Guests learn about the featured ingredient, taste one or two preparations using this ingredient, and enjoy a hands-on cooking experience using a recipe and this product with the chef.

Since the hotel is at the center of all Paris explorations, guests can, at any time, enjoy afternoon tea in the Tea Garden. Paris is a city that delivers its last bursts of energy in the late afternoon, and, for those who need a break from all of the excitement and indulgences, we invite them to take the time to dream in their magical *piéd a terre*.
