HISTORICAL NOTES:

1. Canadian Football governing bodies were the CRU (Canadian Rugby Union) until 1955, and the CFC (Canadian Football Council) for 1956-57. The CFC was renamed the Canadian Football League in January 1958.
2. The present-day CFL East Division was formed from the long-standing IRFU founded in 1907. It was renamed the Eastern Conference in 1960 and the East Division in 1981. The CFL West Division was formed as the WIFU in 1936, renamed the Western Conference in 1961, and the West Division in 1981.
3. Division Semi-Finals have been held in the one-game format across the CFL since 1965. The two-game format was used in the East only in 1951 and in the West from 1952 to 1964.
4. In the East, Division Finals were staged as a 2-game total point series in most seasons from 1936 to 1972. The East adopted the one-game final format in 1973 with the exception of 1986 when there was a two-game Final only.
4. In the West, Division Finals were staged as a two-game total point series in most years from 1936 to 1949 (1947 required a third game to break a tie). From 1950 to 1971, West Division Finals were staged as best-of-three series. The one-game final format began in 1972 in the West.
5. ORFU champions played IRFU winners from 1945 to 1952 and the WIFU final winners in 1953 and 1954.
6. Regina did not play in the 1936 Grey Cup due to a rules dispute.
7. Winnipeg did not play in the 1940 Grey Cup due to a rules dispute.
8. Division results shown for 1941 are from the ECRFU.
9. In 1945, the WIFU did not conduct a regular season.

Notes: In order to support World War II efforts, the IRFU dissolved itself on July 24, 1941. The league did not operate from 1941 to 1944 before resuming play in 1945. At the July 1941 meeting, that year's season in the East was saved by formation of a new league called the Eastern Canada Rugby Football Union which added Toronto Balmy Beach as a replacement for the Hamilton Tigers who had withdrawn from the IRFU three weeks earlier. The ECRFU included the existing Toronto and Ottawa clubs along with the Montreal Bulldogs and was run as a completely separate entity. The 1941 Eastern season is NOT considered to be part of the contiguous IRFU / CFL East Division history as are results from the Service Era games conducted from 1942 to 1944. The WIFU shut down after the 1941 season with play resuming in time for the 1945 playoffs i.e. no 1945 regular season.

NOTE - THE IMPACT OF 1954 CRU RULEBOOK ANOMALY - EAST VS WEST

Since 1958, incomplete passes accompanied by a defensive pass interference (DPI) penalty have been negated with no reception/yardage recorded. In 1954 however IRFU (CRU) rules indicated they should be scored as completions while the WIFU used the post-1958 rule of negating them. This affected many plays prior to 1958 but especially in the 1954 Grey Cup (Play #93, a 26-yard DPI penalty on a "completion" from Etcheverry to O'Quinn). Using the IRFU interpretation gave O'Quinn a record 13 receptions for 316 yards; using the current (and then WIFU) rule gave O'Quinn only 12 catches for 290 yards. This difference makes comparison to today's standards difficult and thus both totals are presented here.
