2017 CFL GAME NOTES • TORONTO AT OTTAWA



1. Canadian Football League Commissioner:

On July 5, 2017 the Mr. Jim Lawson, Chairman of the Board of Governors of the Canadian Football League announced **Mr. Randy Ambrosie as its 14th Commissioner**. Here is some background on his 9-year CFL career (1985-1993):

- Drafted second overall in 1985 by Calgary right behind fellow O-Lineman Nick Benjamin
- Played 142 regular season games across 9 seasons 1985 to 1993 for Calgary (34), Toronto (28) and Edmonton (80)
- Traded from Calgary to Toronto in [July 1987](#) for a 1988 second round pick
- Traded from Toronto to Edmonton in [June 1989](#) for DT Branko Vincic
- Played 9 playoff games and in two Grey Cups (Toronto 1987, Edmonton 1993. Won in 1993 with the Eskimos)

2. Quarterback Sacks & Turnover Trends:

- **QB Sack Rate:** There have been 36 sacks in 8 games for an average of 4.5 per game. This continues the declining trend since 2013 with a drop in frequency of **22.5%** - **2017:** 4.5 **2016:** 4.7 **2015:** 5.3 **2014:** 5.4 **2013:** 5.5. The other indicator out of this is that in 2017, no team giving up a QB Sacks has scored on that drive yet. There have been 36 possessions in 2017 in which a club has allowed a QB sack, and NONE have resulted in a TD.

- **Last time that a team did not allow a sack in the first two games?:** Montreal has yet to allow a QB Sack in 2017 - something no team has done since **Hamilton in 2001** and that has occurred only two times across the CFL since 1996. Hamilton also did it in 2000 when they did not allow any sacks for the first four games.
- **Turnovers down at 2.9 per game - but the cost is up:** The attention paid to Turnovers and their impact by our clubs shows in the data for 2017 with only 23 in 8 games (one was deducted for EDM in Week #2 due to a re-scoring of a kickoff muff as an OT recovery). That equates to a total of only 2.88 per Giveaways per game and compares as follows:

In 2016, teams capitalized on opponent Turnovers at **2.4 points** on average on the subsequent possession after taking the ball. That critical indicator has increased by 55% to **3.7 points** per drive after the Turnover in 2017 - that means that 2017 Giveaways have been much more expensive to clubs.

3. Other CFL-Wide & Team Trends Heading into Week #3:

- **CFL Week #2 FGs at 96.4%:** Week #2 Field Goal kicking was unprecedented in its success rate - 27 of 28, **96.4%** across the league (Week #1: **77%**). Tyler Crapigna (SSK) had the only miss, an OT attempt from 33 yards that hit the upright. The highest FG% in any week since **Week #6 of 2012** (16-of-16 100%).
- **Red Zone TD% Rate at 40%:** Thus far there have been 57 opportunities in the Red Zone in 8 games however the TD% success rate has been only twice in every five trips (**40.4%**). Last year the TD% was **55%** and in 2015 **57%**.
- **Current FG Made Streaks:** Sean Whyte and Justin Medlock are now over 20 in a row dating back to 2016. **Justin Medlock** is on the longest streak of his career (previous high: 22), while **Sean Whyte** has matched his previous long run (24 in 2011):

