# EDITOR'S LETTER

## TRAVEL FAR AWAY THIS SUMMER, COME TO MÉRIBEL from 2<sup>nd</sup> July to 28<sup>th</sup> August, 2022

**Méribel:** the name means "the point from which the view is beautiful" in the original Latin. This name aptly describes our collection of alpine villages that have not been spoilt by the introduction of skiing. The resort nestles in the heart of the forests in the Vallée des Allues which overlooks the Tarentaise, its head lost in the high mountains which stretch up to the Gebroulaz glacier. It is a bucolic haven of peace which is full of life in both summer and winter.

Writing in his "Carnets des Alpes de joies", an anonymous city dweller who visited our mountains beautifully described the elegance of Méribel's natural world in summer: "Every summer, by day and by night, on the ridges or at the foot of the mountains, we walked the paths of Les Allues through the Ramées forests filled with Cembro, pine and spruce. Further on, they gave way to the mountain pastures that precede the high summits, the Mont Vallon, before descending or branching off towards the Gebroulaz glacier, our ultimate goal. We were accompanied by the music of these familiar landscapes and the bells of the cows in the mountain pastures. Sometimes we were interrupted by a mule loaded with hay and driven by a native who tends his mountains and shows such respect for his environment. No description, no photo can convey the singular beauty of Lac Tueda, ringed by forests which stand as sentries at the foot of the Alps, dizzying and softened by their cover of trees, stretching to the horizon. Below, the multitude of languid villages nestling amongst the fields and woods of Les Allues still hadn't suffered from the ravages of modernism, protected by their setting of untouched forest where my grandparents used to come and look for pine kernels in order to seed other forests."

Méribel is a haven of peace and health and the perfect jumping-off point for exploring the mountains. Come and discover all the different holidays it offers. For a calm and restful stay, make your way through forests and villages in search of one of the rare and beautiful places only found in the mountains. Or embrace Nature, here protected by the Vanoise Nature Park, as are the golden eagles, black grouse and ptarmigan. Or come for an active and sporting holiday: cycle the switchbacks up to the Loze pass, play golf on the Altiport course, shoulder a backpack carrying crampons and discover the Gebroulaz glacier during the Fanfoué festival. Or use Méribel as a base to tour around the Maurienne, Switzerland or Italy, exploring the passes with evocative names - Iseran, Mont Cenis and Cormet de Roselend - which surround Méribel...

A holiday in Méribel is always refreshing - like the Alpine waters of its fountains - and restores our reserves of health, joy and well-being.





Near Lac Tuéda, cembro pines (characterised by needles grouped by five), form one of the most beautiful cembro forests in the Alps. A signposted botanical trail allows walkers to discover more than a hundred species of Alpine flora. There is also a traditional dairy making local cheese with its many animals. Visitors of all ages are sure to be enchanted by the many discoveries to be made in the Vanoise National Park during their stay in the mountains.

In the company of Cécile or Freddy, discover the secrets of local Beaufort cheese-making at the Perret family farm in the Nature Reserve. You can even taste a piece of this exceptional cheese, known as "the prince of Gruyères".



#### THE BOTANICAL TRAIL

fuge du Saut. Along both sides of the Doron River stretch 1,200

hectares of an exceptional, protected natural environment.

This 2 km itinerary rises 180 m and allows you to discover a multitude of natural environments: marsh, rocky scree, dry grasslands, pastureland, stream banks and of course, the forest of cembro pines, the most notable feature of the Nature Reserve and the main reason for its creation in 1990. The path starts 200 m beyond the Plan Ravet car park, on the left, and ends at the reserve's visitor centre, located on the edge of the lake. Allow  $1^{1/2}$  to 2 hours to fully discover the natural riches of the site.





Welcome to the Méribel Valley, with its nature and mountains, spectacular panoramic views, crystal-clear lakes, brightly coloured wildflowers, varied wildlife and protected areas! Children and adults alike will be spellbound by the many discoveries they make in the Vanoise National Park during their mountain holiday. This is a paradise for nature-lovers: an incomparable variety of landscapes await you in its 53,000 hectares and on its 500 km of walking paths.

