20+ yards:** Ricky Ray leads the CFL in completions where the receiver is deeper than 20 yards downfield with 25 followed by Mike Reilly and Bo Levi Mitchell with 17. Darian Durant has been the most accurate thus far in that range at 58% - here are the leaders in throwing deep in 2017:

- **Ricky Ray Passing:** Ray has passed for 2,282 yards - an average of 380.3 per game and has recorded a career-high 6 straight games of 300+ yards. That 380 per game pace equates to a full season of **6,846** yards and would surpass the CFL record held by Doug Flutie (**6,619 in 1991**). The last player to pass for 300 yards in 7 consecutive games was Here is list of the most passing yards through the first 6 games in CFL history with Ray's 1,896 figure now at #4 all-time:

- **Andrew Harris - 37 receptions:** Harris has made 37 receptions in 5 games - averaging **7.4 per game** and is on pace for **133** for the season. That is far ahead of the CFL record for running backs set by Craig Ellis in 1985 of 102 receptions (and ahead of all but Derrell Mitchell's record 160 for any player set in 1998). Here is a list of all-time most receptions by a running back in a single season (minimum of 75 rushing attempts in that season to qualify as a running back):

- **CFL All-time bests in 2017:** Through 25 games the 2017 season has been remarkable particularly in the passing game. League-wide in 2017 all-time highs are being set for - Completion % at **68.7%** and Pass Efficiency rating at **99.8**, and lowest Interception rate at just **2.1%** (one in 47.2 attempts). Turnovers are even more apparent as there have been just **3.04 per game** in 2017 - that is 26% lower than in any other season in league history (2012: 4.14 T/Os per game)

- **Andrew Buckley 10-for-10:** The Calgary #2 QB challenged the CFL record last week for most pass attempts in a game without an interception or incomplection. Here are the top performances all-time:

- **Reilly on top of QUAR:** With a near-perfect game **QUAR** Rating of **96.8** last week, **Mike Reilly** has risen to #1 in the CFL's Quarterback rating system with a **91.1** mark out of 100 for 2017. He exceeded maximum performance in all but first downs (21) and rushing yards (11) in leading Edmonton to their win over Toronto. His INT-free streak ended last week at **220 in a row**.

- **Kevin Glenn 109 & Darian Durant 62:** Having now reached 50,000 passing yards Glenn's next milestone will be passing legendary Ron Lancaster (50,535) for # all-time. Glenn sits at 50,427 yards through Week #6 and needs just 109 more to pass Lancaster. Durant (30,247) needs only 62 more yards to pass Tom Burgess (30,308) and join the Top 15 all-time. Durant needs 135 yards to pass Sam Etcheverry (30,381) for #14.



2017 CFL GAME NOTES • CALGARY AT TORONTO



1. CFL Trends & Highlights Heading Into Week #7:

- **Home team dominance 16-8:** The home team has now won **the last 7 CFL games** and 12 of the last 14. For the season home teams have dominated winning 16 times to just 8 losses.
- **10 QB Starters in 2017:** Across the CFL through the first 6 weeks, only 10 different QBs have started a game this year, one above the minimum. By year here are the totals at this point - **2017:** 10, **2016:** 14, **2015:** 13, **2014:** 11, **2013:** 13. Only BC has started more than the minimum thus far.
- **East vs West:** West Division clubs have won the last 6, and 12 of the last 13 inter-divisional games. Toronto's record is a good example of this effect as they are 3-0 vs the East, and 0-3 vs the West in 2017.
- **108 yard completion:** The Eskimos Mike Reilly and Vidal Hazelton connected on a 108-yard pass last week vs BC. This was longest pass play in the CFL since a 109 yarder Damon Allen to Alfred Jackson in 2002 for BC and the longest in Edmonton history.
- **FG% Success at 87%:** The league-wide success rate for field goals is at an all-time high of 86.8%. Over the last 4 weeks, there have been only 7 missed FGs for a rate that is just under 90%.

