



What to Expect

Our first priority is the health and safety of our audience, staff, and artists.

Until circumstances and public health guidelines permit us to seat full audiences, only a small number of socially distanced patrons will be admitted into the theatre. We will provide seats for as many of our subscribers as permitted, determined by a random draw. All other patrons will be able to watch exclusive livestream performances via the internet.

If you are chosen to be part of our in-house audience, we will send you instructions in advance about when to arrive and which entrance to use. You will be asked to wear a mask until seated, and to use one of the new hand-sanitizing stations at the building entrances.

Coming to the theatre will be considered a declaration that you are in good health and have not been out of the province within the last two weeks or had recent contact with someone with COVID-19.

When you arrive at the theatre, you will be guided by staff and volunteers who will also be wearing masks. Look for signage and visual aids to keep you safely distanced through our lobby, washrooms, and to your seats.

The bar and concession will be closed for the foreseeable future, but you will have the opportunity to pre-order a drink, which will be waiting for you at your seat.
