










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






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

An icon inspires, an icon is unique, not only in its own right but also, and above all, for the way people appreciate it and how it makes them feel. And so, it's because of the people **who make (and who have made) it what it is** but, most of all, the people who come here and love it, that Verbier is iconic!


ALL ROUTES LEAD TO VERBIER

Verbier may be perched 1,500 m up in the Alps, but it has transport links that make it easy to get to from anywhere. With a train station at the heart of the destination, its proximity to Geneva Airport and the crossroads of Switzerland with France and Italy, Verbier is infinitely reachable by train, car or plane: or any combination thereof.

LE CHÂBLE -VERBIER: BESIDE THE CABLE LINES

Conveniently part of the public transport network, the Le Châble - Verbier gondola provides a smooth connection between the plain and the resort. Directly connected to the Le Châble train station, with an intermediate station in Verbier, it can take passengers straight from the train to the slopes. Operational daily from 5:15am to 11:50pm, it suits all schedules. The infrastructure also makes it easy to come by car with large free car parks at the base of the main lift station. Accessible, fast and comfortable, this 'valley lift' represents an efficient and sustainable travel solution for getting to Verbier with a reduced travel carbon footprint.

BESIDE THE RAIL TRACKS

Having reached Geneva by train or plane, travelling the final kilometres to Verbier is as easy as it is beautiful. From the train station housed in same building as the airport, the train route skirts Lake Geneva with unbeatable scenic views. Then, with just one change at Martigny, a smaller train heads up the mountain to Le Châble where it unloads its passengers at the foot of the gondolas that lead to Verbier and onto the slopes.

VERBIER EXPRESS AND VOSALPES

The Verbier Express train offers direct routes from Geneva to Le Châble, avoiding the need to switch trains in Martigny, and runs from mid-December to mid-April on weekends and some public holidays. Similarly, the VosAlpes Express line connects Fribourg (CH) to Verbier. By choosing to take the train, skiers and mountain enthusiasts can also take advantage of train and lift pass bundles.

LOCAL TRANSPORT

In resort, there is a **free bus service which circulates from 8am to 8pm throughout the winter season.** A night bus operates during some peak periods in the season, from 8pm onwards. And visitors can wander further afield in the Val de Bagnes by taking take the red TMR buses to Sarreyer, Bruson and deeper into the valley to explore more facets of the region.

WELL-KEPT SECRETS

Skiing at first light is a 'not-to-be-missed' experience in this destination. Savoleyres lights up gently beneath the rays of the rising sun, to show plunging views over Verbier. For adrenaline seekers, **Bruson** reveals its narrow, sinuous forest runs, a true playground for hardened skiers looking for some authenticity, away from the crowds.

Time for a break, means it's time for cheese – the undisputed king of the Alps. The highest fondue in Europe, at the summit of Mont Fort, at 3,330 metres. melts slowly as the 360°- panoramic vista opens up over Mont Blanc and the Matterhorn. Lower down, in La Chaux, sample the famous Raclette du Valais PDO at Le Dahu restaurant's outdoor food truck. A delicious and satisfying way to recharge the batteries before getting back onto the slopes.

SKI FROM NOVEMBER TO MAY

In Verbier, skiing can be savoured for six months of the year! From November 2025 to the end of April 2026, winter sports lovers will be able to click into their bindings. Initially just at the weekends (Saturday and Sunday) and then, from the first weekend in December, the lift system will operate every day (7/7) until the end of April 2026.



THE BIRTH OF A REVOLUTION

This winter, our ski area will see the start of a mini revolution: firstly, it will be the final winter for the oldest operating gondola in Switzerland (1970). Iconic symbols of the resort, the mythical gondola cars of Savoleyres will be put up for auction over the summer of 2026. The upper section of its successor, the Les Esserts-Savolevres Télémixte Lift (chairlifts and gondolas combined) will be inaugurated this winter, (followed by the lower section next winter). This project will establish an efficient link between the sectors of Verbier and Savoleyres - La Tzoumaz, up till now, connected only by a bus service through the resort.

Another new introduction is a brand new chairlift replacing the old Lac II. connecting the Lac des Vaux to the Col de Chassoure and its freeride itinerary. Both these recent additions aim to strengthen the links between the different sectors of the 4 Vallées ski area and encourage skiers to explore all the possibilities of this vast playground.

With an altitude range of 1,500 to 3,330 m, but the majority of its slopes above 2,000 m, Verbier 4 Vallées is one of the highest ski areas in Europe. In addition to that, 63% of the area is covered by artificial snowmaking capacity, ensuring good snow depth over a long period.

SNOWFALL HISTORY (RUINETTES 2,200 M)






THE 4 VALLÉES: **THE LARGEST SWISS SKI AREA**

Even from the 3,330-metre-high summit of Mont Fort, it's impossible to look over the whole ski area. And for a reason: the 4 Vallées is the largest ski area completely in Switzerland and connects the five resorts of Verbier, La Tzoumaz, Nendaz, Veysonnaz and Thyon. The area is so extensive that skiing to all the resorts in one day is hard to do. The possibilities for skiers and snowboarders in this huge playground are endless: secured freeride itineraries, undulating slopes, beginnerzones, steep blacks, family-friendly slopes and high mountain runs. Such diversity, combined with a reputation for well-prepared slopes, has earned the 4 Vallées international acclaim and made it an iconic destination for all skiers!