#### THE GÉBROULAZ GLACIOLOGICAL TRAIL

Welcome to the Doron des Allues valley... Accompanied by the sound of its babbling waters, you can walk alongside this lively torrent all the way to its source: the bowels of the glacier. It takes 3 hours of climbing to reach the river of ice which flows from the peaks of Péclet-Polset. Gébroulaz used to be the last glacier remaining in private hands. It belonged to a local family, the Etievents until it was acquired by the commune in 2003. You can relive the history of this glacier on a hike over several kilometres, a history which dates back thousands of years! Thanks to this trail, you can discover and understand the fascinating life of this river of ice since the last ice age. Numbered markers are set along a path that climbs to the Col de Soufre at an altitude of 2,819 m. You will hike through an exceptional area, so please treat it with respect!

#### LAC DE TUÉDA AND REFUGE DU SAUT WALK

This walk takes you to the heart of the Plan de Tuéda Nature Reserve, in the Vanoise National Park. From the lac du Tuéda, the path climbs towards the Vallon du Fruit before reaching the refuge du Saut. This circular walk allows you to enjoy a very wide diversity of landscapes, plant life (alder, spruce, arolla pines) and wildlife (marmots, eagles, chamois, ibex). After starting in the Ramées woods, this itinerary takes you up high to reach the plateau de la Plagne at 2,000 m altitude, at the foot of l'Aiguille du Fruit.





The Méribel valley and Vanoise National Park abound with high altitude lakes, all located in spectacular natural sites that you can discover. In the Méribel valley alone there are ten lakes, including the magnificent lacs du Mont Coua, located above 2,500 m, the mystical Lac des Fées (Lake of the Fairies), a haunt of marmots, or the unmissable Lac Tuéda, lying in the heart of the Plan de Tuéda Nature Reserve. There are many ways to discover these enchanting mountain lakes: with a guide or independently, on a day hike or as part of an overnight trip to a mountain refuge, and along easy or more challenging paths.

## TWO-DAY HIKE: TOUR OF THE AIGUILLE DU FRUIT

This two-day walk for good hikers allows you to discover no less than ten of the most beautiful lakes in the Méribel valley, including lac de Tuéda and lac des Fées, lacs du Mont Coua, lac de Chanrouge and lacs Merlet. You will be spellbound by these expanses of water of varying colours and their different surroundings. After a night in a mountain refuge, you will set out to climb the Platta, Chanrossa and Fruit passes, before dropping back down into Méribel-Mottaret.

**Pay 1** Meet at the plan Ravet cark park and start from the lac de Tuéda and head towards the refuge du Saut. When you arrive on the plateau de la Plagne, go past the chalets and continue to the end of the plateau to discover the crystalline lac path. Continue to the refuge du Saut then follow and col du Soufre up as far as the footbridge that crosses the stream. Once you have crossed over, take the path to the left. The four beautiful lakes are not signposted, but the path is clearly visible. At the fourth lake, go off path to the left, towards the Mont Coua passage, and descend through the scree to lac de Chanrouge. Next, join the path that leads to the col de Chanrouge and head towards lacs Merlet. Go over the pass and drop down to spend the night at the refuge des lacs Merlet

Day 2 From the refuge, go over the Platta, Chanrossa and then Fruit passes before descending to Méribel-Mottaret, passing by lac Tuéda. Duration: 4h

Méribel invites you this summer to try Explor Games®, a fun, original and free game which raises children's and adults' awareness of biodiversity.

Combining aspects of an escape game and geocaching, this offers immersive storylines and a unique experience. It is open summer and winter in the magnificent Plan de Tuéda Nature Reserve with its 1,200 hectares of protected nature. Guided by an app, you will set out on an adventure with your friends or family, avoiding traps on your path and taking on challenges! You'll play the part of a band of adventurers exploring Méribel, the only people who can save the valley by finding the Heart of Méribel, a treasure which has the power to bring peace and harmony. Explor'Games\* is a unique opportunity to discover the history of the valley and the secrets of its Alpine flora and fauna. It's your turn to play! Allow 2 hours.





#### LES LACS DU MONT COUA

This 7-hour hike of average difficulty will allow you to admire the six spectacular Mont Coua lakes which lie between 2,520 and 2,820 m. On your return, you can also make a little detour to visit the 7th lake, the lac de Chanrouge, which lies under the north-east face of la Roche Pellier and is close to the path. And why not include an 8th lake, the lac des Fées, lying in the Vallon du Fruit, 500 m south-east of the chalet de la Plagne.

Ascent From the plan Ravet car park in Mottaret (1,681m), set out towards the refuge du Saut, passing by the lac de Tuéda. After the lake continue

(signposted), climbing some fairly steep passages. Enjoy a breather along the flat Vallon du Fruit area, by the meandering Doron des Allues river as it flows through the green pastures covered with flowers.

