In fact, WFO's volunteers as well as its partners', **ECO Eyewear** and **Rizek Vidal Recyclers**, carried out a series of cleanups on Santo Domingo's beaches, and also used the WFO waste-catching trawl that they placed on a river. The various actions enabled the collection of lots of ocean plastic which have then been brought to the recycling facility Rizek Vidal Recycler.
