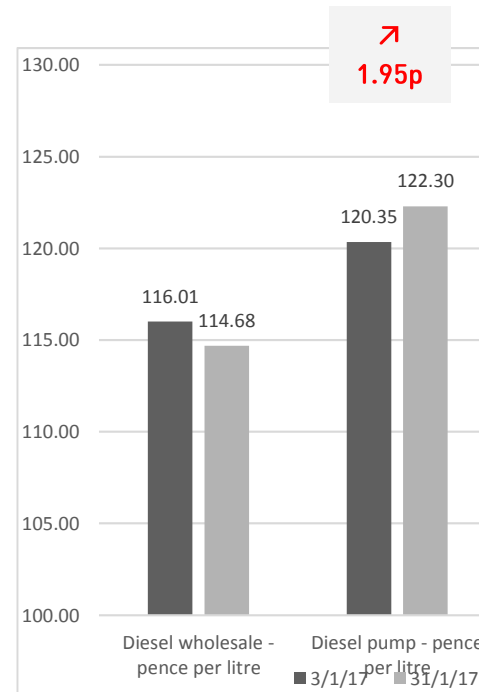
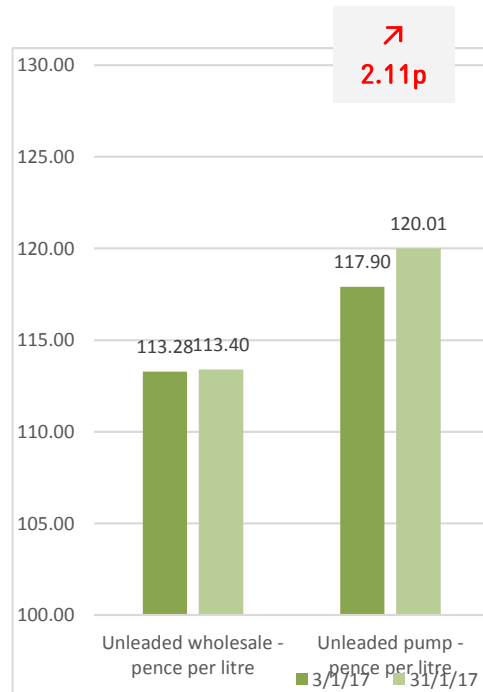
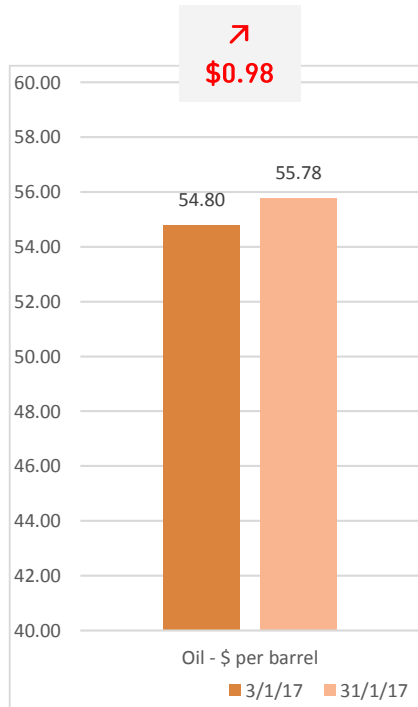


UK fuel prices report

Petrol and diesel price changes in January 2017



Our view on prices

"In the last two months 5p a litre has been added to the pump price of both petrol and diesel which means the cost of filling up is really starting to hurt motorists again. But the January rise is harder to swallow as there is a saving from wholesale prices that retailers should be passing on a little faster than they are. As the wholesale price stands currently we would expect to see average prices come down by over a penny a litre in the next fortnight."