3. Other CFL-Wide & Team Trends Heading into Week #3:

- CFL Quarterback Rating:** Through the first two weeks and based on a 2-0 record alongside his 118.0 pass efficiency rating, Edmonton's **Mike Reilly** leads the CFL with an overall QUAR of 92.9 (out of 100). His Week #2 rating was an astonishing 95.2 based on superior performances in all aspects of QB play on just 12 possessions.
 League-wide the average **QUAR** has been very high at 76.2, well above the 2016 average of 62.5. This rise is easily attributable to higher scoring on offence (**52.4 ppg vs 49.0 in 2016 up 7%**) and a league-wide gain in Pass Efficiency from an all-time high of **98.0** in 2016 to an even higher **103.2** in 2017). The CFL completion % of 68.6 is also an all-time record high.
- More 3rd & Short Gambles:** Last year the conversion rate on 3rd down and 1-2 yards was 82% (154-of-187) and gambles averaged 2.3 times per game. In 2017, no team has failed to convert going 28-for-28 - that success rate has increased the tendency to go for it up to 3.5 times per game, more than twice as often as in 2016.
- Two Overtimes:** Two of the eight games thus far have gone into OT - the most in the first two weeks of any season since **1992** (when 3 of the first 5 games went overtime). Winnipeg went first in OT last week and won at Regina - that made it **18 for 30 (60%)** for teams going first and winning since 2004.
- C-1 Convert Kicks - 75% in 2017:** As successful as kickers have been this season with an all-time high of 86.4% on field goals, convert success has been the other way around. Last week, they made just 12-of-18 attempts (66%) after an opening week 12-of-14 (86%). Last season the conversion rate was 91% compared to just 75% thus far in 2017.
- CFL scoring:** The average across the CFL through the first 8 contests is **56.1 points per game**, the highest it has been since 2008 (56.2). Teams are scoring on offence on 16% of their drives, consistent with last year at 16.5% (one TD every six possessions). Where scoring is REALLY up is on Field Goals at **6.4 per game** - the most FGs made per game since the 1991 season (6.7).
- Consecutive QB Unbeaten Starts & All-Time Win Pct:** The record for most consecutive unbeaten starts by a CFL QB is now 18 for Bo Levi Mitchell after last week's 43-39 win over Ottawa by Calgary.

- Andrew Buckley:** Recorded a 60-yard TD run last week, one of only **nine** 60+ yard gains by a QB in the last 34 seasons (1984-2017). He is the 16th QB to ever run for 60+ yards, the last being Rakeem Cato for 73 yards in 2016. It matched the second longest run by a Canadian Quarterback in CFL history - Gerry Dattilio also for Calgary in 1982.

- Punt Return TDs in same game:** Last week Calgary's **Tunde Adeleke** and Ottawa's **Diontae Spencer** each returned a punt for a TD in the same game. The last time each team had one against each other was four years ago - June 27, 2013. Winnipeg (Demond Washington) and Montreal (Tyrone Carrier) each had a punt return TD in that game.
- Time of Possession Anomaly:** Of the seven winning teams thus far, only two have been on the positive side for Possession Time. Five losing teams have won the TOP battle and on average clubs who have lost have averaged 31:15 to 28:45 for the opposition.
- 1st Quarter scoring?:** This year there have been very slow starts to scoring as the by-quarter breakdown shows. Scoring in the opening quarter has averaged just **6.4 points per game** and only 11% of the total:

