

The iDalko Story

iDalko was founded in 2011 when Atlassian was in a global upswing which led to a whole class of new users needing support. iDalko began to develop add-ons for companies who wanted to get even more out of their Atlassian software investment.

In the past decade, iDalko has consistently grown under the radar. While Atlassian software consulting and licensing has been a major factor behind that growth, the prime reason was Exalate, iDalko's flagship product. Exalate is cross-company integration software which allows companies to collaborate in an ultra-secure environment and synchronize data in real time.

Based in Antwerp, Belgium, iDalko can count on an international team of over 90 employees (speaking 24 languages) across five offices. After, France and Ukraine, the growth-stage company recently opened offices in Costa Rica and India. These new offices should allow iDalko to better serve the American and APAC market.

IDalko works for more than 2,000 companies, including 30% of the Top 50 of the Fortune 500.

Exalate employs ultra-strict security protocols. The tool can handle simple to highly complicated scenarios and the company maintains full control and confidentiality over their own data and processes.

With Exalate, iDalko provides an answer to the complex challenges that companies face in today's increasingly volatile environment, where digital technology moves at an ever-faster pace with rapid innovations. Companies are joining forces to meet those challenges. Integration tools are not new. But Exalate is the only software in the world that works cross-company with such a high degree of security and user autonomy. The integration software builds networks between companies and can handle the most challenging integrations. Adding companies to the network is quick and pain-free. Exalate is also flexible and constantly evolves with new collaborations, new processes, and new ways of working.

Exalate is available for the largest and most important software platforms and workflow systems: Zendesk, Jira, Servicenow, Salesforce, Azure, Github, among others. Multinationals from all industries—including well-known gaming companies and car brands—are already working with Exalate. As does the U.S. government.

Table Grid (for Jira)

Jira, the popular Atlassian app, makes it possible to track projects and open issues. iDalko built Table Grid, an add-on to view and modify Jira tables in either databases stored locally or external databases in the cloud.

Table Grid can add and configure external data sources with a REST API for the Jira app. Users can give new information to their projects and tasks (milestones, releases, etc.) as well as easily search for projects or quickly organize them. Table Grid is designed to be intuitive and user-friendly.

In short, the Table Grid add-on helps organizations run their project management efficiently.



4 iDalko Milestones

2011	Francis Martens founds iDalko and joins the growing market of Atlassian software and tools
2012	Launch of Table Grid for Jira; one of the first commercial apps in the Atlassian Marketplace.
2014	iDalko joins Start it @KBC, the country's largest accelerator, to develop Exalate and bring it to market.
2016	Leaves the iconic skyscraper, home of Start it @KBC, and moves to its own headquarters in Antwerp. The same year, iDalko opens an office in Lviv, Ukraine.
2017	iDalko raises seed-funding for Exalate and expands further, beyond the Atlassian environment, by setting up an integration with HP ALM.
2018	Hits the 30-employee mark. iDalko moves to a new office in Antwerp and opens an office in Paris.
2019	Exalate is available for Jira, Zendesk, ServiceNow, HPALM, Azure DevOps and Github
2020	iDalko opens an office in Costa Rica to serve the US market.
2021	Tenth anniversary. iDalko opens its fifth office ir India and grows to more than 90 employees.
