1. Gm #40 - Toronto at Montréal Notes:

- **Return to Montreal:** Toronto's **Marc Trestman** returns to Montreal as a head coach for the first time since his last regular season game there on **October 28, 2012** (a 27-25 win over Edmonton). In his five seasons as Montreal's head coach he compiled a record of 59-31 .656 overall. This will be his first ever game coaching against the Alouettes and is the first of a back-to-back set vs Montreal.
- **Career All-Time Record - Home Games:** Trestman's five Montreal clubs compiled a record of **36-9 .800 at home**, the best home record of any coach with a minimum of 40 games across all of CFL history to 2016:

- **John Bowman 115 Career Sacks:** Research completed in this past week into John Bowman's career provides the following breakdown in multiple ways highlighted by his **25 QB Sacks against Toronto** - more than any other opponent. In addition, a breakdown is shown of the opposing QBs who have been taken down by Bowman since 2006, all 37 of them. This week's opposing starter Ricky Ray has been sacked 5 times in his career by Bowman.

Ray's replacement QBs have fared far better than most mid-season situations where clubs lose their #1 QB and are forced to make a change for injury. Toronto has gone **4-1 .800** in these five mid-season situations since 2012 when Ray joined the Argos. In fact, since 2012 the Argos are **27-32 .458** when Ray has started and **19-19 .500** when he has been on either the sidelines.

- **Since August 17, 2013:** That day marked the final start of **Anthony Calvillo's** playing career and since then the Alouettes have had a CFL-high **10 different QB starters** (Neiswander, Marsh, Smith, Brink, Crompton, Cato, Glenn, Bridge, Adams & Durant). That is 10 QB starters over a span of 71 games and includes 16 week-to-week changes in QB starter. Here are the number of different starters by club since August 2013:

1. Gm #40 - Toronto at Montréal Notes:

- **1-4 lately / battle for 1st Place:** The Als have lost 4 of their last 5 games to drop to 2-4 but are a win in this game away from taking over first place at 3-4 ahead of Toronto on a tie-breaker and with a better winning percentage. Thanks to David Arseneault of RDS for the idea, Montreal can take over first place in the East with a win for the first time since **November 7, 2014**. They were in first with one game left in 2014 losing 29-15 to Hamilton in their final game to drop to 2nd place on Nov 8/14.
 - **Darian Durant:** The MTL QB will be making career start #120 this week and has a career record of **60-58-1 .508** (2-4 for Montreal). In head-to-head meetings with Ricky Ray, Durant has a **5-7** mark in their 12 games against one another. Durant comes into this week off of back-to-back 300-yard games; the last time had 3 in a row at 300+ was back in **September 2013**.
 - **Nik Lewis 1011:** The Als' veteran made 8 receptions last game to move up to #3 all-time with 1,011 for his career. With 6 more catches he can tie Ben Cahoon for #2 all-time at 1,017 and he is now 18 short of matching record-holder Geroy Simon at 1,029.
 - **Montreal Off a Bye 1-1:** The Alouettes coming off a bye had two entirely different results in 2016, a 31-7 loss at home to Hamilton in July and a 38-11 win in Toronto on Oct 2/16. In 2015, Montreal was also 1-1 coming off a bye week.
 - **Montreal 1st Quarters & Finishes:** Over their first 5 games the Als scored only 16 First Quarter points - last time out they had a season-high 14 pts in the first 15:00 at Winnipeg but could not hold on to win. They wound losing by a single point; that made all four of their defeats in 2017 by 7 points or less. In two of their losses, they have held leads of 10 points or more.
 - **Boris Bede:** His FG statistics show a real turnaround from 2016 when he made just 11-of-21 attempts (52.4%) and missed three from inside 40 yards. He is 15-of-16 this year to lead the CFL at 94% and is a perfect 11-of-11 inside the 40-yard line missing only once from 45 yards out. He has made his last 15 FG attempts after a miss on the season's first drive in Week #1.
 - **Cody Fajardo:** Stepped in for Ricky Ray last game and led most of four drives in the 2nd half. Three of those four possessions resulted in scores with a 98-yard TD drive the highlight capping the final plays of that contest. Fajardo's play against the Calgary defence took the score from 34-10 to a final count of 41-24. He passed for 75 yards on 6-of-11 attempts.
 - **Toronto defensive split / Victor Butler:** The Argos allowed just 22.7 points per game over their first three contests in 2017, but that has jumped to 34.0 ppg since then. In games that Victor Butler has started they are **3-2**, when he has not played Toronto is **0-2**.
 - **Toronto starters:** The Argos have started 34 different players this season split evenly on offence and defence. By contrast Montreal has started the second-fewest number in the CFL at just 31.
 - **40 points on offence last game:** The Alouettes' 40 points scored by their offence in Week #6 was their highest output since Aug 19/16 and 43-19 win at Ottawa. They scored on 8 of their 13 drives with 4 TDs and 4 field goals with just a pair of 2-&-Outs.
 - **B.J. Cunningham:** Has a modest streak going of consecutive 100-yard receiving games for the first time in his career. He will be trying to become the first Montreal player with three 100's in a row since Duron Carter's 3 in a row in July-August 2016. Cunningham now has a catch in 22 straight games
 - **Rutley & Beaulieu - 118 and 7:** The Montreal duo of rushers combined for 118 yards on just 13 carries last game for an average of 9.1 yards per carry and 7 first downs.
 - **Bear Woods:** Has made 17 defensive tackles in the last two games and in total defensive plays now ranks #3 in the CFL with 50. Marcus Ball is also in the Top 10 with 42 (#8).

