



## Alexandre McCormack Founder Shayp

# Why did you found your startup in Belgium?

We were living here already when we started. We all studied in Belgium so we have a good network and know the system quite well. We created our first prototypes here as well as our first proof of concept with the support of many different local actors: the City of Brussels, the Brussels Region, beAngels, Start it @KBC and Imec.

We have found that Belgian investors are very risk-averse even in the early rounds. This puts a brake on the velocity of growth. Lots of startups here have to bootstrap their business much more than in other countries: it's a big cultural difference compared to the UK, Germany and the US.


