2020 CFL DRAFT SELECTION TRADE SUMMARY

ROUND 1

1st overall – Calgary Stampeders via Ottawa REDBLACKS

Calgary acquired Ottawa's original 2020 first-round selection (1st overall) along with Ottawa's original 2020 third-round selection (21st overall) in exchange for American quarterback Nick Arbuckle and Calgary's original 2020 first-round selection (6th overall).

5th overall – Hamilton Tiger-Cats via Montréal Alouettes

Hamilton acquired Montréal's original 2020 first-round selection (5th overall) along with Montréal's original 2021 first-round selection, National defensive lineman Jamaal Westerman and American wide receiver Chris Williams in exchange for American quarterback Johnny Manziel, American offensive lineman Tony Washington and National offensive lineman Landon Rice.

6th overall – Ottawa REDBLACKS via Calgary Stampeders

Ottawa acquired Calgary's original 2020 first-round selection (6th overall) along with American quarterback Nick Arbuckle in exchange for Ottawa's original 2020 first-round selection (1st overall) and Ottawa's original 2020 third-round selection (21st overall).

9th overall – Toronto Argonauts via Winnipeg Blue Bombers

Toronto acquired Winnipeg's original 2020 first-round selection (9th overall) along with Winnipeg's original 2020 third-round selection (28th overall) in exchange for American quarterback Zach Collaros and Toronto's best 2020 fifth-round selection (39th overall).

ROUND 2

16th overall – Montréal Alouettes via Saskatchewan Roughriders

Montréal acquired Saskatchewan's original 2020 second-round selection (16th overall) along with National wide receiver Joshua Stanford in exchange for National offensive lineman Philip Blake and National wide receiver Patrick Lavoie.

19th overall – Ottawa REDBLACKS

Ottawa has been assigned a second-round (19th overall) Territorial selection.

20th overall – Toronto Argonauts

Toronto has been assigned a second-round (20th overall) Territorial selection.

22nd overall – Montréal Alouettes via Toronto Argonauts

Montréal acquired Toronto's original 2020 third-round selection (22nd overall) along with American defensive back T.J. Heath in exchange for National offensive lineman Ryan Bomben and Montréal's original 2020 fifth-round selection (42nd overall).

Third-Round Selection – Saskatchewan Roughriders

Saskatchewan forfeited its original third-round selection after selecting National offensive lineman Jake Bennett in the 2019 CFL Supplemental Draft.

28th overall – Toronto Argonauts via Winnipeg Blue Bombers

Toronto acquired Winnipeg's original 2020 third-round selection (28th overall) along with Winnipeg's original 2020 first-round selection (9th overall) in exchange for American quarterback Zach Collaros and Toronto's best 2020 fifth-round selection (39th overall).

ROUND 4

30th overall – Saskatchewan Roughriders via Toronto Argonauts

Saskatchewan acquired Toronto's original 2020 fourth-round selection (30th overall) in exchange for American quarterback Zach Collaros.

31st overall – Calgary Stampeders via BC Lions

Calgary acquired BC's original 2020 fourth-round selection (31st overall) along with a player from BC's negotiation list in exchange for American offensive lineman Justin Renfrow and Calgary's original 2020 fifth-round selection (43rd overall).

ROUND 5

39th overall – Winnipeg Blue Bombers via Toronto Argonauts

Winnipeg acquired Toronto's best 2020 fifth-round selection (39th overall) along with American quarterback Zach Collaros in exchange for Winnipeg's original 2020 first-round selection (9th overall) and Winnipeg's original 2020 third-round selection (28th overall).

42nd overall – Toronto Argonauts via Montréal Alouettes

Toronto acquired Montréal's original 2020 fifth-round selection (42nd overall) along with National offensive lineman Ryan Bomben in exchange for Toronto's original 2020 third-round selection (22nd overall) and American defensive back T.J. Heath.

43rd overall – BC Lions via Calgary Stampeders

BC acquired Calgary's original 2020 fifth-round selection (43rd overall) along with American offensive lineman Justin Renfrow in exchange for BC's original 2020 fourth-round selection (31st overall) and a player from BC's negotiation list.

ROUND 6

49th overall – Montréal Alouettes via BC Lions

Montréal acquired BC's original 2020 sixth-round selection (49th overall) along with BC's original 2019 second-round selection (13th overall) in exchange for American running back Tyrell Sutton and Montréal's acquired 2019 third-round selection (26th overall – originally Saskatchewan's).

Montréal originally acquired Saskatchewan's original (and best) 2019 third-round selection (26th overall) along with National defensive back Tevaughn Campbell, Saskatchewan's best 2018 third-round selection (23rd overall) and the rights to a player on Saskatchewan's negotiation list in exchange for American quarterback Vernon Adams Jr., Montréal's original fifth-round selection (36th overall) in the 2018 CFL Draft and the rights to a player on Montréal's negotiation list.

ROUND 7

57th overall – Edmonton Eskimos via Toronto Argonauts

Edmonton acquired Toronto's original 2020 six-round selection (57th overall) along with American running back Martese Jackson in exchange for Edmonton's original 2019 third-round selection (23rd overall).

ROUND 8

66th overall – Montréal Alouettes via Toronto Argonauts

Montréal acquired Toronto's original 2020 eight-round selection (66th overall) in exchange for National linebacker Boseko Lokombo.

