1. CFL Trends & Highlights · Heading Into Week #13:

- **CFL In-Season Coaching Changes 1958-2017:** This season Hamilton made their 9th and the CFL's 60th in-season head coaching change since 1958. Only BC has made more in-season head coaching changes than Hamilton with 11. Montreal followed with their third in 3 years and 4th in a 5-year span making it 61 all-time.

Montreal has thus become the **first team in CFL history** to make an in-season head coaching change **3 years in a row**. Since 1996 when they re-entered the CFL, no team has made more in-season changes than the Alouettes. Montreal's GM **Kavis Reed** beings a 3-year coaching record of 22-32 .407 after his 2011-2013 stretch with Edmonton.

June Jones has now won his first two games as a head coach and has a chance to make it to 3 straight victories off the start of his CFL coaching career. The last **FIRST-YEAR CFL HEAD COACH** to take over in-season and win at least their first 3 games was **Larry Donovan** for BC in 1987 - 30 years ago and he is the most recent one of just two men to start at least 3-0 in Year #1:

Among **ALL** coaches, Ken Miller (2011: 3-0), Adam Rita (2002: 4-0) and Joe Faragalli (1991: 4-0) (all of whom were in at least their second go around as head men) also started with at least 3 consecutive wins after taking charge.

- **Calgary's 14-game winning streak vs the West:** Calgary brings a 14-game win streak against West Division rivals into Week #13 and their home game vs BC. This is just one win short of the **longest divisional win streak in CFL history back to 1950 built by Toronto across 1996-97**. Here are the longest-ever Divisional winning streaks:

- **Calgary 15 home wins in a row:** The Stampeders have a current 15-game home win streak and that ranks as the CFL's 7th-longest in its history. They can tie Winnipeg at #5 (16 straight 1983-85) with a win over BC this week at McMahon Stadium.
- **Cross-Over Possibilities:** With 32 games remaining the potential for Cross-Over from West to East is again high. The BC Lions sit in 4th place in the West with 6 wins while Montreal who is riding a 4-game losing streak have only 3 victories and remain ahead of Hamilton for 3rd spot. Since Edmonton crossed over in 2016, that sets up the possibility for a 2nd year in a row - something that has only happened once before (2008 Edmonton, 2009 Saskatchewan). It would also make it 3 times in 4 years, and 4 times in the last 6.
- **Maurice Leggett:** The Winnipeg defender accomplished something last week that had been done only three times before in the entire history of the CFL - making **BOTH** a kick return and a defensive return touchdown in the same game:

- **West over East .854:** Western Division clubs have won 20 of the 24 Inter-Divisional meetings thus far with the East taking just 3 (one tie). That is a winning % of .854 and is easily the highest in CFL history since 1961 when interlocking play began.

All four East Division clubs are at least 3 games below .500 and that is only the second time in CFL history that has been the case. It happened was in mid-2014 when all four at least 4 games below .500.

- **Wire-to-wire:** In recent weeks, most losing teams have not been able even to get hold of a lead. In the last 19 games, 14 of them have been wire-to-wire victories. No losing team has led by more than 8 points in any of the last 25 CFL games back to Week #6.
- **Hamilton resurgence:** The Tiger-Cats have won both games since making a coaching change and with a game in hand and a win on Friday night would pull within two points of Toronto and three back of Ottawa in the Eastern playoff chase. They have a chance to become the first-ever 0-8 starter to make the playoffs (and this now even harder in the Cross-Over era) and with a legitimate playoff chance. Both of their victories were by 4 points or less.

