




# UK fuel prices in June 2016

Price of a barrel of oil **rose to** \$48.45

#### Unleaded

Wholesale price rose 0.39p to 106.93p per litre

Pump price rose 1.5p to 112.17p per litre

#### Diesel

Wholesale price rose 2.23p to 107.89p per litre

Pump price rose 1.66p to
112.39p per litre

"June was another bad month for motorists with the price of petrol going up again.

"While it was only a penny and a half it makes for a rise of more than 10p since the start of March. Filling up with unleaded is now £5.64 more expensive. But it is good news that fuel prices are so far weathering the Brexit storm"