CFL DRAFT HISTORICAL NOTES

1. The concept of the Canadian College Draft was created at a meeting of Eastern clubs held on April 6, 1952. Their plan was to draft as many as seven “university graduate rookies” to each member club. In the meeting presided over by President Jack Welch delegates agreed in principle with the idea that the last place team from the previous year would have the right to select first in each round.
2. The 1952 IRFU College Draft was at first deemed “unofficial” but names announced for each team were in fact added to those particular club rosters for 1952.
3. Prior to 1956, Western clubs did not recognize the exclusive rights granted to the Eastern clubs to sign their picks and attempted to acquire many of them. With the creation of the CFC in 1956, all clubs participated in the Draft until 1959. Pick order was determined by reverse record with the losing Grey Cup Conference going first.
4. From 1960 to 1962 only the four Eastern teams plus Calgary participated in the Draft. The other Western teams had a territorial right to players from their area.
5. Prior to around 1970, positions varied from the present-day narrow specialization. More generic names were used for example Halfback or Tackle which covered offence and defence.
6. From 1972 to 1982, each club had the right to pre-select two players from its region who would be exempted from the draft as Territorial Exemptions. Doing so, the first pick from 1973 to 1982 became the #19 overall selection in the Draft, rather than strictly #1. Territorial Exemptions were reduced to one Draft exemption selection in 1983 and 1984. The practice was terminated altogether prior to the 1985 Draft
7. From 2013 to 2015, the CFL Draft consisted of seven rounds of selections, and from 1997 to 2012 the Draft concluded after six rounds. In 2016, the CFL Draft expanded from seven to eight rounds. In 2019, it was determined that the two teams with the highest waiver priority would each get to make one Territorial Draft Pick at the end of the second round.
8. There have been 26 players selected multiple time with Garnett Bertland (McGill) and Paul Desjardins (Ottawa) being chosen three times each.

A SHORT HISTORY OF THE CANADIAN DRAFT

The annual college draft has proven to be a valuable source of Canadian football talent for the Canadian Football League, but it went through a number of organizational changes over the years before it became the stable operation it is today.

Prior to 1953, college players were assigned to member Clubs on the basis of territorial rights. In 1953, the first draft involved only the four eastern teams - Montréal, Ottawa, Toronto and Hamilton - with the selection limited to players from five eastern universities, being McGill, Queen's, Toronto, Western Ontario and McMaster. Out west, where there were only a few universities competing, territorial rights continued to prevail.

By 1956, the four eastern and five western Clubs started serious discussions about the formation of a single league in Canada. Thus the Canadian Football Council was created, which later evolved into the present day Canadian Football League. Among the council recommendations was a national draft in which all nine Clubs participated. The first such draft was held in 1956, and continued until 1959.

In 1960, an argument occurred over the scarcity of draftable talent from the western universities, and the reluctance of many eastern draftees to move west to join the drafting team. There were only four western Canadian universities playing football at that time, namely UBC, Alberta, Saskatchewan, and Manitoba, so the BC, Edmonton, Saskatchewan and Winnipeg Clubs were awarded rights to those players. Since Calgary did not have a university, the Stampeders were allowed to continue to participate in the eastern draft; this arrangement continued in 1961 and 1962.

In 1963, the list of draft candidates was expanded to include all degree-granting schools in Canada, so all nine CFL Clubs again participated on the basis of the waiver priority. There continued to be disputes over the eligibility of certain players to be drafted until the current set of draft rules was established in 1970.

Up to this point, only players attending Canadian schools were eligible for the draft. If a Canadian player attended school in the USA, he belonged to the Club in which territory he was domiciled. In 1973, it was agreed to extend the draft to include Canadians attending schools outside of Canada, although each Club was permitted to exempt from the draft and retain territorial rights on two players from its area, whether they attended schools inside or outside of Canada.

The right of a Club to exempt two territorial players from the draft were reduced to one Draft exemption selection in 1983 and 1984, and the practice was terminated altogether prior to the 1985. However, prior to the 2019 Draft, it was determined that the two teams with the highest waiver priority would each get to make one Territorial Draft Pick at the end of the second round.

The site of the annual draft also went through a transition process. Until 1969, it was an item on the League's Annual Meeting agenda, with the doors open to the media during this part of the meeting. It may be noted that in those days, the draft was something of a lottery, as illustrated by the following extract from the minutes of the 1969 Annual Meeting:

"...It was pointed out that while the Commissioner's office had distributed the information as it was received from the colleges there could be no guarantee that the players listed were in fact eligible for the current draft, or that other players not listed were not eligible. Consequently, a Club would select at its own risk. If the player selected was eligible, such selection would supersede all other claims for that player's service. If he was not eligible the selection would be meaningless..."

Consequently, the draft became a function of the General Managers Committee at its Annual Meeting. An ad hoc committee met with Canadian Intercollegiate Athletic Union (CIAU) officials to develop a more accurate information system, which gradually improved to the present.

Commencing in 1985, the draft became a theatrical production similar to the Academy Awards with the first few rounds on national television. This proved to be very costly, with the expenses of hiring a hall and flying players to the site, so it was discontinued after the 1995 draft, to be replaced by the current telephone conference method.

The net result is that the League's By-laws now provide strict guidelines to the effect that, among other things:

- The college player cannot play in the League without being subject to the draft.
- The player shall be declared eligible for the draft only once in his career.
- The player must qualify as a national player.
