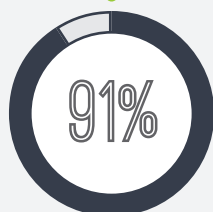

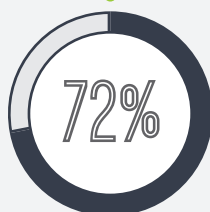

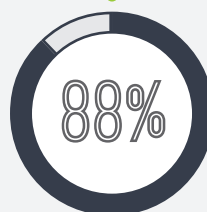

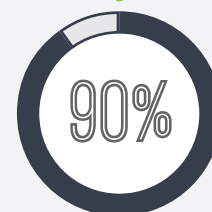

MAJOR DISTRICT HIGHWAY PROJECTS BY COUNTY

ADAMS

- **Quincy Memorial Bridge:** \$219 million for bridge replacement at Mississippi River at Quincy. Illinois is the lead agency; Missouri and Illinois will share these costs equally.
- **Illinois 96:** \$18.8 million for resurfacing 4.6 miles, new shoulders, bi-directional left turn lane and other improvements from south of State Street in Quincy to south of I-172.

HANCOCK

- **U.S. 136:** \$33 million for vertical realignment on 1.1 miles, bridge replacement, railroad crossing improvement and other improvements from the Mississippi River to Main Street in Hamilton.

LOGAN

- **I-55:** \$51 million for reconstruction of 3.8 miles from north of I-55 Business north of Lincoln to 1.9 miles north of Kickapoo Creek.

MACOUPIN

- **Illinois 111:** \$35.4 million for resurfacing 25.9 miles, bridge replacement, culvert replacement and ADA improvements from south of Sherman Street in Palmyra to the Jersey County line in Brighton.

MONTGOMERY

- **Illinois 16:** \$17.7 million for resurfacing 13.6 miles, ADA improvements, culvert replacement and other improvements from Miller Street in Schram City to south of Gibson Street in Nokomis.

PIKE

- **I-72:** \$147.7 million for resurfacing 28.5 miles, shoulder reconstruction, underdrain work, bridge deck repairs, bridge deck overlay and bridge joint replacement/repair from Illinois 96 to U.S. 54/Illinois 107.

SANGAMON

- **I-55:** \$125 million for additional lanes and reconstruction of 7.8 miles, including ramp repair, from Illinois 54/Sangamon Avenue in Springfield to 2.7 miles south of Illinois 123 in Williamsville.
- **I-55 Business/6th Street/5th Street:** \$22.5 million for reconstruction of 0.61 miles, intersection reconstruction, turning lanes, sidewalks, bikeway and utility adjustments from Stevenson Drive to Stanford Avenue in Springfield.
- **Illinois 97/125:** \$40 million for additional lanes and reconstruction of 2.2 miles, bridge replacement, intersection reconstruction and a new bridge from Illinois 97/125 to Old Covered Bridge Lane.
- **MacArthur Boulevard:** \$21 million for reconstruction of 1.5 miles, traffic signal replacement and ADA improvements from Wabash/Stanford Avenue to South Grand Avenue in Springfield.
