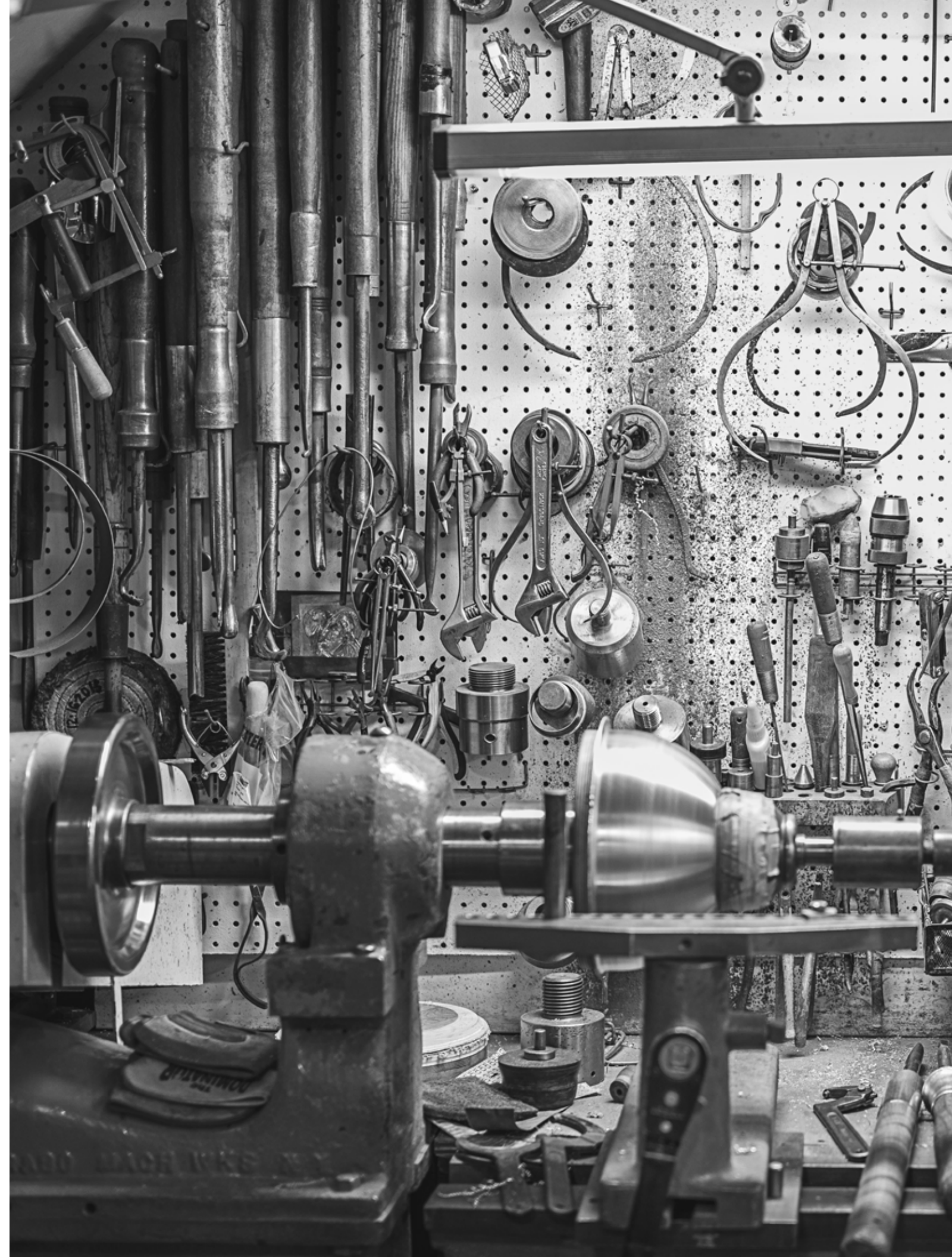


Hollowware: A Solid Legacy

In 1851, Charles Lewis Tiffany entered an exclusive partnership with prominent silversmith, John C. Moore, to manufacture silver hollowware. Around this time, the U.S. adopted the jeweler's standard for silver—925 parts per 1,000—enhancing Tiffany's growing reputation for excellence. Upon opening his hollowware workshop in Manhattan, Mr. Tiffany commissioned silversmiths or "Tiffany Makers" to handcraft trophies, beginning with the Woodlawn Vase in 1860.

