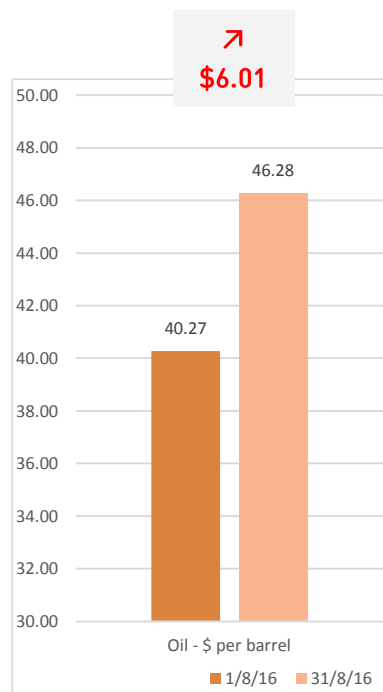
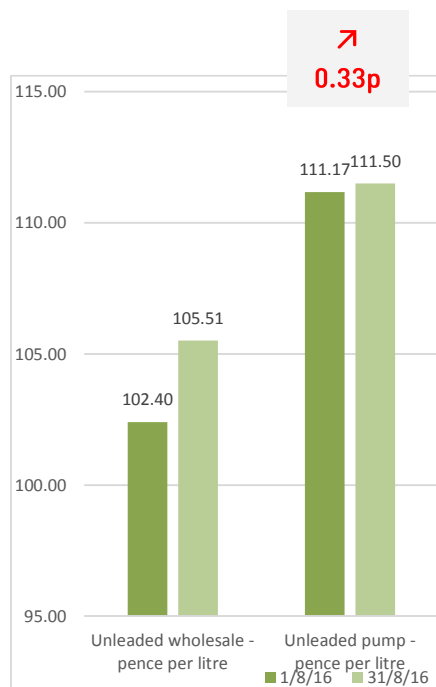


UK fuel prices in August 2016



Crude oil

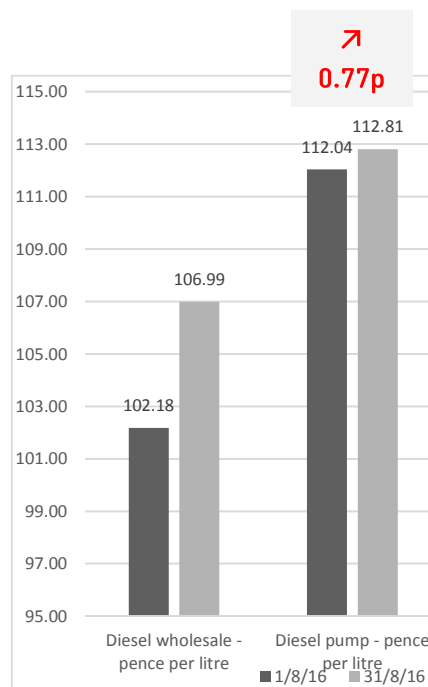
Price of a barrel of oil **rose \$6.01** to \$46.28



Unleaded

Wholesale price **rose 3.11p** to 105.51p per litre

Pump price **rose 0.33p** to 111.5p per litre



Diesel

Wholesale price **rose 4.81p** to 106.99p per litre

Pump price **rose 0.77p** to 112.81p per litre

Two week price predictor

from 1 September 2016

→ Unleaded — **little change expected**

→ Diesel — **little change expected**

Our view on prices

"There was a strong case for a 3p per litre cut in the price of petrol and diesel in late July, and it was a relief to see re-tailers going some way towards passing on savings to motorists at the start of August.

"Since this point however, the oil price has rebounded slightly which has had the effect of pushing up wholesale fuel prices again.