At refuge du Saut (2,140 m), there is a sign; follow in the direction of Col du Soufre and climb up to the footbridge over the Doron des Allues (2,440 m). After the footbridge take the path to the left (East) towards the lacs du Mont Coua. This is not marked, but the trail is clearly visible. After the first small lake, a little off the path, you will reach the second lake. Follow the path and the cairns on the right (south-east) towards the largest lake (2,672 m); this lake is highly prized by fishermen. After the large lake, continue along the path following the cairns (south-east) towards the fourth and the fifth lakes (2,780 m).

You can even, if you have enough time and the weather is favourable, continue to the sixth lake...

Return Above the fifth lake, find the le petit collet (2,787m) to the north (Passage des Eaux Noires), indicated by large cairns. Go down into the valley on the right of the Mont Coua cliffs. You will see numerous cairns in the beautiful. ochre-coloured scree. There are a few steep passages but no technical difficulties through this scree. This route does not appear on the IGN maps (the blue marks indicate a ski touring route). There is no difficulty in finding your direction: simply go down into the valley (north) and at the bottom you'll find greenery and the marked path that leads to the Col Rouge. Once you reach the path to the Col Rouge, go north-west towards the refuge du Saut, and return to Tuéda down the route of your ascent.

#### RECOMMENDED FOR WALKERS: LE SAUT MOUNTAIN REFUGE

Lying on the boundary of the Plan de Tuéda Nature Reserve, le Refuge du Saut is a perfect 'base camp' for walkers and lovers of the high mountains. This refuge offers a high level of comfort and accommodates up to 25 people (meals and accommodation) in comfortable rooms and dorms of 2, 4, 6 and 8 beds. It is eco-friendly throughout with solar panels, wind-powered ventilation, and locally sourced purified water and is heated with wood burners.







## MÉRIBEL is an ideal destination for family holidays in the mountains.

Holder of the "Family Plus" award for many years, the resort goes to great lengths to make family holidays unforgettable and offers a wide range of services, facilities, activities and entertainments dedicated to children.

Méribel allows children to get close to animals, with wildlife to discover in the Plan de Tuéda Nature Reserve and pony-rides on offer, including small ponies for the youngest children at the Ranch Nordique riding centre. Other highpoints of your family holiday may include day outings on foot or mountain bikes. Méribel's mountain guides offer outings and hikes for families, even those with young children, such as via ferrata sessions, the Sentier des Animaux (animal trail), a night in a mountain refuge, discovery of the flora and fauna or Beaufort cheese-making.



Discover the Pumptrack and the Ludizone at the Chaudanne. These free play areas are ideal for learning or improving: enjoy a first taste of downhill mountain biking in the Ludizone, or whizz down the swooping terrain of the Pumptrack circuit, without having to pedal. This closed-off and fun circuit is made up of bumps and turns and can be used by all and requires no pedalling. The Ludizone allows you to learn to ride on a mini, downhill-sloping course made up of small bumps which allow you to discover the sensations of mountain biking in complete safety before you move on to the Bike Park!



#### TAKE A BREAK AT LE CLOS BERNARD!

Located in a magical spot at the heart of the Altiport forest, the Clos Bernard welcomes you every day of the week from 4pm for teatime surrounded by animals. Before your teatime snack, you can get close to the farm animals: pigs, goats, sheep, poultry, rabbits and quail... Le Clos Bernard is sure to be your favourite family destination thanks to its range of activities organised throughout the summer: cooking workshops (learn to make fritters and other Savoyard specialities), learn about medicinal plants, try orienteering and even take part in a treasure hunt. This summer's fascinating new arrival is a beehive of Savoie black bees! Twice a week, keen beekeeper Herwan will introduce you to their world and teach you everything you want to know about bees: how they forage and reproduce and how the hive functions.





#### THE EDUCATIONAL FARM AT REFUGE DE LA TRAYE

At Refuge de la Traye, your children will be able to get close to animals and learn all about them. The refuge's educational farm is part of an authentic setting showcasing rural traditions in a preserved natural environment. #### | RECOMMENDED SPOT

Sports in Méribel take place in the heart of a spectacular setting, with more than 20% of its land located in the Vanoise National Park and spectacular rocky scenery as you approach 3,000m altitude.

There is something for all tastes and abilities: treetop adventure courses, paragliding, fly-fishing, cycling, mountain biking, hiking, climbing, canyoning, glacial hikes, via ferrata, tennis and more. Here's a quick overview of some of our unmissable outdoor sporting activities.

