### Telenet adjusts ExpressNet and TurboNet volumes

New data volumes for standard internet and top internet packages as of August 1 2008

Mechelen, May 21 2008 - **On August 1st Telenet will increase the volumes of its ExpressNet and TurboNet internet packages. The available volume for ExpressNet users will increase to 20 Gigabytes (GB) per month. For TurboNet the available volume will rise to 60 GB per month. Telenet internet users will thereby enjoy not only superfast internet, but also significantly more data volume. Telenet is also announcing a significant reduction in the price of extra volume 'blocks' in the summer.**

"Over the past years we have mainly invested in higher upload and download speeds for all our internet products" notes Jo van Gorp, Executive Vice President Residential Marketing at Telenet. "Nowadays our customers require extra volume due to the large offer of video and music on the internet and the possibilities presented by Web 2.0. This is why in April of this year we adjusted the volumes of BasicNet and ComfortNet and will now increase the monthly volume of ExpressNet by 66% to 20 GB per month and TurboNet by 71% to 60 GB per month. These volumes should enable our customers to fully enjoy even the most demanding internet applications."

The volume increases will come into effect from August 1st 2008. Customers do not need to do anything to benefit from these improvements. Via their Telemeter they will be able to verify that they possess 20 GB per month for ExpressNet and 60 GB per month for TurboNet.

#### **Extra volume price adjustment**

Telenet is also planning a price reduction in the summer for the purchase of extra volume blocks, to offer users of introductory and light internet packages the option of purchasing extra volume at attractive rates should they have the need.

These volume adjustments set the tone for a long-term strategy in which Telenet combines superfast internet with large data volumes.



## **Note to the editor :**

*Overview of important internet milestones over the past two years :*

### **August 2008**

ExpressNet: Increase of the volume limit from 12 GB to 20 GB

TurboNet Increase of the volume limit from 35 GB to 60 GB

### **April 2008**

BasicNet: Increase of the volume limit from 400 MB to 1 GB

ComfortNet: Doubling of the volume limit from 1 GB to 2 GB

### **December 2007**

BasicNet: Doubling of the downstream speed

ComfortNet: Fourfold increase of the downstream speed and increase of the upstream speed by 33%.

ExpressNet: Doubling of the upstream speed to 512 Kbps. (phased launch – ready in May 2008)

TurboNet: Doubling of the upstream speed to 1 Mbps. (phased launch – ready in May 2008)

### **April 2007**

All subscriptions: Until April 2007 upload traffic was limited to a maximum of 20% of the downstream volume. That meant that with, for example, an ExpressNet connection, you could send a maximum of 2 GB of data. As of April we no longer differentiate between the up and download volume.

### **Augustus 2006**

ComfortNet: Doubling of speed from 512 Kbps to 1 Mbps and an increase in the download limit from 400 MB to 1 GB

### **April 2006**

ExpressNet : Increase in download speed from 6 Mbps to 10 Mbps

### **January 2006**

TurboNet: Doubling of the downstream speed from 10 Mbps to 20 Mbps

All subscriptions: increase of the monthly volume limit by 20%. ExpressNet will increase from 10 GB to 12 GB and TurboNet from 30 GB to 35 GB.