XTREME VERBIER: A GLOBAL EVENT → 28 MARCH - 5 APRIL 2026

The Xtreme Verbier is THE iconic freeride competition that, since 1996, takes place every year on the north face of the Bec des Rosses, in Verbier. This contest, which marks the final of the Freeride World Tour, sees the crowning of the world champions in the discipline. The Bec des Rosses, at 3,222 m high with an average gradient of 50 degrees, is an extreme and technical face on which only a handful of the world's top riders get to compete. The Xtreme Verbier is not just a competition, it is also a celebration of freeride culture, showcasing the technical and mental demands of the discipline, the importance of safety and preparation in the mountains, the virtuosity of the athletes and the incredible excitement of this sport.

FREERIDING IN VERBIER, THE BIRTH OF A LEGEND

Rodolphe Tissières, founder of the Verbier ski lift system, championed making the mountains more accessible. It was in 1960, following the construction of the Mont Gelé cable car, that the first mountain, completely free of groomed slopes was opened to skiers. This concept was subsequently replicated at Mont Fort. For the first time, skiers could enjoy the sensations of off-piste skiing without long, gruelling climbs.

In the 1970s, a skiing counter-culture emerged, looking to break free of traditional and rigid skiing practices. It was a group of three young men who put Verbier firmly on the off-piste (later freeride) map. Their **Team Clambin** style, as captured in the photographs of Mark Shapiro and **published worldwide**, gave fresh impetus to **freeride skiing in Verbier**.

With the next generation, freeride really took off and began gaining popular appeal. This time it was on the steep faces of the Bec des Rosses, that the first big competition dedicated to the discipline, the Xtreme Verbier, took place,



ICONIC FIGURES

TEAM CLAMBIN

In the 1970s, Mark Shapiro, John Falkiner and Ace Kvale set up base in Clambin, just above Verbier. Rejecting academic style, these pioneers explored untamed faces, (naming them Stairway, Barry's Bowl, Hidden Valley...) and made it an art form. Their exploits and the iconic images captured by Shapiro attracted riders from across the world and turned Verbier into the capital of freeride.

ELISABETH GERRITZEN

Instilled with a love of the mountains since childhood thanks to her parents, Elisabeth started competing in Verbier at 16 years old. At 20, she entered the Freeride World Tour, winning the Xtreme Verbier in 2019 and 2021, plus the world title in 2021 – a first for a Swiss female skier. Having a strong sense of social responsibility, she is also a staunch defender of women's rights in sport.

VERBIER MOUNTAIN GUIDES

The first Swiss Company of Guides and Porters was created in Verbier and the Pays du St-Bernard in 1853. That tradition and fascination for the mountains continues to this day in our region, as is evidenced by the fact that our various guide bureaux combined have the largest number of guides in Switzerland, counting almost 100 professionals. It is clear that the iconic role of the mountain guide continues to have a strong vocational appeal here.





A LOCAL ECOSYSTEM GEARED TOWARDS FREERIDE

Verbier lives and breathes freeride all year round thanks to a comprehensive ecosystem supporting the discipline. In terms of equipment, Faction, a brand founded in Verbier and still based in the region, and similarly First Track Lab, an innovative ski manufacturer, take advantage of their proximity to the Verbier playground to test their products on the mountain. In terms of training, the Freeride World Tour Academy trains youngsters from 8 to 16 years old, be it for a day, a week or the whole season. For committed athletes, the Verbier Freeride Team provides financial support to local riders of all ages and levels and is currently the most represented team globally in competitions.

ICONIC SPOTS



Although locals and regulars would prefer to keep these places secret, it is impossible not to be aware of Verbier's freeride potential. From runs in the forest on the Bruson side to the more exposed couloirs behind Mont Fort, the possibility of playing in ungroomed terrain is greater than most other places. Making fresh tracks in Verbier has to be done, and although it may mean jostling for space in the first cable car of the day, the ski area has plenty of room for everyone. A few classic 'notto-be-missed' runs, always, of course, with a mountain guide, are Mont Gelé, Stairway to Heaven, La Mouche, Rocky Garden and Backside Mont Fort.

With affordable neighbouring villages. discounted packages and off-peak stays, Verbier can also be enjoyed on a budget. And to find some tranquillity away from the hubbub, head for its hidden spots: backcountry trails, mountain refuges and panoramic views where you have the mountains all to yourself.

THE VAL DE BAGNES **REFUGES:** WINTER WARMTH IN THE ALPS

Nestling at the foot of snowy peaks, the Val de Bagnes refuges are open to visitors in winter for meals or the unique experience of an overnight stay. The sociable atmosphere, friendly welcome and delicious local specialties encourage visitors to simply enjoy the moment.

