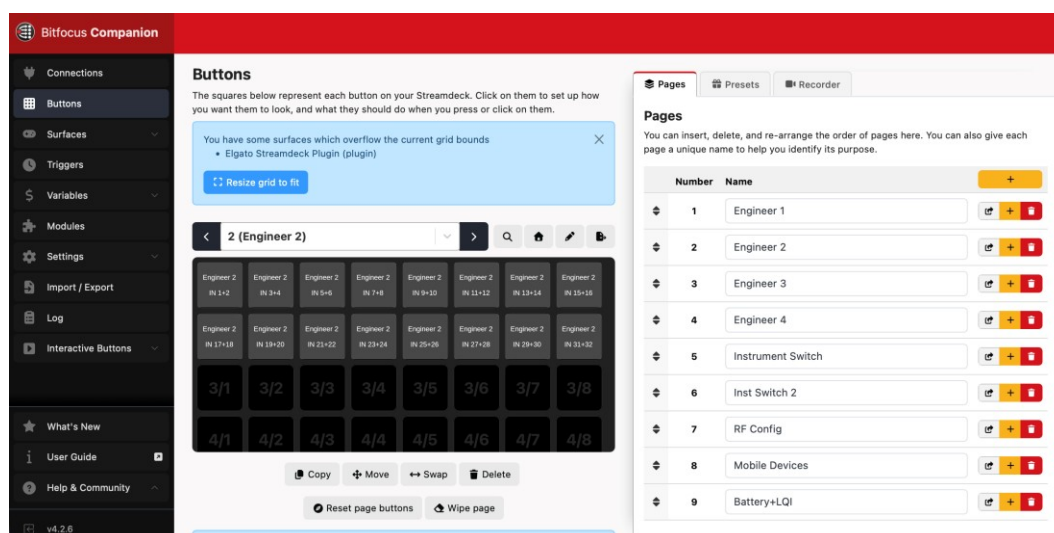




### Sennheiser Spectera module now available in Bitfocus Companion and Buttons apps
