



## Rac Fuel Watch

### Petrol and diesel price changes in September 2017







#### Crude oil

\$5.40 to \$58.48

#### **Unleaded**

Wholesale price fell 6p to 110.1p per litre

Pump price rose 0.83p to 119.19p per litre

#### Diesel

Wholesale price rose 0.72p to 115.73p per litre

Pump price rose 1.34p to 120.31p per litre

#### Our view on prices

"There is scope for a further round of pump price reductions as wholesale unleaded is 6p a litre cheaper than it was at the start of September.

"If the big retailers were to play fair with motorists we would see at least another 2p a litre come off unleaded at the pump. Unfortunately, the wholesale price of diesel is static so we won't be seeing any cuts there.

"With oil up to its highest price since early July 2015 motorists have been saved from steeper prices by the pound which has gained in strength. Without this drivers would be paying far more for their fuel. The late September petrol and diesel cut from the supermarkets was a demonstration of how important a favourable exchange rate is ."
