My middle daughter was sleeping next to me. I covered her with my body. There was a lot of things hitting my back.

Stones, woods... a lot of other things that I couldn't understand in a few seconds.

At that moment

I felt nothing

but pain. I was horrified.

I was really out of mind, out of place.

After I checked that my kids were okay,

I was worried about my family because I am parently living on their roof.

I went down there. All the glasses have been broken. But thank God they are all alive and nobody was injured.

We left our home for an hour till the sunrise and we could see better when I came back.

I saw what's been happening. Everything was covered with sand, with dust.
