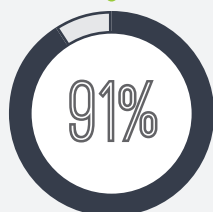

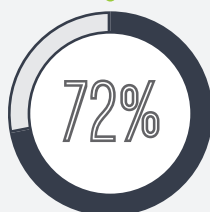

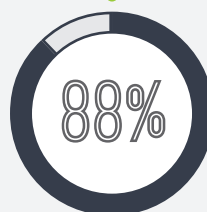

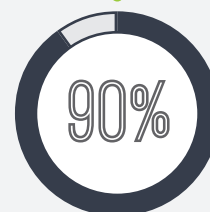

MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

COLES

- **I-57:** \$76.1 million for rubblization/reconstruction of 10.9 miles from north of Illinois 16 to the Douglas County line.

CLARK

- **U.S. 40:** \$26.1 million for resurfacing 26.3 miles, new shoulders, safety improvements, lighting, bridge deck overlay and bridge deck repairs from Illinois 49 to the Indiana state line.
- **Illinois 1:** \$18 million for resurfacing 10.3 miles, ADA improvements, bridge deck overlay, bridge repairs, traffic signal modernization and pedestrian signals from the Edgar County line to Grand Turn Road.

CUMBERLAND AND SHELBY

- **I-57:** \$26.2 million for resurfacing 8.6 miles from the Effingham County line to U.S. 45 at Neoga.

EFFINGHAM

- **U.S. 40/45/Illinois 33/Fayette Avenue:** \$22.5 million for reconstruction and additional lanes of 1.2 miles, ADA improvements, curb and gutter, storm sewer and building demolition from Banker Street to Salt Creek in Effingham.

FAYETTE

- **I-70:** \$24.5 million for resurfacing 11.6 miles (including ramp repair) from the Bond County line to the Kaskaskia River east of Vandalia.

LAWRENCE

- **U.S. 50:** \$58.1 million for bridge replacements and median crossovers from Beaver Pond Ditch to Sun and Sand Drive. *This project has been approved for Illinois Special Bridge funding.*

MACON

- **I-72/U.S. 36/51:** \$35.6 million for resurfacing 10.2 miles (including ramp repair) from west of U.S. 51 west of Decatur to west of U.S. 51 in Forsyth.
- **Old U.S. 51 Business:** \$24.4 million for resurfacing 1.1 miles and reconstruction of 2.1 miles, ADA improvements and traffic signal modernization from Illinois 121 to U.S. 36 in Decatur.

WAYNE

- **I-64:** \$14.4 million for bridge replacements, bridge removal and median crossovers over abandoned railroad 0.5 miles west of U.S. 45 and over U.S. 45 north of Mills Shoals.
