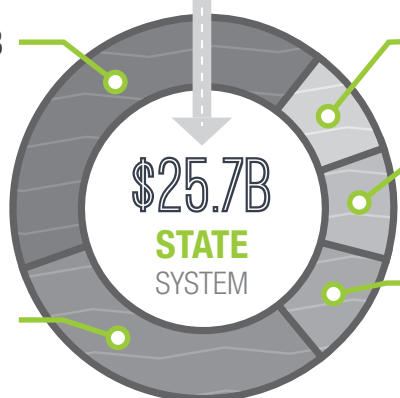

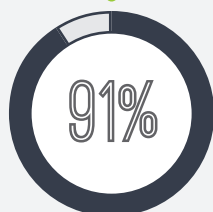

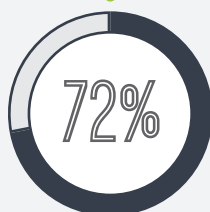

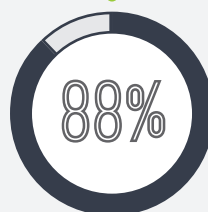

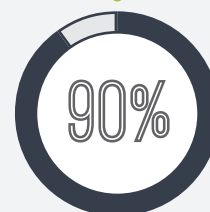

MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

CALHOUN AND GREENE

- **Joe Page Bridge (Illinois 16/100):** \$245 million for a bridge replacement at the Illinois River.

CLINTON

- **Illinois 161:** \$8.8 million for pavement replacement of 0.7 mile and ADA improvements from Charles Street to Meadow Lark Lane in Albers.

GREENE

- **U.S. 67:** \$43.4 million for bridge replacement at Apple Creek Overflow 3.5 miles south of White Hall. *This project has been approved for Illinois Special Bridge Program funding.*

MADISON

- **I-270:** \$116.5 million for interchange reconstruction, 1.2 miles of pavement replacement and additional lanes, bridge replacement and other bridge work from Chain of Rocks Canal to St. Thomas Road in Granite City.
- **Illinois 4:** \$63.5 million for resurfacing 10.2 miles, new shoulders, ADA improvements, drainage, culvert replacement, bridge deck repairs, bridge deck overlay, land acquisition and utility adjustments from I-55 to Illinois 143.

MARION

- **I-57:** \$172.9 million for reconstruction of 7.3 miles, bridge replacement, new bridge decks, bridge painting and other improvements from north of Illinois 161 to U.S. 50 in Salem.

MONROE AND ST. CLAIR

- **Interstate 255/U.S. 50/Illinois 3:** \$163.4 million for resurfacing 15.2 miles, including ramp repair, bridge deck overlay, bridge repair, bridge joint replacement/repair, bridge deck repairs and bridge painting from the Mississippi River to Illinois 157 in Cahokia Heights.

ST. CLAIR

- **I-55/64/U.S. 40/Illinois 3:** \$368.1 million for pavement replacement of 2.7 miles, bridge replacement, bridge deck overlay, new bridge deck, bridge superstructure replacement, bridge painting and other improvements from the Mississippi River to the I-64 (Tri-Level) interchange.
- **Illinois 3 Connector:** \$106 million for new construction of 1.5 miles from Fairmont City Boulevard in Fairmont City to Illinois 3/203 in Madison, including reconstruction of 0.4 mile on Exchange Avenue from 1st to 7th Street in East St. Louis.
- **Illinois 3 Relocation:** \$305.5 million for new construction of 4 miles, grading, paving, new bridges, drainage, retaining wall, new signing, land acquisition and utility adjustments from River Park Connector to Monsanto Avenue in Sauget.

WASHINGTON

- **I-64:** \$98.8 million for resurfacing 9.1 miles, including ramp repair, bridge joint replacement/repair, bridge deck overlay, new bridge deck and bridge deck repairs from Beaver Pond Creek to the Jefferson County line.
