

WHAT TO DO **BEFORE YOU FLY.**







Check the visa requirements for the UAE.



Take international travel insurance.



Complete and sign the UAE health and quarantine declaration forms



Take a PCR test ahead of travel. Obtain certificate showing you are COVID-19 negative, issued within 96 hours of arrival.

Take a PCR test on arrival in Dubai.



RETURNING RESIDENTS



Apply for approval to return to Dubai on the Dubai's General Directorate of Residency and Foreigners Affairs (GDRFA) website.



Complete and sign the UAE health and quarantine declaration forms



UAE CITIZENS AND RESIDENTS



Check the IATA Travel Centre website to understand if any restrictions are in place at the destination of travel.



Make sure you book a return ticket.



Take international travel insurance.



Complete and sign the UAE health and quarantine declaration forms.



WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU ARRIVE.



EVERYONE ARRIVING IN DUBAI



Take a PCR test at Dubai International (unless you are able to present a negative result certificate issued within the last 96 hours).



Quarantine until the results of the test have been received.



If the results are positive for COVID-19, a 14 day quarantine period must be observed.



Download the COVID19 - DXB Smart App (from Apple App Store or from Google Play Store) to register with the Dubai Health Authority before leaving the airport. There is free Wi-Fi available at Dubai International.



Comply with all the precautionary COVID-19 measures in place in Dubai, including wearing a mask, observing social distancing and washing your hands regularly.