2. Gm #35 - Calgary at Toronto Notes:

- **#1 vs #2 Offence:** This game features the #1 and #2 offences in the CFL with Calgary at 420.2 yards per game and Toronto at 401.5. Calgary comes in with six consecutive wins over Toronto and 7 in the last 8 meetings. Overall, Calgary is **28-6-2 .806** vs East Division clubs since the start of 2013, Toronto is just **2-11** vs the West in their last 13 inter-divisional games. Ricky Ray is 2-4 in his 6 starts against Calgary for Toronto.
- **McDaniel 76-game streak stopped:** Last week the Stamps did not target McDaniel on any of their pass attempts and thus his magnificent streak of 76 straight games with at least one reception ended. He last failed to catch a pass on Aug 25/12 (and he was not targeted in that game either).
- **Jerome Messam rushing:** In his first 4 games he had 48 carries for 188 yards, 1 TD and an average of only 3.9 yards. Since being ejected on Jul 14/17, his totals are: 39 carries for 226 yards, 4 TDs and a 5.8 yard average.
- **Marken Michel's 190 yards:** Michel caught 6 passes on 9 targets for 190 yards last week - the most yards by a Calgary receiver since **Oct 23/09** when Romby Bryant had 211 yards on 9 catches vs Edmonton. Michel's 190 yards ranks among the Top 17 performances in all of Calgary club history.
- **TDs 4 ways:** Last week the Stamps scored via 4 different types of touchdowns and for the second time this season. This is just one short of the CFL record of scoring in **5 different ways** and that has occurred only 7 times in history and not since 2003. Saskatchewan scored a TD via rush, pass, interception, punt and kickoff returns on **August 17, 2003**.
- **Calgary O-Line Excellence:** The Stampeders have not allowed a Sack in the last two games and just two in the last 4 contests in 2017. They went 3 games in a row last year without allowing a Sack on their QBs and over their last 22 games have given up just 20 or **less than one per game**. What makes it more remarkable is that 11 different players have started over this 22-game span.
- **Bo Levi Mitchell 16 games in a row:** Mitchell is off to a career-best start this season with a 5,496-yard pace despite sitting out the entire 2nd half last week. He is now riding a streak of **16 consecutive games with at least one TD pass** (Reminder: games where a QB does not see the field at all are excluded from streak calculation as no opportunity is there to extend it). Mitchell has thrown at least one TD pass in **37 of his last 38 games**.
- **All-Time Win Pct / Fastest 50:** Bo Levi Mitchell's career winning % is now .839 and ranks him as follows with a second listing for fastest to 50 wins as a starter. Mitchell cannot be the fastest to 50 wins trailing Winnipeg's **Ken Ploen** but can be one of only two to reach 50 wins in 60 starts:

- **Ray INTs:** Over his last two games Ray has not thrown an interception covering 93 straight pass attempts. He has just 3 picks in 266 throws this year.
- **Shawn Lemon:** Has logged 4 Sacks and 9 QB Pressures over his last 5 games and ranks #3 for the season with 11 Pressures overall. His total of 15 Sacks & Pressures is tied for #1 in the CFL.
- **Martese Jackson:** The Argos' return game has risen to the top of the CFL in recent weeks with the addition of Martese Jackson as a regular. Over his last 3 games, Jackson has gained 631 return yards plus another 42 on offence - that equates to a pace of over 4,000 yards for a season.
- **FG Kickers Last 3 games:** The two kickers come into this game near-perfect in recent weeks. Rene Paredes is 8-for-8 in his last 3 games, Lirim Hajrullahu 11-for-12 on his tries missing only from 39 yards on Jul 24/17.

RAY-SING THE BAR: QB Ricky Ray is simply raising the bar for quarterback play as an Argonaut so far this season. The 15-year veteran currently leads the CFL with 2,282 passing yards and nine touchdowns on 184-of-266 passing. Ray is currently on pace to throw for 7,388 yards this season which would be 769 passing yards more than current single-season all-time leader Doug Flutie (6,619) and 1,725 more than his career-high (5,663) set in 2008.

Ray became the franchise leader in passing yards with a five-yard strike to RB/SB **Anthony Coombs** in the fourth quarter on Saturday, surpassing longtime record holder Condredge Holloway (16,619). Ray also became the club's all-time leader in passing attempts (Holloway – 1,989) in the first quarter on Saturday afternoon. Ray needs four passing touchdowns to become the club's outright all-time leading passer.