Easy to reach from the slopes, the attractions of the Cabane Mont Fort (2.457 m) include its uninterrupted sunset view and traditional Alpine atmosphere. Opposite, at 2,100 m, the Cabane Brunet, reachable on foot, snowshoes or touring skis, has a warm welcome for touring skiers and mountaineers, many on their way to climb Mont Rogneux. These two iconic refuges encapsulate the intensity and simplicity of mountain life.

END-OF-SEASON EVENTS → 1-30 APRIL



After a short loop to the spring of the ancient watercourse, the route heads back downhill into the snowy pastures of Bruson. A circuit where every step invites you to absorb and savour the space and pure tranquillity of the mountains.

The day kicks off early in the morning at Geneva Station where the Santas are invited aboard the free train connecting the main towns around Lake Geneva all the way to Le Châble where they disembark at 10 am at the foot of the gondolas which take them right up to Verbier.

After a few runs, the jolly red-clad revellers meet up on the Inkontro terrace (on-slope eatery) for the traditional group photo and for a musical happy hour. When the slopes close, the party continues with a tasty raclette at

SKI VERBIER ON A BUDGET: **MISSION POSSIBLE**

Cachet, panoramic views, cosmopolitan vibe... Verbier has all the appeal. And yet, it doesn't have to cost a fortune to ski here. With a few smart moves, quality skiing in Switzerland can be surprisingly affordable.

Tip n°1: look beyond Verbier. Neighbouring villages offer comfortable, well-positioned accommodation with rapid and efficient transport links to the slopes.

Tip n°2: ski passes purchased online 10 days in advance have a 10% discount, there are also off-peak reductions.

Tip n°3: direct hotel reservations are often better value than booking platforms. And for even more favourable rates, target off-peak periods - well clear of Christmas, New Year and February - or opt for a chalet or apartment rental.

Result: same snow, same vibe... with costs under control.

TOBOGGAN RUN: SOME PRE-OLYMYPICS PRACTICE?

No need to be a winter sports professional to zoom down the La Tzoumaz toboggan run, all that's required are strong nerves. From either Verbier or La Tzoumaz, sledgers start from the summit of the Savoleyres cable car station (2,354 m), where jaw-dropping vistas of the Grand Combin and the Rhone Valley await. From there, it's a 7 km-long, 711 m-drop, adrenaline rush, with laughter from start to finish. Open to all. Wearing a helmet is strongly advised. Hire toboggans in resort or at the top of the run in Savoleyres.

In Val de Bagnes, home to the Capital of Raclette, raclette is much more than a tradition – it is an art, a way of life. For an authentic taste of raclette, crafted, of course, with the finest Raclette du Valais PDO cheese, head to Eddy's Raclett'House in Bruson or Le Caveau in Verbier. Another outstanding Bagnes speciality is the potence (gallows) – succulent meat flambéed on a spiked metal apparatus which can be enjoyed at the Hôtel La Vallée in Lourtier or the au Vieux Verbier restaurant. As for croûtes (grilled cheese dishes), whether plain or topped with mushrooms, la Marmotte restaurant is the place!

For those who appreciate fine dining, Verbier is home to a diverse range of restaurants guaranteed to delight connoisseurs and food lovers. Under the direction of Sebastiano Lombardi, La Table d'Adrien (17 points in the Gault&Millau Guide, 1 Michelin star) offers Italian-inspired gourmet cuisine.

At W Verbier's restaurant **Bô!** (13 points in the Gault&Millau Guide) chef Emiliano Vignoni proposes an extraordinary and refined culinary journey.

At **La Grange** (13 points in the Gault&Millau Guide), local Thierry Corthay prepares exceptional regional produce in a welcoming setting.

Taratata (14 points in the Gault&Millau Guide), housed in a former night club, with its laid-back atmosphere and its butcher's counter, is ideal for a relaxed evening.

Perched at an altitude of 2,700 m, yet easily reachable on foot, **Le Bistrot** restaurant, directed by chef, Bert De Rycker, offers delicious and generous gourmet cuisine (13 points in the Gault&Millau Guide).

At **Kanpâna** (12 points in the Gault&Millau Guide), in the heart of Le Châble, it is with laid-back style that Fabio Amaral and Kelly Manenti serve up a true culinary experience.

Beyond Verbier, in a converted former sheep stable in the village of Etiez, young chef Jeremie Voutaz (22 years old) works solo in his table d'hôte, À Table.

As, during the day, the village seems to move to the slopes, it's important to be able to get a nourishing and sustaining meal up there! For those having a family day on the La Tzoumaz side, **Chez Simon** restaurant offers attractive surroundings, while **La Croix-de-Coeur** knows how to please with its selection of casseroles and cheese dishes.

Venturing into the Verbier sector, head for **Le Dahu** or **Le Bistrot**. The first, a popular restaurant of exceptional quality, has a large terrace with a view of the Grand Combin massif. Le Bistrot, perched on the summit of Les Attelas, in a cosy setting, offers a bistronomic menu using local produce.

And last but not least, for those heading to Bruson, the little restaurant **La Grange à Tienne Oeudan**, surprises with its stunning terrace, friendly vibe and Valaisan specialities.




