






A collection like no other

It's been 12 years since IKEA first started collaborating with social businesses around the world.


Together, we develop unique, handmade products designed to create jobs for women and marginalised groups in regions where it's most needed.

Dream teamwork










Business as unusual



The MÄVINN makers

Today, IKEA works with 11 social businesses in six countries to create global products. They are united by their long-term efforts to create jobs for people far from the labour market. Five partners – from Bangladesh, India and Jordan – have contributed to this launch.



Rangsutra, India

Creates jobs, and develops handicraft traditions. The artisans, mainly women, are shareholders in the company and come from villages and small towns in the Uttar Pradesh area. Nearly 1 500 artisans are involved in handweaving and hand-embroidering products for IKEA at the Rangsutra centres.



SPUN, India

Creates jobs and offers handicraft technique training for rural women far from the labour market, thus strengthening the region overall. SPUN was initiated by the long-term and big IKEA supplier Welspun to take social responsibility in the rural areas where they operate.

Ramesh Flowers, India

Started with 5 people and has now passed 700 employees. Ramesh Flowers creates jobs for rural women through natural waste material production. That means creating handcrafted items from nuthell, bark, and more.

Classical Handmade Products, Bangladesh

Specialised in sustainable, handmade products using only garment waste and natural fibres such as jute and banana fibre. The production is located in rural areas, allowing families to stay in their home villages.

Jordan River Foundation, Jordan

Jordan River Foundation and IKEA started their partnership in 2017 as an urgent response to the Syrian war, when millions of refugees fled to neighbouring Jordan. The aim was, and is, to create jobs and increase integration between women refugees and local women artisans by turning to traditional handicraft skills.

Twelve years of collaboration



At IKEA, we believe there is no better route out of poverty than a decent job. That's why we, in 2012, began forming long-term partnerships with social enterprises worldwide, supporting them in their effort to provide work for people in vulnerable communities.

By connecting social businesses to the IKEA value chain, we aim to be an enabler for women's empowerment and for marginalised people to gain independence. And it's good business – IKEA gets the opportunity to offer customers unique, handcrafted products made by skilled artisans.