1. CFL Trends & Highlights · Heading Into Week #13:

- **Week #12 QBs down:** Through Week #10 (the halfway point of 2017), there had been just 11 different QB starters - only two over the minimum number. Of the 82 QB starts to that point, only Toronto's Jeff Mathews for one week and BC's split between Jonathon Jennings and Travis Lulay had gone away from all being made by #1 QBs. Jeremiah Masoli took over Zach Collaros in Week #1 but Week #12 saw the in-game loss of **Kevin Glenn** (SSK), **Trevor Harris** (OTT) and **Travis Lulay** (BC).
- **Duron Carter 6 games in a row:** Brings a streak of 6 consecutive games with a TD reception into this week and this is one game away from matching the CFL's 3rd-longest streak in history. Terry Evanshen (10) and Milt Stegall (8) hold the two longest runs while Tony Gabriel (1978), Travis Moore (2000), Ben Cahoon (2003) and Stegall (2005) each got to 7 games straight.
- **Big play gap:** Often it is the gap between big plays made and allowed that determine game results. The #1 "gap" is held by Calgary who have made 39 and allowed just 25 for a **+14 edge** - that is a big part of their 9-1-1 mark. Montreal too is **+14** but are just 3-8. The real anomaly is Winnipeg who have only 25 big plays and have allowed 44 for a -19 gap - but they are 8-3 thus far on the strength of a +5 T/O Ratio and a #1 ranking in 2nd down conversions.
- **Short passing game preferred / Deep throws effective:** Across the CFL there have been 3,637 pass attempts made or about 37 per team per game. Of those 3,637 passes, 59% or 3 out of 5 are thrown in short range (8 yards or less downfield) while 16% (or 1 in 6) are thrown with receivers more than 20 yards downfield. The payoff has been great for deep throws however as 76 of the 161 TD passes (47% of them) have come on deep throws.
- **Penalties way down:** This season there have been an average of just 15.8 penalties per game. That is down by 11% from last year (17.8) and 23% less than the 2015 season which at 20.4 penalties per game was the most since 2004.

2. Notes & Trends · Gm #60 · Edmonton at Toronto:

- **One streak will end:** The Eskimos come into this game with a 4-game losing streak, their longest since a 5-game skid in September-October 2013. Toronto has lost two in a row and 5 of their last 6 games coming into this contest. Since a 4-2 start to 2016, the Argos have gone just **5-18 on those 23 games**.

As a team, the Argos' record of 5-18 in a 23-game run is their poorest since a 3-20 mark across **2008-09**.

- **Turnovers really matter for SSK & TOR:** The Argos have lost the **last 16 times** that they have made more Turnovers than their opponents, while Saskatchewan has lost each of the **last 17 times** they have had more. The last time that either team won with more Giveaways was on Oct 6/15, Toronto over Ottawa.

Since 2012, here are these two clubs results with either more or fewer T/Os, and the gap between their W-L records is the most extreme among all CFL teams:

- **Ray vs Reilly:** This game marks the 4th meeting between these QBs as starters but in one of those (Aug 23/14), Reilly left on the second play from scrimmage after being injured and was not the QB of record for that game (Matt Nichols took over that day). Here are their head-to-head stats for the three previous starts:

- **1st Quarter scoring last 4 games:** Edmonton has dropped the last 4 contests and have gotten off to a slow start in each one. They have trailed after 15:00 in all four games and by a cumulative score of 29-3. At the half in 2017, Edmonton is 5-0 when they lead and 2-4 when they have been trailing after 30:00.
- **Brandon Zylstra 314:** Over his last two games he has led the entire CFL with 19 receptions for 314 yards with 8 catches for 2nd down conversions. His 314 yards over a two-game span is the most by any CFL receiver since 2016 Weeks #2-3: Greg Ellingson had 319 yards on Jul 8-13/16, and Edmonton's Adarius Bowman had consecutive games of 141 and 185 yards on Jul 8-14/16 (326). Zylstra will be looking for his second streak of 3 consecutive 100-yard games (first: JUL 14-28/17).



2. Notes & Trends - Gm #60 - Edmonton at Toronto:

- **Recent Edmonton vs Toronto matchups:** Edmonton has won the last 3 times these teams have played and James Franklin started two of those contests at QB. Ricky Ray has started just once against Edmonton in their last 4 head-to-head matchups due to injury. NONE of the last 4 games have been close with the average winning margin being over 21 points.

- **Most Career QB Starts Toronto:** Ricky Ray will be making start #63 for Toronto and here is how that stacks up historically (#2). Ray is the Argos' all-time leading passer with 17,695 yards and 102 TD passes:

- **Brandon Whitaker:** With only 3 more rushing yards, Whitaker can pass Michael Clemons (5,341) for #35 all-time. He enters this week with 5,339 career yards on 1,009 carries.

- **Jackson contained:** The Argos' **Martese Jackson** has been a major addition to the Toronto special teams this year averaging 10.0 yards on punt returns (#5) and 22.7 yards returning kickoffs (#7). On Jul 13/17, he had two big returns of 78 and 68 yards plus an 84-yard kickoff return. Since Jul 13/17 however, opponents have not allowed Jackson any big play returns covering his last 61 attempts on punts and kickoffs. His longest runbacks since then are 26 and 34 yards respectively.

