HISTORY OF THE HEART

To date, La Mer has helped support the protection of 16 million miles of unique marine habitats across the globe.

2005: La Mer embarks on an eight-year partnership with Oceana. Highlights of La Mer's and Oceana's work include the protection of 16.1 million square miles of seafloor habitat in the North Pacific Ocean, 118 seamounts and pristine coral formations off the coast of Chile, and Leatherback sea turtle habitats off the American shores.

2010: La Mer introduces the first Limited-Edition Blue Heart Crème de La Mer that commemorates the precious blue heart of our planet.

2013: La Mer partners with National Geographic Society and renowned ocean-explorer Dr. Sylvia Earle to delve into underwater habitat protection and address actionable changes.

2014: La Mer continues its partnership with the National Geographic Society, focusing on their Emerging Explorers program to support the next generation of ocean explorers in their ground-breaking work. We commemorate biologist, Andrea Marshall, and her groundbreaking work to help save globally threatened marine wildlife.

2015: La Mer supports two new National Geographic Society Emerging Explorers: Dr. David Gruber, who studies bioluminescent and biofluorescent marine animals to expand knowledge of deep sea life, and Shannon Switzer, who works with communities to understand how they sustain their shoreline and ocean life.

2017: La Mer launches La Mer Blue Heart Oceans Fund as a way to make charitable contributions that support ocean conservation efforts around the world.

2018: La Mer Blue Heart Oceans Fund supports conservation initiatives in The Azores, Grenada and East China Sea. Through mangrove replanting efforts and sustainable fishing, we strive to reduce the effects of climate change and help conserve marine ecosystems for future generations

2019: We helped support:

• EarthEcho's Future in the Bag campaign. Developed for youth by youth, this community-centered project promotes accessibility to the tools communities need to jumpstart reusable bag projects, return stations and plastic bag ordinances.

- The Nature Conservancy's advancement of methods for mangrove restoration in Samaná Bay, Dominican Republic.
- Oceano Azul Foundation's Blue Azores Program which promotes ocean literacy, with the aim of expanding to serve over 10,000 students, while their Blue Economy Ideation Program helps turn promising university students' solutions for sustainable economic development into successful businesses.
- ADM Capital Foundation advancement of a sustainable seafood market by developing tools to encourage responsible sourcing—including a wild-capture fisheries risk assessment method and an Aquaculture Sourcing Tool—and developing a website to make these tools and information readily available.

Our founder, Dr. Max Huber, was inspired by the ocean's legendary healing powers. In tribute to his legacy, La Mer continues to only use sea kelp sustainably hand-harvested from pristine, protected waters off the coast of Vancouver Island in its nutrient-rich Miracle Broth™ which lies at the heart of every La Mer product