2. CFL Trends & Highlights Heading Into Week #8:

- Overall Inter-Divisional Win Streaks:** West Division clubs have won the last 9, and 15 of the last 16 inter-divisional games after sweeping Week #7. The CFL record for most consecutive wins by one Division over the other is long though and very recent being set at **17 games in a row in 2016**. That streak stretched from August 20, 2016 to October 21, 2016. Here are the top 5 streaks since 1961 (when inter-divisional play began):

- Andrew Harris - 1000-1000:** Harris is chasing a mark that has never been reached in CFL history - rushing and receiving totals of 1,000 yards in the same season. Only **ONE** player has ever had 800+ rushing and receiving yards in the same season, a pace that Harris is on in 2017, and he is also close to 1,000 yard receiving pace, a milestone never reached by a running back:

- CFL Receiving Leaders Weeks #5-7:** Andrew Harris and Bryan Burnham are the CFL's top receivers over the last three weeks with Harris at 24 catches and Burnham the only player with 300+ yards. Brad Sinopoli has made the most of his receptions as 11 of the 22 have gone for 2nd down conversions. Sinopoli leads the CFL with 19 for the season - of his 277 career receptions, 85 of them have been 2nd down conversion catches (31%).

- Reilly and Lulay on top of QUAR:** Travis Lulay and Mike Reilly have risen to be #1-2 in the CFL's Quarterback rating system through Week #7 with marks of **94.9** and **94.5** out of 100 for 2017. Reilly is #1 among all QBs with at least 60 drives led and is even higher than the **87.6** QUAR Rating he had in 2016.

2. CFL Trends & Highlights Heading Into Week #8:

- **6-0 Starts:** Edmonton has started 2017 at 6-0 and become the **16th team in CFL history** to do so. Across the 1948 to 2016 seasons, this happened only 2.5% of the time (15 times in 602 team seasons). Here are some historical observations on 6-0 starts:

Among the 15 teams through 2016 to start 6-0 or better ...

- None has ever missed the playoffs
- 12 out of the 15 clubs who started 6-0 extended their run to **7-0** at least (80%)
- Surprisingly only 3 out of these 15 starters at 6-0 went on to WIN the Grey Cup (20%)
- Edmonton has now made it to 6-0 on 3 occasions (1955, 1961 & 2017)
- Calgary has started 6-0 the most times since 1948: **5 times** (1948, 1949, 1991, 1993 and 1995)

- **2nd Down Conversion catches:** Over the last four seasons Brad Sinopoli and Greg Ellingson have been among the leaders in this key receiving stat - here are the CFL's top 2nd down conversion receivers since 2014 (2014-2017 seasons):

- **Roy Finch:** Leads the CFL with a 17.7 yard punt return average and this is well above the existing CFL record set by Leon Bright in 1980 at 16.81 yards per attempt, just ahead of Larry Highbaugh's 16.79 average in 1975. Finch is well ahead of the Calgary record of 14.9 yards set by Pee Wee Smith in 1991.

