The GB Snowsport Alpine Ski Team is currently competing in the FIS Alpine Skiing World Cup in Adelboden, Switzerland (Men) and in Kranjska Gora, Slovenia (Women) on January 7th-8th and continues later in February with the highlight of the season - the FIS Alpine Skiing World Championships in Courchevel-Méribel, France.

At the start gate are the representatives of a promising generation of British skiers: Dave Ryding, Billy Major, Laurie Taylor and Charlie Raposo in the men's category and Alex Tilley and Charlie Guest in the women's category.

The Para-Alpine Ski Team will be on track for the Para-Alpine Skiing World Cup from January 10th-14th in Veysonnaz, Switzerland, followed by the FIS Para-Alpine Skiing World Championships in La Molina, Spain from January 18th-29th, with a medal-hopeful British team lead by the "Golden Boys", Paralympic Champions from Beijing 2022, Neil & Andrew Simpson.