TEAM TRENDS: The Argos' defence has allowed a league-low 314.1 yards of net offence per game while allowing just 5.8 yards per play. They are the lone team to hold opponents to a sub-6.0 figure on a per-play basis.

The Argos are the only team in the East Division with a winning home record in 2017. They are one win away from surpassing their 2016 home win total. Away teams have won 39% of games in 2017, down from a five-year high of 53% in 2016.

The Argos lead the league with 33 sacks through 12 weeks. Last week's game was just the second time all season the team had been held without more than one sack in a game. The last time (and only time) the Argos led the league in sacks was during the 1997 season.

GOLDEN HAWKS REUNITED: Argos LB **Nakas Onyeka** and Eskimos DL **Kwaku Boateng** will play against each other for the first time in their professional careers on Saturday.

Both 2017 CFL Draft picks, Onyeka (5th round, 36th overall) and Boateng (5th round, 41st overall), played their college ball as members of the Laurier Golden Hawks. They combined for 81.5 tackles, 24.5 tackles for a loss, 12 sacks, five forced fumbles and two fumble recoveries during their 2016 senior year while leading the school to its' first Yates Cup win since 2005.

Onyeka has carved out a role for himself on the Argos special teams, tallying five special teams tackles this season. Boateng, meanwhile, has filled a rotational role on the Esks defensive line, posting 16 tackles and three sacks during his rookie campaign.

GREEN ON CAREER PACE: After suffering a significant season ending knee injury just one year ago, SJ Green has proved doubters wrong so far this season.

In his 11th professional season, the Florida native has put together the strongest first half of his entire career.

Ranked second in the CFL in receiving yards (1,002) and receptions (69), the 11-year veteran has already hauled in the third-highest single-season touchdown total (5) of his career.

Green is currently on pace to record the best season of his career with 113 catches for 1,640 yards. Those single-season totals would

rank him fourth in Argos history for receiving yards and fifth in single-season receptions.

GETTING HEALTHY ON D: When Akwasi Owusu-Ansah went down with an injury in the first half vs. Montreal in Week 10, the Argos' defensive unit was without seven of its 12 opening day starters.

Heading into Week 12, the unit could receive a big boost with the potential return of defensive end Victor Butler and defensive lineman Cleyon Laing. Both practiced this week for the first time since being placed on the injured list after the Argos' Week 5 home win over the Ottawa Redblacks.

Butler still shares the CFL lead for sacks (7) and forced fumbles (3) despite playing just 4.5 games to begin the year while Laing holds the outright lead in fumbles recovered (3) after missing the same amount of time. The team has received a huge effort and strong production in both players' absence but their return should nonetheless provide the team with an additional jolt up front.

Johnny Sears Jr., who has been injured since the team's Week 6 road loss to Saskatchewan, also appears to be prepared to play in this week's bout vs. Edmonton. Sears was averaging over five tackles per game before the injury, adding one sack, two quarterback pressures, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery and an interception.

NEWS & NOTES:

- WR **DeVier Posey** got off to a fast start this season, hauling in 19 passes for 280 yards and two touchdowns in the first three games of the regular season. After missing six games on the injured list, Posey has picked up right where he left off, bringing down 10 receptions for 106 yards and two majors in the last two games.
- Eight receivers caught passes from **Ricky Ray** in Week 11, marking the sixth time this season that he's spread the ball around to eight or more targets.
- Week 11's game vs. Hamilton marked **Ricky Ray's** 86th career game with 300+ passing yards. His eight 300-yard performances in 2017 have him within eight of surpassing **Henry Burris** (93) for second in CFL history.
- WR **Armanti Edwards** is currently on pace to record 1,088 receiving yards this season. If he continues to produce at his current pace, Edwards would join S.J. Green as the Argos first pair of 1,000-yard receivers in a single season since 2005 (Tony Miles – 1,275; Arland Bruce – 1,205; Robert Baker – 1,065).
- **Shawn Lemon** recorded his 49th career sack and his 21st in Toronto during Week 11 against Hamilton. With that sack, Lemon now ranks #50 all-time in just 74 career games.
- Linebacker **Marcus Ball** picked off Jeremiah Masoli on the third play of the Labour Day game, posting his second interception of the season and the sixth of his career. Ball's single-season high in interceptions came during the 2013 season when he had three.