4. Gm #20: Toronto at Ottawa Notes:

- **2016 Series:** Last season Ottawa won two of the three games splitting with Toronto at TD Place. Trevor Harris started the third and deciding game in his only start of the REDBLACKS against the Argos to date in a 29-12 win on Sep 23/16. Since 2014, the Argos have won 5 of their 8 meetings, six of which have gone down to the final 3:00 of play.
 - **Ottawa close games:** They have had plenty of these and both in 2017 were settled (or not) by 4 points or less. Since the start of 2016, they are 2-5-2 in 0-4 point margin games fully 45% of their 20 games over that span.
 - **QB Starters:** In the last four meetings between these two clubs Toronto has started four different QBs ... Trevor Harris, Ricky Ray, Logan Kilgore and Dan Lefevour. Ray will make his third career start against the REDBLACKS and he is yet to beat them losing once in 2014 and 2015. Ray is now 104-97-1 in 202 career starts while Harris is 14-13-2 in 29 starts - both are coming off a loss this week.
 - **Ricky Ray Starts Coming Off a Loss (40-28, 15-11):** For the Argos as a starter Ray is now at 25-29 in 54 starts since 2012. Of note however is that he is **15-11 .577** when coming off a loss in the previous week for the Argos as he will be in this game. For his entire career, Ray is **40-28** in 68 starts when coming off a loss.
 - **Trevor Harris:** Had a monster game last week throwing for 425 yards and 2 TDs and is ranked #3 in QB Rating at 85.5 out of 100 to Week #2. Last week vs Calgary he went **4-of-6 on throws deeper than 16 yards** (receiver depth) for 202 yards with completions for **59, 34, 44** and **65** yards. At one point last week, **Harris completed 15 passes in a row.**
 - **Ellingson & Sinopoli:** The Ottawa duo ranks #3 (tied) in the CFL at 199 yards each on a combined 30 catches (on 41 targets). Ellingson is the most targeted CFL receiver thus far with 23 passes his way and has 70 yards after the catch. Brad Sinopoli has caught 15 of 18 throws (83%) and leads the CFL with 132 YAC yards.
 - **Victor Butler - 5 second down stops etc.:** NO CFL defender has had a better year to date than Butler who has 19 total defensive plays including a league-best 4 QB Sacks and 6 QB Pressures. He also has two forced fumbles and a pair of knockdowns in the line. He also leads the CFL with 5 stops in Opponent 2nd Down Conversion situations.
 - **Toronto Up & Down:** The Argos have produced two very different results thus far winning by 17 points and never trailing, followed by last week's loss by 13 to BC leading for only just over 3 minutes of that game (3:22 to be exact). Pass defence has been a key as Hamilton was held to just 242 yards and 9 first downs through the air, while BC racked up 301 yards and 14 first downs passing. The Lions scored 18 points in the 4th Quarter to win, the most that the Argos have allowed in Q4 since Aug 28/15 (21 by EDM).
 - **Toronto & Ottawa Red Zone:** The Argos cashed in on just one of four opportunities inside the 20 last week vs BC and are now just 2-of-9 (22%) on the season (2 TD, 6 FGs, 1 T/O). Last season Toronto ranked #2 in Red Zone success at 58%. Ottawa has gone 3-of-7 thus far in their Red Zone chances.
 - **Ottawa drives:** The REDBLACKS have had 28 possessions thus far but only 3 have started in the opposition end. Their average starting point of their own 34-yard line is the poorest among teams with two games played. Their 25% rate of 2-&-Outs (1-in-4) however is well below the CFL average of 32%.
 - **Ottawa YAC:** The REDBLACKS lead the CFL in yards after the catch with 306 - that equates to 42% of their passing yardage total coming after balls are caught (tied for #1 at 42% with WPG).
 - **Ottawa Rankings:** They lead the CFL in net offence (setting up this game as #1 Offence vs #1 Defence for yardage) at 445 per game along with a 74.1% completion rate and 49 first downs. On defence however, they are #7 in both points allowed (30.5) and opponent net offence (417 per game). They trail the CFL with a -2 T/O Ratio as well.
 - **Toronto Rankings:** They lead the CFL in passing offence at 417 yards per game, and in 30+ yard completions with 7, and at a staggering 9.7 yards per attempt. Rushing however has been the opposite as they have just 60 yards on the ground to date. Defensively, Toronto is #1 allowing only 296 yards per game and just 17.0 points by their defence.
 - **Ottawa's Diontae Spencer:** Leads the entire CFL with 388 combined yards including 96 of which came on the THIRD longest Ottawa punt return TD in their history (OTT Record: Mariet Ford 101 yds in 1983). Spencer leads the CFL in punt return yards with 177 and is in the Top 20 with 115 receiving yards.
 - **Ray 833 yards:** He leads the CFL in passing yards in 2017, something he has done 4 times before ... 2006, 2008, 2009 & 2014.

RAY LEAD: Through the first two weeks of the season, Argonauts QB **Ricky Ray** has led the league in passing. The 15-year veteran has thrown for a league-leading 833 yards (506 in WK1 & 327 in WK2) while completing the second most passes among all CFL quarterbacks.

Ray has also been efficient as a passer, accumulating a 105.4 passer efficiency rating.

BOOKENDS: Argos defensive ends **Victor Butler** and **Shawn Lemon** have been terrorizing offences and quarterbacks in the first two weeks of the season. Together, the Argos duo has accumulated six of the team's nine quarterback sacks. Last week vs. BC, first-year Argo Victor Butler posted four tackles, two sacks and a forced fumble. Butler currently leads the CFL in sacks (4), forced fumbles (2), quarterback pressures (6) and is tied for the league-lead in second down conversion stops (5).

Additionally, Shawn Lemon squeezed out his first pair of 'Lemon Drops' last Friday, posting two tackles and two sacks. The second-year Argo now has 11 career multi-sack games, six of which have been registered since he was traded to the club from Saskatchewan on July 2, 2016.

Meanwhile, Canadian DT **Cleyon Laing** can be credited as the centerfold or centre piece to this tandem. The Edmonton native, who returned to Toronto this offseason, has four tackles, two sacks, two fumble recoveries, one forced fumble, and two quarterback pressures to his name.

