#### **Back Roads**

Back Roads returns to take viewers to more of Australia's most interesting communities. These are towns full of authentic characters, full of grit and good humour.

With so many wonderful places to visit, award-winning journalist Heather Ewart is helped out by guest presenters Felicity Urquart, singer and presenter of ABC Radio's Saturday Night Country, ABC News Channel's Joe O'Brien, and foodie and farmer Paul West. Felicity, Joe and Paul will uncover more resilient communities defined by their strength and humility.

The people featured on *Back Roads* are as awe-inspiring as the landscape that surrounds them.

In this series, *Back Roads* visits Queensland's Atherton Tablelands, the NSW town of Lightning Ridge, The Furneaux Islands in Bass Strait, Tasmania, Marble Bar in WA, Finke in the Northern Territory, Beaufort in Victoria,

Windorah in Queensland, and The Coorong in South Australia.

#### Sherlock

As Sherlock (Benedict Cumberbatch) waits for Moriarty (Andrew Scott) to make his posthumous move, an intriguing puzzle captures the mercurial detective's attention. But this case is more dangerous than he could have imagined. There is a dark purpose at work. Something with its roots deep in Mary Watson's (Amanda Abbington) past. Sherlock and John will face their most chilling enemies yet. In this 3-part series, everything they know will be tested. Everyone they know is under threat. Is the game finally over?

# Fresh Blood Pilot Season: The Angus Project

FRESH BLOOD is a ground-breaking ABC and Screen Australia initiative that seeks to uncover the next generation of Australian comedy talent. First launched in 2013, there were hundreds of entries of from all over the country that culminated in the Wham Bam Thankyou Ma'am and Fancy Boy sketch series (both co-produced with NBCU's Seeso streaming platform (US). Once again in 2017, 20 up-and-coming comedy teams were given \$15,000 each to produce a 3x5 minute comedy project. This year, four of those were chosen to produce a half hour comedy pilot, with one or possibly two projects to be commissioned to make a 6-part series.

All four Fresh Blood pilots, including The Angus Project premiere on ABC iview on Tuesday 20 November.

#### The Angus Project

Angus is an aspiring sports journalist with cerebral palsy, who works for a shonky local paper called The Bathurst Gazette. He wastes his days with his carer Nina, a flailing university student who has a knack for blowing even the most mundane tasks out of proportion. Assisted by their eclectic drug dealer Kane, the two find colourful ways to shirk their responsibilities, and undermine their boss Kath, a nasty woman who runs the regional disability service provider.

Guest cast includes award-winning comedian Sammy J as 'Kane', actor and musician Adam Bowes as 'Wizza', and Sydney based triple j radio presenter, actress, comedian and writer Veronica Milsom as 'Kath'.

"I adored the original, short-form series of The Angus Project and jumped at the chance to be involved. It was particularly satisfying to be finally cast in a role that reflects my true self; a drug-dealing, paranoid conspiracy-theorist." - Sammy J Angus Thompson is a 26-year-old actor with Cerebral Palsy from Bathurst, NSW. During his time at university studying Public Relations, Angus began acting in student short films. This encouraged Angus to pursue further projects in front of the camera. Last year Angus was accepted into ABC's Fresh Blood, where a three-episode web series, The Angus Project was first created. This year Angus has acted in educational and training videos for Sydney based companies, as well as modelled in Melbourne Fashion Week's event Access to Fashion. Angus is hopeful to pursue future projects within the creative industry and do his part in pushing for the disabled population to be seen and heard in the media.

Director/Producer/Writer/'Nina' Nina Oyama is a stand-up comedian, actress and writer whose TV credits include You're Skitting Me S2 (ABC3), The Chaser's Election Desk and Squinters. In 2017, Nina was a recurring cast member of multi award-winning show Utopia, playing Courtney the receptionist. Her stand-up comedy has appeared on SBS2's Stand Up @ Bella Union, C31's About Tonight, In the Zone 2015 and most she recently was a reporter on Tonightly with Tom Ballard.

Producer Bronte Rose Jovevski is a comedy producer/director with a background in independent production and producing animated commercials. She came to The Angus Project fresh from directing and producing sketch comedy group Freudian Nip's Fresh Blood suite and producing a late-night comedy talk show for ABC2. She is now working in post-production in Toronto (the one in Canada).
