



## MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

#### **CHAMPAIGN**

- I-57: \$15.2 million for bridge replacement at Kirby Avenue (overhead) west of Champaign.
- U.S. 150 (Prospect Avenue): \$13.2 million for resurfacing 1.8 miles, intersection improvement and other improvements from Marketview Drive to Illinois 10 (Springfield Avenue) in Champaign.

#### **DEWITT**

 U.S. 51: \$26 million for reconstruction of 3 miles from McLean County line to Autumn Road south of Wapella.

#### DOUGLAS AND CHAMPAIGN

• I-57: \$21 million for resurfacing 12.1 miles from north of U.S. 36 to south of Sadorus Road.

#### **DOUGLAS**

• Illinois 133: \$35 million for resurfacing 11.9 miles, culvert replacements, utility adjustments, new shoulders, safety improvements and culvert extension from 0.5 mile east of I-57 to the Coles County line.

#### **EDGAR**

• **U.S. 150/Illinois 1:** \$22.9 million for resurfacing 16.7 miles (including cold milling on 6.5 miles), guardrail, ADA improvements, bridge deck overlay and land acquisition from U.S. 36 to south of Gibson Drive south of Paris.

#### MCLEAN

- I-55: \$26 million for resurfacing 9.6 miles from north of Pipeline Road northeast of Normal to south of County Highway 8 south of Lexington.
- **I-74:** \$16.5 million for resurfacing (using a preservation method) from east of U.S. 51 Business south of Bloomington to County Highway 36 at Downs.
- U.S. 51 Business: \$10 million for resurfacing 2.8 miles from Olive Street to Woodrig Road in Bloomington.

#### **PIATT**

I-72: \$26.3 million for resurfacing 10 miles from the Macon County line to Illinois 105 north of Monticello.

#### **VFRMII INN**

• **I-74:** \$16.5 million for overhead bridge replacements at Township Road 102, County Highway 11 and Township Road 34B from north of Muncie to north of Fithian.