- **CFL Rushing Leaders Weeks #5-7:** Jerome Messam is far ahead of the competition in recent weeks with 302 yards over the last three weeks to take the league lead at 490 yards in total. Messam, Jeremiah Johnson and Cameron Marshall are the only players on pace to reach 1,000 yards in 2017 with Messam's at 1,260 yards (490 yards after 7 games).

- **Downfield Passing 20+ yards:** **Ricky Ray** leads the CFL in completions where the receiver is deeper than 20 yards downfield with 25 (0-for-3 last week however) followed by **Mike Reilly** at 21 and **Bo Levi Mitchell** with 20. **Travis Lulay** has been the most accurate thus far in that range at 61.5% and last week vs Saskatchewan completed passes of 49, 26, 35, 38, 50, 21 & 13 yards when throwing deeper than 20 yards downfield (the 13-yarder was a TD pass deep into the end zone):

- **Greg Ellingson 100.3 yards:** Ellingson is the only player averaging over 100 yards per game receiving this year - something that has only been done 4 times in the last 20 years. Only Adarius Bowman (2016, 103.6), Jamel Richardson (2011, 104.5), Geroy Simon (2006, 103.1) and Milt Stegall (2002, 105.3) have gone over 100 per game since 1998.

2. CFL Trends & Highlights Heading Into Week #8:

- **Ottawa 7 close games - 5 points or less:** The REDBLACKS are the **ONLY team in CFL history** to have each of their first SEVEN games of a season all decided by 5 points or less. The only two teams to come close to that are Hamilton in 1999 with their first 6 games decided by 7 points or less as have Montreal in 2017.
- **0-6 Starts:** Hamilton has started out 0-6 and become the 18th team in CFL history to do so. Only **ONE** team has ever managed to rebound from 6 straight losses off the top and make the playoffs: **BC in 1969** (5-11). However, that must be qualified as this was accomplished before the **Crossover Rule** came into effect in 1996.
- **Darian Durant 62 yards:** Durant (30,247) needs only 62 more yards to pass Tom Burgess (30,308) and join the Top 15 all-time. Durant needs 135 yards to pass Sam Etcheverry (30,381) for #14.
- **After the 3rd Quarter:** Through 29 games, teams that have been able to gain the lead heading the 4th Quarter have lost just 6 times winning 77% of the time in untied contests. No team has more than one comeback when trailing after the 3rd Quarter.
- **Edmonton Injured List:** The Eskimos have already had 27 players spend at least one game on the IL this season and had 20 on the IL last week alone. Across the full season here is the IL total for Edmonton - 2017: 27 players, 2016: 34, 2015: 41, 2014: 46.
- **EDM 100+ Rushers:** The Esks seem to be able to start a running back that reaches the 100-yard mark despite having to swap frequently due to injury. They have already had **3 different RB starters post a 100-yard game** in 2017. In just 6 games, that is only one short of the CFL record of 4 players. Only 5 clubs since 1950 have had 4 different players record a 100-game in the same season - Winnipeg: 1960, Ottawa: 1960, Calgary: 1962, Saskatchewan: 1976 and Calgary: 2014 (Cornish, Walter, Mallett, Charles).
- **2-&-Out Rate:** The 2-&-Out appears to be declining rapidly as clubs have improved their ability to convert on 2nd down opportunities. The 2-&-Out rate has declined every year since 2014 and by 37% since 2013:

Thursday's loss to the Stampeders. In five of his last seven games, Woods has notched 6+ tackles. Woods, who set the Alouettes club record for tackles in a season (126), is currently averaging six tackles a game and on pace to register 118 tackles this season which would surpass Chris Gaines' 117 recorded in 1990 for second all-time in Argos history.

SJ GREEN: After suffering a significant season ending knee injury just one year ago, SJ Green have proved doubters wrong so far this season. Ranked second in the CFL in receiving with 43 catches for 673 yards and three touchdowns through seven games, the 11-year veteran is currently on pace to record the best season of his career with 110 catches for 1,730 yards which would rank him fourth all-time in Argos history in receiving yards in a single-season.