While the workshop has moved from Newark and Parsippany, New Jersey to its current location in Cumberland, Rhode Island, many of the techniques from a century ago are still used today. Each trophy is stamped with "TIFFANY & CO. MAKERS," "Ag925" to denote sterling silver and an individually registered serial number.

Designing and crafting more than 65 custom trophies each year, Tiffany & Co. is the world's authority in hollowware and has been for over a century and a half.

The Vince Lombardi Trophy

Awarded each year to the champions of the Super Bowl®, Tiffany & Co. has proudly created the Vince Lombardi trophy since 1967. Named after the legendary Green Bay Packers coach and NFL® executive who led the team to victory at the first two Super Bowls in 1966 and '67, the sterling silver design recalls a regulation-sized football.

The Larry O'Brien Championship Trophy

Presented to the winning team of the NBA® Finals, Tiffany has crafted the sterling silver and 24k gold vermeil trophy since 1977. While it kept the Walter A. Brown name until 1984 when it was renamed after former NBA® Commissioner Larry O'Brien, the trophy was first awarded following the Portland Trail Blazers' 4-2 series win over the Philadelphia 76ers in the 1977 NBA® Finals.

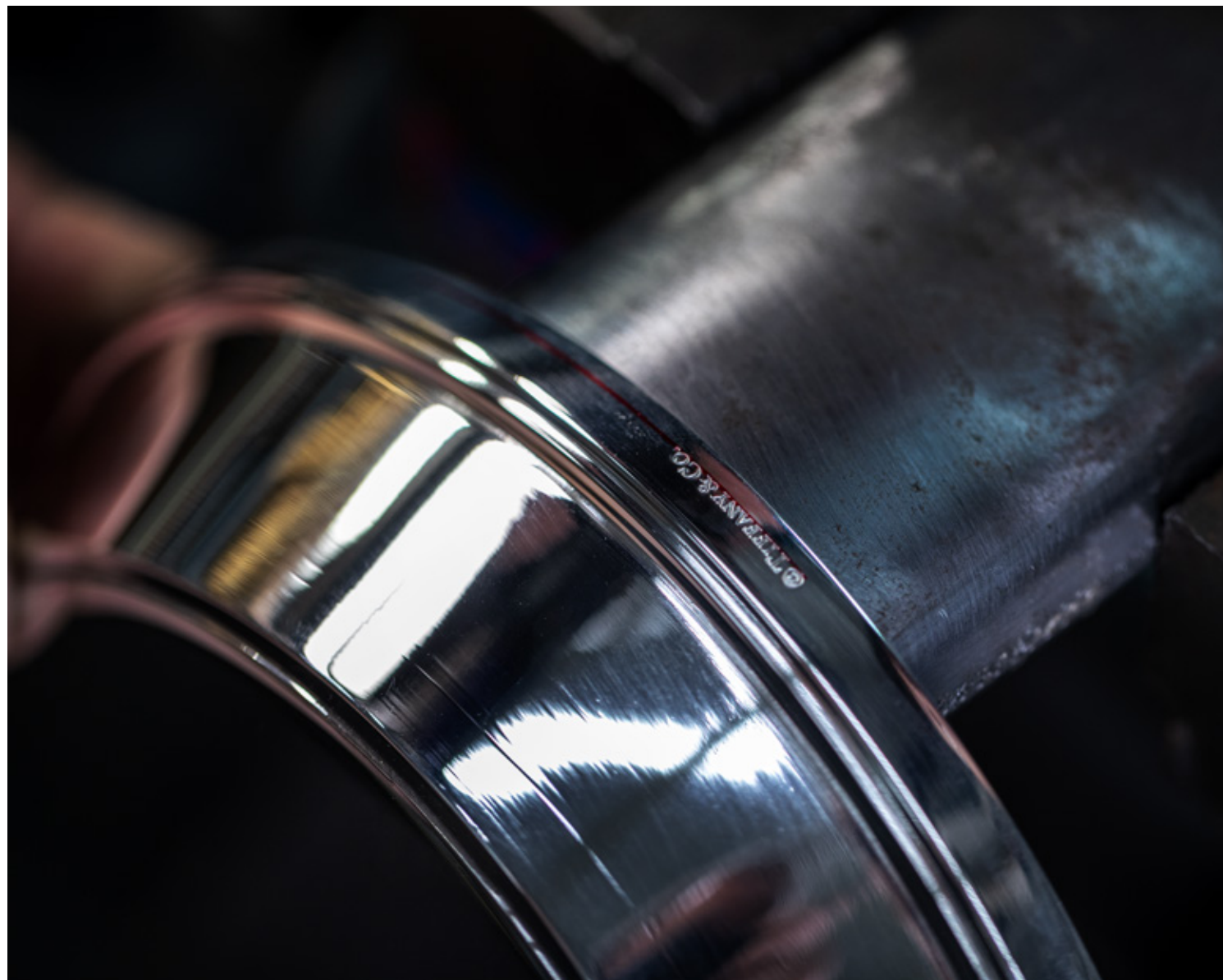

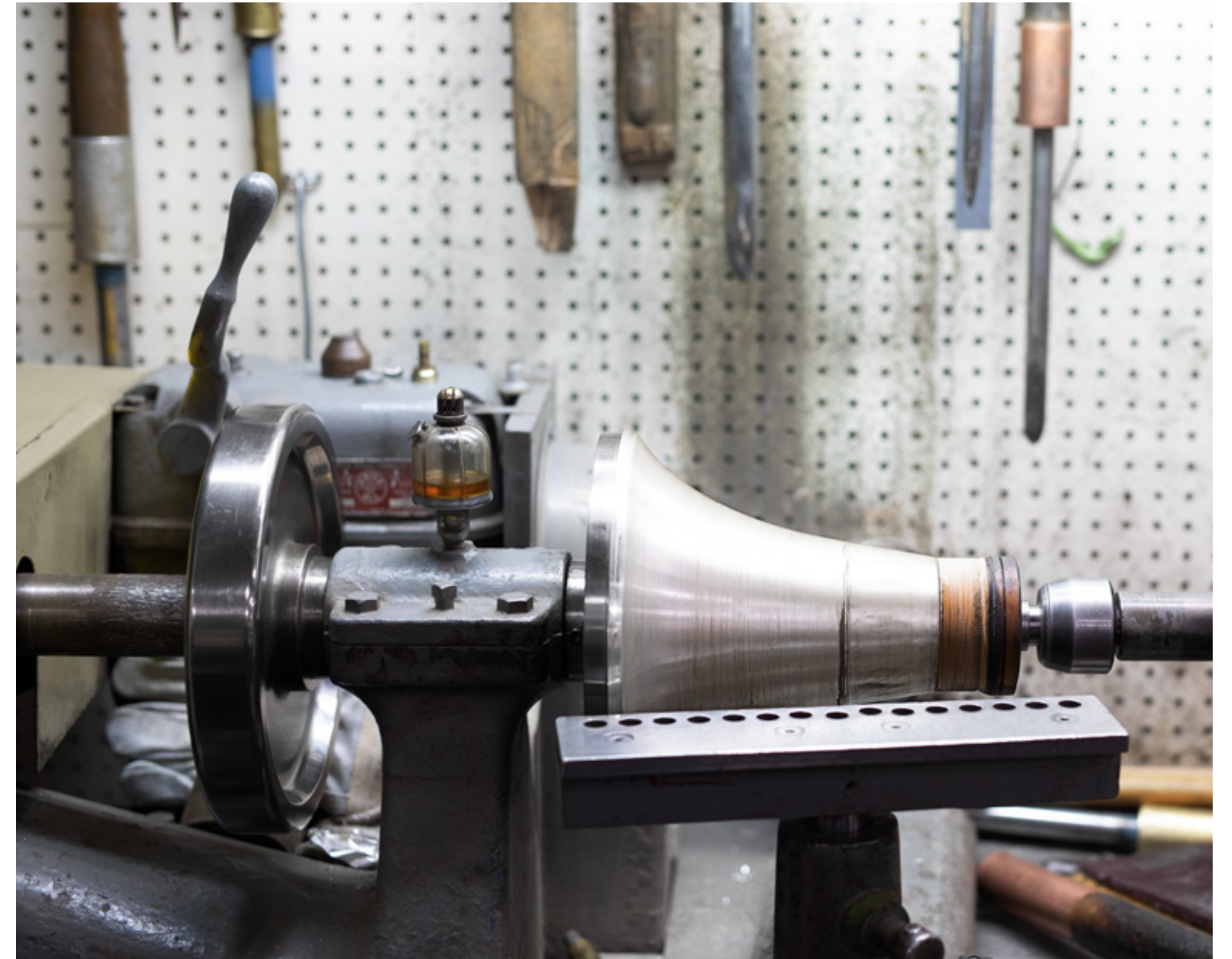

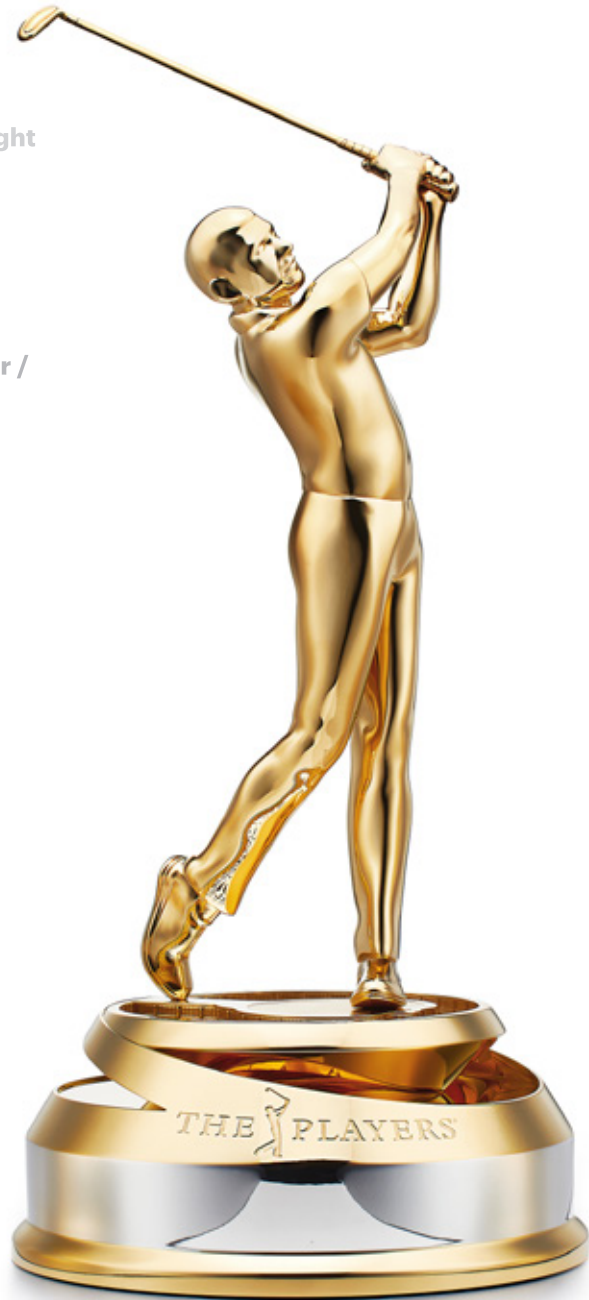
THE PLAYERS[®] Championship Trophy


