This way, the animals provide the fertiliser so the soil has plenty of nutrients for the crops. My farmer has to make sure that his animals have enough room to move about and be comfortable. Their welfare must be respected.

If you see the EU organic logo, you can be absolutely sure that what you are eating has been produced according to strict EU environmental and animal welfare rules, and is regularly checked.