RETURNING TO FAMILIAR TERRITORY: On Friday night in Montreal, Argos GM Jim Popp and head coach Marc Trestman will make their first returns to Percival Molson Stadium. The tandem spent five seasons together in the same roles with the Alouettes from 2008-12, guiding the Als to four division titles, five playoff appearances, three Grey Cup appearances and back-to-back-Grey Cup Championships in 2008-09.

Popp held the GM position for 21 years in Montreal, and saw his teams make the playoffs in 19 of those years with 10 first place finishes. Under his watch, the Als went 227-150-1 from 1996-2016.

Meanwhile, Trestman who returned to the CFL this year after five seasons in the NFL, held a 59-31 records with the Alouettes during his tenure and never missed the playoffs.

Thursday night will not only mark a first time visit for the Argos leadership but also WR **SJ Green** and LB **Bear Woods**, both of whom traded in the Als jerseys for Double Blue this offseason.

Green, who currently leads the Argos and ranks second in the CFL in receiving with 43 catches for 673 yards and three touchdowns, played 116 games in 10 seasons with Montreal. During that time, Green hauled in 444 passes for 6,636 yards and 42 touchdowns before suffering a season ending knee injury in 2016. He was traded to Toronto this past off-season in exchange for a sixth round CFL Draft pick.

Woods played five seasons with the Als and set the club's single-season record in tackles last season with 126. The two-time East Division Most Outstanding Defensive Player was released by Montreal at the start of training camp before signing in Toronto as a free agent. Since arriving in the Big Smoke, Woods has proved his worth ranking third in the CFL in total defensive plays (50) and second in tackles with 46.

Additionally, Canadian DT Jeff Finley, who is having a career season and recorded two sacks last week vs. Calgary, will also make his return to Montreal this week.

BEAR CHOPPING WOOD: Since arriving in Toronto during training camp, Argos linebacker **Bear Woods** has shown his worth. The six-year CFL veteran ranks third in the CFL and leads the Argos with 46 defensive tackles, nine of which came in last

NEWS & NOTES:

- Argos kicker **Lirim Hajrullahu** continues to lead the league in field goals attempted (29) and made (24) heading into Week 8 of CFL action. His 29 field goal attempts are seven more than the next closest place kicker while his 24 converted field goals are five more. Additionally, Hajrullahu needs to convert 14 more field goals this season to surpass his East Division All-Star totals from last season. The Western product is currently averaging 3.4 field goals converted per game while attempting an average of 4.1 field goals through seven weeks. If he continues on this pace, he is set to record a career-high 61-of-74 field goals which would surpass Lance Chomyc's mark of 55 field goals made in 1991.
- Canadian defensive tackle **Jeff Finley** recorded his second game this season with a pair of sacks. Finley finished last Thursday's tilt vs. Calgary with a career-high five tackles and two sacks.
- RB/KR **Martese Jackson** will get his first taste of action against his former team on Friday night in Montreal. Jackson, who spent last season on the Als practice roster, has compiled 962 combined yards (46 receiving, 251 punt return, 600 kick return and 65 miss field goal) despite only playing in five games this season. Jackson currently sits 181 behind league-leader Chris Rainey. Last week vs. the Stamps, he posted 226 combined yards on the night, his highest yardage total since his CFL debut in Winnipeg in Week 4.
- First-year Argonaut **Dylan Wynn** notched both his first career sack and first career game with multiple sacks last week vs. Calgary; he had a season-high four tackles and two sacks vs. the Stamps.
- 2017 CFL Draft pick **Nakas Onyeka** was a special teams ace for the Double Blue on Thursday night. The Wilfrid Laurier product led the team with three special teams tackles after recording his first career tackle last week in Regina.
- The Argos D brought down Bo Levi Mitchell a season-high five times on the night while getting to Andrew Buckley once. Entering Week 7, Calgary had given up a total of four sacks in their previous six games and had not allowed a single sack in the previous two games. Toronto now has a total of 25 sacks through seven weeks, only 13 less (38) than the team recorded in 2016.
- 2015 CFL Draft pick **Lievi Noel** has been a special teams ace for the Double Blue over since arriving in Toronto. This season, the Toronto native currently ranks tied for third in the CFL in special teams tackles with 10. Noel, who led the club with 19 STT in 2016, is only nine shy from matching his numbers as a rookie.
