



## Two week price predictor

from 1 September 2016

- → Unleaded little change expected
- → Diesel little change expected

### Our view on prices

"There was a strong case for a 3p per litre cut in the price of petrol and diesel in late July, and it was a relief to see retailers going some way towards passing on savings to motorists at the start of August.

"Since this point however, the oil price has rebounded slightly which has had the effect of pushing up wholesale fuel prices again.