THE DREADED D: The Argonauts defence continues to rank among the top defences in the CFL heading into Week 3 of the season. Toronto has allowed a total of 21.5 points per game and an average of just 17.0 points per game by opposing offences.

Opposing offences have managed just 5.4 yards per play, a passing efficiency of 81.1, and an average of 295.5 offensive yards per game, all three of which lead the league.

The CFL's most tormenting defence leads all teams with four forced turnovers and two interceptions while boasting nine sacks, five more than the next CFL team (EDM & BC).

KEEPING IT 100: The Argonauts receiving corps has been productive through the first two weeks of the seasons. In that time, the Argos have had four different receivers eclipse the 100-yard mark: Argos WRs DeVier Posey (7-147-1), SJ Green (6-126), and Jeff Fuller (3-104) popped off in Week 1 while newcomer Armanti Edwards quietly recorded his first career 100-yard game last week. Edwards hauled in all 10 passes he was targeted on for 131 yards and a touchdown in the Week Two loss to the BC Lions.

With four receivers having eclipsed the 100-yard receiving mark in the first two weeks of the season, the Argos currently sit one shy of the team's total of 5 (2 – Diontae Spencer, 3 – Kenny Shaw) in 2016.

TOP OF THE TOP: On Saturday night in the Nation's Capital, the CFL will see the league's top two offences and quarterbacks, as well as the top four receivers go head-to-head at TD Place. Heading into Week Three, Toronto's **Ricky Ray** leads the CFL with 833 passing yards on 62-of-86 passing (72%) while Ottawa has the second-leading passer in former Argo Trevor Harris (60-80 passing for 725 passing yards and five touchdowns).

From a pass catchers standpoint, Argos WRs **DeVier Posey** (12-218-1TD) and **Armanti Edwards** (16-209-1TD) sit number 1 and 2 in the league while REDBLACKS WRs Greg Ellingson and Brad Sinopoli sit tied for third/fourth with 15 catches for 199 yards, although Sinopoli has a lone major to his name.

NEWS & NOTES:

- Newcomer **Armanti Edwards** has quietly been a sure handed target for QB Ricky Ray. The second-year CFLer has hauled in all 16 passes he's been targeted on for 209 yards and a touchdown this season. Edwards is one of only two receivers (SSK's Nic Demski - 14) in the CFL to have caught every pass thrown their way.
- If activated off the injured list this week, Argonauts receiver **Khalil Paden** and offensive lineman **J'Micheal Deane** will get their first opportunity to play against their former team on Saturday night. Both players spent the last three seasons with the REDBLACKS and assisted them to the 104th Grey Cup Championship in Toronto last season. Paden caught 39 passes for 626 yards in his three seasons in Ottawa while Deane started in all 16 games that he appeared in in 2016.
- Argos LB **Marcus Ball** is tied for the league-lead with Calgary's Alex Singleton in total defensive plays with 20. Ball has notched 14 tackles (12 DT, 2 ST), two quarterback pressures, one tackle for a loss and three pass knockdowns in two games. He put together another productive defensive outing last week with seven tackles (6 DT, 1 ST), his second straight game with 5+ tackles.
- Argos DB **Johnny Sears Jr.** sit third among Argonauts in tackles (9) while adding two quarterback pressures and an interception. Sears' interception last week on BC Lions QB Jonathan Jennings was the Michigan product's first since the 2015 CFL season.
- Since missing a 49-yard field goal attempt in the third quarter during Week One, Argos kicker **Lirim Hajrullahu** has connected on his last six attempts after going three-for-three last week vs. BC.
- Since Ottawa's return to the CFL in 2014, the Argonauts have held a 5-3 record vs. the REDBLACKS, including a 2-2 record at TD Place. If you include the Argos home game vs. the REDBLACKS on October 6, 2015, the Argos hold a 3-2 record at TD Place.
- **Ricky Ray** has not played a game at TD Place since the Ottawa Redblacks home opener during their inaugural season on July 8, 2014. Ray has missed the last four road games in Ottawa.
- **Ray** enters Saturday's game just two touchdowns away from the 300-touchdown club. He's poised to join Anthony Calvillo (455), Damon Allen (394), Henry Burris (373), Ron Lancaster (333) and Matt Dunigan (303) as the only QBs in CFL history with 300 or more touchdown passes.
