## Techtextil 2019: Frankfurt the hotspot for high-tech textiles

SPACE FOR INNOVATION is the slogan of Techtextil 2019. Some three months before opening, the leading international trade fair for technical textiles and nonwovens is almost fully booked. With its trend topic, "Urban living – City of the Future", this trade fair will be casting its eye on things to come and considering how technical textiles will affect our urban life in the future. From 14 to 17 May 2019 Techtextil will be featuring numerous new developments and highlights.

Every two years, Techtextil mirrors the range of applications for textile materials.