He posted his sixth consecutive game with 300+ passing yards on Saturday vs. the Riders. Ray's 386-yard performance last Saturday at Mosaic Stadium notches a feat which he has never accomplished in his 15-year career – 506 in Week 1, 327 in Week 2, 366 in Week 3, 330 in Week 4, 367 in Week 5. Additionally, his three-touchdown game on Saturday was his first since last year's Labour Day Classic in Hamilton on September 5, 2016.

The Argos all-time passing leader needs 10 more 300-yard games to pass Henry Burris for 2nd all-time.

COOMBS PACING IN 2017: For the second consecutive week, Argos SB/RB **Anthony Coombs** led all pass catchers with nine catches for 97 yards vs. the Riders. In the last four games, the Argos 2014 CFL Draft pick has hauled in 29 passes for 307 yards and a touchdown, an average of 10.5 yards per catch. Coombs, who currently ranks 13th in the CFL in receiving with 37 catches for 350 yards and a touchdown, is currently on pace to set a career-high with 1,050 yards on 111 catches. Not only would these leapfrog career-highs of 57 catches for 486 yards set back in 2015 but he has already surpassed last year's season totals.

KEEPING IT 100: The Argonauts receiving corps has been more than productive through the first six weeks of the season. In that time, the Argos have had four different receivers eclipse the 100-yard mark, including one in that group that gone for over 200: Argos WRs **DeVier Posey** (7-147-1), **SJ Green** (WK1 6-126 & WK3 10-210-1), and **Jeff Fuller** (3-104) popped off in Week 1 while newcomer **Armanti Edwards** quietly recorded his first career 100-yard game in Week 2. In just four weeks, the Argos 100-yard efforts have matched the team's total in 2016 - 2 – Diontae Spencer, 3 – Kenny Shaw.



BEAR CHOPPING WOOD: Since arriving in Toronto during training camp, Argos linebacker **Bear Woods** has shown his worth. The six-year CFL veteran ranks fourth in the CFL and leads the Argos with 37 defensive tackles, eight of which came last week against the Riders. In four of his last six games, Woods has notched 6+ tackles. Woods, who set the Alouettes club record for tackles in a season (126), is currently averaging six tackles a game and on pace to register 110 tackles this season which would match Kevin Eiben's 110 tackles (fourth all-time in Argos history) in 2004.

NEWS & NOTES:

- Argos DE **Shawn Lemon** registered four tackles and a sack in his first return to Regina since being traded to Toronto on July 2, 2016. Since being traded the seven-year CFL veteran has recorded 33 tackles and 18 sacks in 22 games with the Double Blue.
- Argos kicker **Lirim Hajrullahu** has attempted a league-high 26 field goals through six weeks. Of his 26 attempts, Hajrullahu has connected on a league-leading 21 attempts, a conversion rate of 80.8%. The Western product's 26 field goals attempts are also nine more than the next closest place kicker.
- 2016 CFL Draft pick Llevi Noel caught his second career touchdown last week vs. the Riders. Noel, who also serves as a special teams ace for the Double Blue, is currently tied for fourth in the CFL with nine special teams tackles. Noel trails the league-leaders by just one special teams tackle.
- WRs **SJ Green** and **Armanti Edwards** rank second and seventh in CFL, respectively, in receiving yards. Green currently leads the Boatmen with 37 catches for 587 yards and two touchdowns while Edwards has caught 31 of 41 targets for 428 yards and a touchdown.
- Third-year Argo **Marcus Ball** registered four tackles for the second consecutive week. Ball now has 28 tackles and an interception on the season and has registered 4+ tackles in all six games.
- DE **Troy Davis** made his first career start last week vs. SSK, registering three tackles, one sack and one quarterback pressure a week after tallying his first career sack in relief of Victor Butler.
- The Argos' punt return unit has been airtight during the first third of the season, allowing a league-low 7.6 yards per punt return to opponents. They'll face Stamps' returner Roy Finch this week, who averages a league-high 15.9 yards per punt return.
- Despite playing in just four games this season, Argos RB/KR **Martese Jackson** ranks fourth in the league in combined yards with 736. Jackson has 476 kickoff return yards, 218 punt return yards and 42 receiving yards.

