



MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

COOK

- I-55: \$454 million for the rehabilitation of 49 bridges from the Chinatown feeder ramps to Wolf Road including the reconstruction of the Illinois 50 (Cicero Avenue) and Illinois 43 (Harlem Avenue) interchanges in Chicago.
- I-80 (Eastbound): \$59.1 million for bridge replacement at I-294 in Hazel Crest.
- I-90/94: \$12.9 million for bridge deck overlays at Ogden Avenue in Chicago.
- I-94: \$18.1 million for bridge replacement at Devon Avenue in Chicago and Lincolnwood.
- I-190 at Bessie Coleman Drive to I-90 (Kennedy Expressway) and I-294: \$761 million for a new interchange, new bridge, bridge replacements, reconstruction and construction of auxiliary lanes, additional ramps in Chicago and Rosemont.
- I-290: \$50 million for 12.4 miles of standard overlay from I-88 to east of Ashland Avenue.
- I-290 Corridor: \$1.3 billion for bridge replacement, rehabilitation, interchange reconstruction, and drainage from Mannheim Road to Racine Avenue.
- U.S. 12/20/45 (95th Street): \$93 million for several bridge replacements, intersection reconstruction and additional improvements at Stony Island Avenue in Chicago.
- U.S. 20: \$127.9 million for construction of a new interchange, retaining walls and bridge replacement at Shales Parkway in Elgin.
- Illinois 43: \$128 million for a railroad grade separation at the BRC Railroad in Bedford Park.
- Ida B. Wells Drive: \$27.1 million for bridge superstructure replacement, superstructure rehabilitation and new bridge deck at the Old Post Office in Chicago.
- Kedzie Avenue: \$39.1 million for a bridge superstructure replacement over CSXT RR and Wireton Road in Blue Island.
- Pershing Road: \$64.5 million for bridge replacement and pedestrian and bicycle improvements at Racine Avenue and at CN Railroad in Chicago.
- Willow Road: \$27 million for resurfacing on 1 mile, additional lanes, intersection improvement, pedestrian and bicycle improvements, and additional improvements from east of the Des Plaines River to Waterview Drive/Protection Parkway in Glenview and Prospect Heights.

DUPAGE

- I-290: \$55.2 million for bridge replacement and culvert replacement at I-355 and at Spring Brook in Itasca.
- Illinois 38: \$42 million for resurfacing on 1 mile, widening of existing pavement, drainage, intersection reconstruction and patching from Winfield Road to County Farm Road.

KANE

• Illinois 47/U.S. 30: \$86.4 million for reconstruction and construction of additional lanes for 2.4 miles, pedestrian and bicycle improvements, bridge replacements, culvert replacements, water main, sewer, and railroad relocation from Cross Street to Galena Road in Sugar Grove and Yorkville.

LAKE

- **U.S. 41:** \$93.4 million for interchange reconstruction, construction of auxiliary lanes, pedestrian and bicycle improvements, bridge replacement, storm sewer, drainage and grading at Illinois 176 in Lake Bluff and North Chicago.
- U.S. 45: \$37.8 million for construction of additional lanes, reconstruction of 2 miles, and pedestrian and bicycle improvements from Illinois 132 to Washington Street.
- Illinois 120: \$25.8 million for reconstruction and construction of additional lanes for nearly 1 mile as well as pedestrian and bicycle improvements from Ashford Lane to U.S. 45 in Gravslake.
- Illinois 131: \$98.7 for reconstruction and construction of additional lanes for 2.5 miles as well as a pump station and pedestrian and bicycle improvements from Wadsworth Road to Sunset Avenue in Beach Park.

MCHENRY

• Illinois 31: \$209 million for reconstruction and construction of additional lanes for 6.7 miles, pedestrian and bicycle improvements, culvert replacements, drainage improvements, traffic signal modernization and ADA improvements from Illinois 120 to Illinois 176 in McHenry, Prairie Grove and Crystal Lake.

WILL

- I-55: \$144.4 million for interchange reconstruction and bridge replacement at Lorenzo Road and at Illinois 129, also auxiliary lanes and resurfacing from Illinois 129 to Lorenzo.
- I-55: \$192.8 million for bridge replacements and construction of interchanges at Airport Road/Lockport Road and at Illinois 126 in Romeoville.
- I-57: \$185.5 million for new interchange and railroad crossing construction at Eagle Lake Road.
- I-80 from Ridge Road to U.S. 30: \$610.8 million for multiple bridge replacements, including aging, obsolete structures over the Des Plaines River. Interchange reconstruction and bridge replacements at both the Center Street Interchange and Chicago Street. Capacity enhancements include auxiliary lanes and shoulders in Joliet, New Lenox and Minooka.
- U.S. 52: \$93.4 million for reconstruction and construction of additional lanes, pedestrian and bicycle improvements, bridge widening, turning lanes, culvert
 extension and bridge repairs from River Road to Houbolt Road in Shorewood and Joliet.
- Illinois 53/U.S. 52: \$49 million for intersection improvements as well as pedestrian and bicycle improvements from Patterson Road to Arsenal Road in Joliet, Elwood and Wilmington.
