# ABC plays highest proportion of Australian music of any broadcaster

Ausmusic Month returns to the ABC this November as we celebrate our place as one of the nation's biggest supporters of local music and musicians.

Throughout the month, we'll be putting some of Australia's favourite music artists front and centre across ABC TV including *Missy Higgins, Peter Garrett, Kasey Chambers, Dan Sultan, Angus & Julia Stone, Ball Park Music, The Presets, The Rubens* and more.

ABC currently plays the highest proportion of Australian music of any broadcaster. In the last year 58% of music played on triple j was Australian, and Classic FM played over 50% of Australian performances for the first time ever.

We've taken a fresh approach to live music on television with our new program *The Set*, bringing viewers live performances from some of the Australia's most exciting talent, performing special collaborations and covers in a purpose-built share house.

In the tradition of **Ausmusic Month** concerts of previous years, ABC will broadcast *Missy Higgins and Friends Live* where Missy Higgins will perform her most loved songs and covers with some well-known special guests.

Excited to take to the stage for Ausmusic Month, Missy Higgins says "This show is going to be so fun, I've always wanted to play in the Melba Spiegeltent and to have such incredible guests joining me on stage just tops it off. My career all started because of winning triple j Unearthed way back in 2001 so to be invited by the ABC to headline their Ausmusic Month celebration feels like a pretty cool 'coming full circle' moment. It's going to be very special."

Also screening during the month is the ground-breaking new series *Don't Stop the Music*, highlighting the importance of music education in Australian schools, and inspiring the next generation of children to embrace music.