Lifts open from 2 July to 28 August 2022

Méribel is paradise for cyclists... To one side of our valley is the Vanoise National Park and on the other, le Mont Blanc.

Welcome to Méribel's Bike Park, in the heart of les 3 Vallées, which stretches from rocky summits to green mountain pastures and forests. This playground for mountain bikers includes 11 downhill itineraries, 9 enduro itineraries, 3 cross-country itineraries, and 6 itineraries designed for electric mountain bikes.

Road cyclists can also discover these landscapes on tarmac. Méribel is the starting point of many routes allowing you to discover legendary neighbouring passes such as Col de la Madeleine, Col de l'Iseran, Col du Glandon, Cormet de Roselend, Col du Petit Saint Bernard, and further afield. Col San Carlo...

**PARADISE FOR CYCLISTS** 

All road cyclists in Méribel must try the legendary climb to Col de la Loze, which saw the greatest names in world cycling battle it out during the 'queen stage' of the 2020 Tour de France...

Finally, the "Boucles de Thomas Voeckler", which opened last year, are accessible to all levels of cyclists and are proving very popular. This champion cyclist collaborated with the resort to create a range of itineraries to help people discover Méribel's roads and paths. So far, 2 itineraries are ready to be discovered this summer.





In 2019, Méribel and Courchevel opened a new 12.5 km cycle path exclusively for the use of cyclists, which peaks on the Col de la Loze at 2,304 m. Choose an electric bike or road bike to tackle this novel route which begins in the forest then winds through mountain pastures. You'll ride along a mountain road without meeting a single car, in the heart of nature and far from any pollution.

Keen cyclists will here find several peaceful itineraries to discover the Méribel and Courchevel valleys. And as an added bonus, you're likely to spot marmots! The pass's steep incline will also please those who enjoy a challenge. The new cycle path perfectly follows the curves of the mountain. Some turns are especially steep and there are numerous changes in gradient, some of which are quite brutal.

Cyclists will have to master a short 23% incline before reaching the pass. Their efforts will be rewarded by the majestic 360° panorama awaiting them over the Méribel valley and the Mont-Blanc, Grand Bec and Grande Casse peaks.

Any cyclist can enjoy a complete escape into the mountain with an electric bike. With friends or family, you can pedal from Méribel to Courchevel via Brides-les-Bains and have fun discovering the Col de la Loze, the 3<sup>rd</sup> highest pass in Savoie after the Iseran and Galibier passes. This summer, challenge yourself to climb le Col de la Loze which saw the world's best cyclists battle it out during the 'queen stage' of the Tour de France two years ago.

Since last summer. Méribel has had an ambassador - the great Thomas Voeckler - to promote the resort's cycling credentials and, in particular, its new cycle path which climbs to the legendary Col de la Loze! Thomas Voeckler has one of the finest records in French cycling, with 52 victories to his name. He is the holder of a series of awards, most notably in the Tour de France (yellow jersey, stage victories, polka dot jersey) which made his reputation and started "Voeckler-mania". E-bike or even a mountain bike.

#### Loop 1 "Les Cotilles"

A 6.7 km loop accessible to all, which can be used by bike or E-bike: "Les Cotilles" - green level - Start at Le Blanchot restaurant & return via Chante-Mouche. Total ascent 150 m // Total descent 156 m

#### Cop 2 "Col de la Loze"

A 43-kilometer loop starting from Les Allues via the Col de la Loze with a return via La Tania. Total ascent 1.584 m // Total descent 1.583 m

Thomas Voeckler will also be in Méribel for the highpoints of the cycling calendar, such as the "l'Echappée du Col de la Loze" on 20 and 21 August.

The first French golf course to be built above 1,500 m, Méribel's course was created in 1966 at the wish of Peter Lindsay, one of the original founders of Méribel in 1938. This mountain-loving Scotsman was also a keen golfer who wished to see the resort as lively in summer as in winter. He therefore conceived of creating a golf course, which began with only 4 holes and now has 18.

Today, Méribel's par-71 golf course covers 35 hectares and has 18 holes, and is 5,538 m long. Each hole offers fabulous views which change over the seasons. Build on undulating terrain, it is filled with technically challenging natural features. The course winds along wooded slopes, overlooked by Méribel's legendary peak, le Dent de Burgin. It stretches from the Altiport up to les Rhodos and Chantemouche, a height difference of more than 250 m (from 1,565 to 1,850 m). For learning and practicing, Méribel's golf club offers a practice area with a 1,100 m2 putting green, a chipping green, a bunker and 40-place driving range, 10 of which are covered.

