Depending on the features of the connected earphones, users can let the self-adjusting mode in the Watch app automatically set noise control – Active Noise Cancelling and Transparent Hearing - for when they are walking, running or just sitting and enjoying their audio. The app also allows for manual adjustment of the noise control settings.

Being on the move, listeners can leave their iPhone at home and simply connect their true wireless headphones directly to their Apple Watch to listen to their pre-stored music while controlling their sound settings from the watch.

Also featuring a low-battery warning to remind listeners to charge their headphones when the battery level drops below 20%, as well as an equalizer preset selection, Sennheiser's new Smart Control app for Apple Watch is now available.