**STAMPEDERS VS. ARGONAUTS****CALGARY GM #7 · CFL #35****1 GAME OVERVIEW**

The Stampeders look to carry their momentum into the bye as they travel to Toronto to face the Argonauts in their final game before a one-week layoff.

Calgary has won its two most recent games, both at home, by a combined score of 87-11 to improve to 4-1-1 on the season. The Stamps are 1-1-1 on the road so far in 2017.

The Argos are first in the East Division with a 3-3 record including a 2-1 mark at home. Toronto dropped a 38-27 decision to the Roughriders last week in Regina.

The Stamps have prevailed in their six most recent meetings with the Boatmen including a 48-20 victory on Thanksgiving Day in 2016 on what was the Red and White's first visit to BMO Field.

2 STAMPEDERS HISTORICAL NOTES

- Today's game is the 1,179th regular-season game in Stampeders history. The Stamps have 639 wins, 518 losses and 21 ties since 1945. Calgary has played 589 games at home, with a record of 376-203-10, and 589 games on the road (263-315-11)
- This will be the 92nd meeting all-time between the Stampeders and Argonauts. The Stamps are 48-42-1 all-time against Toronto including a road record of 19-26-1

3 NOTABLES

- **Kings of the road:** The Stamps have posted a CFL-best 21-7-2 road record since the start of the 2014 season and are one of only three teams with an above-.500 mark during that period. Here's a breakdown:

- **Decisive decision:** The Stamps' 60-1 win over Hamilton in Week 6 accounted for the largest point differential (59) in a Stampeders game and third-biggest in CFL history. The Stamps' previous largest margin of victory was 50, set in 1963 against Toronto (50-0) and matched in 1995 against Ottawa (57-7). The only larger discrepancies in a CFL contest were Montreal's 68-point victory over Hamilton (82-14) in 1956 and a 60-point shellacking (63-3) by Edmonton against Ottawa in 1995. The 60 points were the third-highest total by a Stamps team, surpassed only by the two occasions the Red and White put 62 points on the board – in 1994 against BC and in 1996 against Montreal
- **Dino-to-Dino deed:** Calgary quarterback **Andrew Buckley**'s scoring pass to **Anthony Parker** in Week 6 marked the first time in CFL history that one U of C Dinos alumnus threw a touchdown pass to another. It was also the first touchdown pass by a Canadian university product since Larry Jusdanis (Acadia) did it for Hamilton in 1996. Until Buckley connected with Parker, no Canadian pivot had thrown a TD pass for the Stamps since Greg Vavra in 1985
- **Points piling up:** The 213 points scored by Calgary so far in 2017 represent the Stamps' highest total six games into a season since they put up 257 points during a 5-0-1 start in 2000. Meanwhile, after allowing 70 points in the first two games of the current season, Calgary has allowed a total of just 51 points in the past four. The Stamps lead the CFL in both points for (an average of 35.5 per game) and points against (20.2)



- **Milestone moment:** In Week 5 against Saskatchewan, **Bo Levi Mitchell** threw the 100th touchdown pass of his CFL career. On the receiving end was **Marquay McDaniel**, who has been Mitchell's most popular target on scoring strikes over the years with 14 TD catches. Mitchell's career total is now up to 102 and here is the complete list of the 24 players who have caught Mitchell's TD passes:

Mitchell has thrown at least one touchdown pass in 16 consecutive games and in 37 of the past 38 contests.

- **Bo and the Boatmen:** Stamps quarterback **Bo Levi Mitchell** has a 6-0 career record against Toronto. He's also unbeaten against Hamilton (8-0) and Saskatchewan (7-0)
- **Offensive firepower:** Calgary (420.2 yards) and Toronto (401.5) are averaging more net offence per game than any other CFL squad. Ricky Ray of the Argos is currently the league's leading passer at 2,282 yards and **Jerome Messam** of the Stamps leads the league in rushing with 414 yards
- **One and done:** The Stampeders haven't dropped two in a row since Weeks 2 and 3 of the 2012 season and the span of 93 games is the longest a team has avoided consecutive defeats in Canadian professional football history

93 games — Stampeders (Week 4 of 2012 season to current)

54 games — Argonauts (Start of 1936 to end of 1946 — no play from 1942-44)*

51 games — Eskimos (Start of 1979 season to Week 4 of 1982 season)
