



SEASON ONE SERIES REGULAR CHARACTER DESCRIPTIONS

SOPHIE O'NEIL (Brittany Snow)

Sophie O'Neil seemed to have it all – a great husband, a thriving career, and an adorable son – until a traumatic event shattered their perfect life. Her husband, Graham, relocates the family from Cambridge, Massachusetts to Maple Brooks, Texas, where they desperately cling to the fresh start it could provide. Still anxious and unsettled, Sophie is thrown into the glamorous and reckless world of the Hunting Wives, a group of wealthy, privileged, gun-toting, hard-drinking women, led by the seductive Margo Banks. As the outsider looking in, Sophie slowly unlocks her deepest desires and needs as she becomes more entangled with Margo, while grappling with her past trauma that continues to haunt her and her marriage. Sophie's life spirals further into chaos when a local woman is murdered, capturing the town's attention.

MARGO BANKS (Malin Åkerman)

Margo Banks is the richest, most beautiful, and most charismatic of the Hunting Wives. She is the woman everyone wants to be, and no one wants to upset. She has an inordinate amount of power and knows how to subtly wield it. Much of her day is filled for sport – she drinks for sport, she dresses for sport, and she shoots for sport. Married to Jed Banks, a Texan billionaire oilman, money does buy her everything. Despite these traits, her love for Sophie is gentle, passionate, and real. When Jed considers running for political office, it threatens to expose their indulgent ways, and the murder of a local girl remains a mystery.

JED BANKS (Dermot Mulroney)

A fifth-generation oil magnate, Jed Banks is proudly married to the young and beautiful Margo, his second (trophy) wife and the alluring leader of the Hunting Wives. But don't be fooled by his Southern charm. Jed knows you do not become this wealthy without being capable of exploiting people along the way. He is aware of the dangers of running for political office, but that is part of the excitement. His drive to win is greater than his desire to keep secrets. To have more is more, but to have the most is better. The local murder of a young woman is exactly what he needs to fuel his potential gubernatorial campaign.

CALLIE BASKIN (Jaime Ray Newman)

Callie Baskin is an alpha female with a fierce love for her husband, her guns, and her friends – especially Margo. As such, her world does not have room for new faces in it,

especially one who seems to be taking Margo's attention away from her. She is as tactical and precise with her words as she is with her weapons. A champion marksman, she is a resilient tour de force of a woman who is extreme in her loyalty. While one should not upset Margo at any cost, one should never cross Callie at all costs. As the wife of Maple Brook's Sheriff, Jonny Baskin, she pushes him to find the murderer of the young woman killed in their town, possibly pushing their status beyond public service. But in truth, it's an opportunity to become closer to Margo.

GRAHAM O'NEIL (Evan Jonigkeit)

Graham O'Neil is the protective father to Jack and the lovable husband to Sophie O'Neil. He knows she's hurting from her past, but he doesn't know how to make it better. He truly thought moving to Maple Brook would automatically reset their marriage and family. He believes his gentle guidance will ease Sophie's pain, not realizing his attempts come across as controlling, furthering her insecurities. He means well but keeps missing the mark, as Sophie isn't aware of what she needs from him either. Oblivious of Sophie's relationship with Margo, Graham does his best to fit in and is eager to keep up appearances to impress his boss, Jed Banks.

BRAD THOMPSON (George Ferrier)

Brad is Jill and Reverend Clint Thompson's son, a popular high school basketball super star headed to Baylor after he graduates. He is dating Abby Jackson, a girl his mom does not approve of, but then again, no one is good enough for her son. What his mother doesn't know, won't hurt her. He is spoiled with a quick and dark temper yet can play up his innocence and local fame to get what he wants.

JILL THOMPSON (Katie Lowes)

Jill Thompson is the wife of the Holy Horizons Christian mega church pastor, Reverend Clint Thompson. While he preaches, she sits in the front row, it's her own personal status symbol. Prim and proper without an ounce of imperfection slipping through to mar her family's pristine image, she believes herself to be charitable, basking in her position and involvement in the church. But all the while she is saying one thing, she is usually thinking another (less charitable) thing. She is a loyal member of the Hunting Wives, unless there is something she could be doing for her son, Brad. Brad eclipses everything and everyone, and her identity orbits around him. She will not allow anyone or anything to interfere with his preordained path to greatness.

STARR JACKSON (Chrissy Metz)

Starr Jackson is the caring mother to Abby Jackson, Brad's girlfriend. Starr is a Christian woman living an honest life and providing the best she can for her daughter. She is not wealthy, not married, and lives in the wrong neighborhood, making her decidedly not Hunting Wife material. She is hurt by their lack of acceptance but carries herself with dignity. She is tender, strong, and grounded in her true self. It is with these values that she is raising her only child as Abby navigates the pressures of Brad's future and Jill's constant aversion towards her.