Open from June to November (according to weather conditions), this exceptional course delights experienced players and is also an ideal place to learn.

#### Spotlight on families:

Families can learn to play golf together, from putting to a full swing, with fun games for the younger children. Méribel Golf Club also offers children's lessons from 3 years old and junior camps lasting 1 to 5 days for children aged 5 years and over. With its numerous permanent trails, Méribel offers a wide range of itineraries each of which has its share of magnificent landscapes. Located in the heart of the Massif de la Vanoise, and passing through the Tuéda Nature Reserve, Méribel's trail-running area offers 150 km of sign-posted paths which are accessible to all runners, from beginners to experts, with something to meet all your hopes and desires! Committed fell runners shouldn't miss the 24 km loop (1,700 m ascent) which forms part of the Méribel Trail competition. This winds its way through technical climbs, contour paths, narrow single-tracks, passages through scree and along ridges, towards the Roc de Tougne, Roc des Trois Marches, Col du Fruit, Lac de la Chambre, Lac du Borgne, plateau du Fruit. 
#### **EVENT** | MÉRIBEL TRAIL

In the heart of the Vanoise massif and les 3 Vallées ski area, the Méribel Trail is a mountainous, technical, high and wild event. Crossing the Tuéda Nature Reserve, taking you to an altitude of nearly 2,800 metres and offering you incomparable views, this is the ideal event for nature lovers who want to try the sport on a short yet demanding course, and also for experienced trail runners who want to test themselves under race conditions to prepare for the big events at the end of the season.

A part of the French Vertical Kilometre Championships, Méribel Trail features 7 courses; the perfect opportunity to come and compete against the best runners in the country!





Here, you can ride in the heart of a wild and unspoilt natural environment. The only equestrian centre in les 3 Vallées which remains open all year round, the Ranch Nordique offers horse and pony trekking from 13 years old. You can discover the most beautiful places in the valley on horseback: for example, the 2-hour loop takes you to the Plan de Tuéda Nature Reserve. Lessons and courses are available for all levels, starting at 6 years old, plus there are theme days such as 'Baby-Pony' (leading-rein rides for tiny tots), or acrobatics - everyone is sure to find an activity they love!

#### | SPORTS IN THE SKY

Fly over Méribel and les 3 Vallées in a paraglider with a professional pilot for incomparable views and a unique experience! Set out from Tougnète in the morning or la Dent du Burgin in the afternoon, take your seat for a 1,000 m descent and at least 20 minutes of flight. The morning flight, which is lower to the ground, allows you to spot animals such as chamois or deer. The afternoon flight is sportier and reaches speeds of 45 km/h. If you are in luck, you may even fly with a golden eagle! You might also see vultures from the nearby Maurienne valley. On both flights, you will enjoy a breath-taking 360° view of Mont Blanc and les 3 Vallées.

to discover trekking over a glacier, a sport midway between hiking and mountaineering. You will be introduced to the techniques and equipment for walking on a glacier, and to high altitudes. For example, take a day outing to the Gébroulaz pass and dome, and the 3 passes (Thorens, Lory and Bouchet). Or spend a night in a refuge on the Pointe de la Réchasse, Dôme de Chasseforêt or Dôme de Polset... Groups 5-6 people max, children are accepted from 10 years old.

#### | TREE-TOP ADVENTURE COURSE

With Méribel Adventure, you can get close up to nature on an 80-element forest adventure course. Starting from le Bois d'Arbin, you can try 5 different forest courses with different challenges and zip wires to test your agility, balance and daring. 


# Go back in time with the traditional Fanfoué village fete Sunday 7 August 2022

Every summer for almost 50 years, Méribel has brought its traditions back to life at the Fanfoué village fete (Fanfoué is Savoy patois for François). This fete brings together Savoyard traditions and heritage in the form of a day of celebrations in Les Allues, with a float parade and traditional open air meal, all in a friendly and welcoming atmosphere.

Visitors will enjoy folklore and traditional scenes from the past, traditional foods, entertainments, stands, exhibitions and a float parade. Immersing yourself in the life of our ancestors is to discover their lifestyle, costumes and practices, but it is also a chance to discover the culinary traditions of the past, such as the bougnettes (typi-

cal Savoyard cakes), bread baked in the village communal oven, traditional cider, home-made jams and many other goodies. It is also the day on which to revive the tradition of 'la route des tommes'.
