SKI THERAPY

Val Thorens needs no introduction: Val Tho', as the resort is commonly known, makes the ideal playground for skiing enthusiasts and anyone who loves the mountains. Located at 2,300 metres at the summit of the Vallée des Belleville, it is the highest resort in Europe and the highest point of the 3 Vallées ski area, the largest in the world with 600 km of linked-up slopes. And an added bonus? The entire resort is ski-in/ski-out which means the slopes are easy to reach no matter where you stay.

Val Tho' is a feast for the eyes, with the majestic Péclet glacier dominating the resort and creating a spectacular and almost unreal panoramic scene. As for the Cime Caron, the resort's highest peak at 3,195 metres, it is none other than "the most beautiful view in the Alps" according to the Michelin Green Guide, offering a 360° view of more than 1,000 summits of the French, Swiss and Italian Alps.

Famous for its top-quality snow and increasingly efficient ski lifts, Val Thorens offers unbeatable skiing in the best possible setting. Carving, off-piste, cross-country, snow park, fun slopes, boardercross and telemark skiing, there's something to suit every taste. The figures speak for themselves: an average snow depth of 6 metres in winter with more than 80% of slopes at elevations above 2,300 metres. Val Thorens offers excellent snow conditions during its 6-months ski season which is the longest in Europe.



VAL THORENS, THE FAVOURITE PLAYGROUND OF HIGH-LEVEL ATHLETES

Famous athletes have always chosen Val Thorens to enjoy the best possible training conditions for major events, be it a French or European championship, a world cup or even the Olympic Games. Thanks to its high elevation (between 2,300 and 3,200 metres), the guarantee of 6 months' snow cover and a diversity of high-quality installations, Val Thorens offers conditions conducive to high performance. Whatever the discipline, the benefits of training at altitude are a major advantage for high-level athletes for whom Val Thorens is the perfect place to oxygenate the blood.



PERFORMANCE-INDUCING INSTALLATIONS

Equipped with three slalom courses and a ski-cross course, Val Thorens hosts multiple races and competitions year after year, including world cup and FIS events, Eurotests and ESF technical trials, French championships and so on. The slalom courses here are among the most in-demand of the Alps because of the quality of the snow cover and the mixed orientation of the ski area offering variety and top quality for 6 months of the year. During the 22/23 season, more than 110 ESF races and 74 official races were held in Val Thorens, in addition to training sessions of various national and international clubs, including the French downhill team and the national teams of Belgium, the Netherlands, Denmark and Ireland.

NEW – PARTNERSHIP WITH THE CHAMBÉRY SAVOIE MONT BLANC HANDBALL CLUB

The Chambéry Savoie Mont Blanc Handball Club has been playing at the highest professional level for over 20 years and Val Thorens is its chosen partner and hypoxic training centre. After a 4-day course in July 2023, the staff and players will now return regularly to Europe's highest resort - both in summer and winter - in order to be fully prepared for the sporting challenges that lie ahead.



VAL THORENS, LAND OF CHAMPIONS

As historic figures of the world ski racing scene, Marielle Goitschel and her sister, Christine, the dazzling French skiing duo who won medals at the 1964 Olympic Games in Innsbruck, are both part of the Val Thorens adventure. In 1987, Marielle created the first Snow Academy to teach children to ski in an amusing and effective way. In her view, "There's nothing like the slopes of Val Tho".

More recently, two young local residents put Val Thorens under the Olympic spotlight: Jean-Frédéric Chapuis, ski-cross gold medal winner at the 2014 Winter Olympics in Sotchi, and Chloé Trespeuch, boardercross bronze medallist in Sotchi and runner-up at the Beijing Winter Olympics of 2022.

Another local figure, Adrien Théaux, also benefited from the assets of this Savoie resort. Originally from the Pyrenees, he earned his stripes at Val Thorens ski club and has now been a member of the French downhill skiing team for 10 years.

CHLOÉ TRESPEUCH A SLOPE NAMED AFTER CHAMPION

"It's an honour to have a slope named after me in my favour ite ski area, where I grew up, from my first snowplough to my Olympic goals."

At the age of 29, Chloé Trespeuch already has a long list of wins: eight years after her bronze medal at Sotchi in 2014, she was snowboard-cross runner-up at the 2022 Winter Olympics in Beijing, and is second in the world rankings this season. She has been a member of the Val Thorens club since the age of 6 when she began on skis but soon switched to snowboarding. She joined the French snowboard team in 2009 and very quickly achieved results that promised her a shining career in this discipline. Val Thorens could only honour its 'smiley' ambassador by opening a slope that bears her name in the resort where she "learned, fell, progressed, doubted and loved".







AGNÈS & DORINE GIRARD — THE VAL THO' SPIRIT THROUGH THE GENERATIONS





Nature escape at lac du lou

For an authentic adventure in the wild, get away from the resort and visit Lac du Lou for a revitalising break and forget about the world. This is the ultimate spot in Val Tho' to escape into the wilderness for a breath of fresh air in the world's biggest ski area. On the edge of the Vanoise National Park, Lac du Lou, which freezes over in winter, can be found in a vast, untouched plain that stretches between the Cime Caron and Pointe de la Masse peaks. This site makes a majestic playground for divers, hikers and anyone who loves nature and the great outdoors.

It takes a little effort to reach this lovely nature spot, accessible neither by car nor by the ski lift which is the whole point of choosing this adventure. When you set off for Lac du Lou, your sense of escape is total, from the moment you begin the journey. This can be done on snowshoes, cross-country skis or via certain off-piste itineraries.

By offering pedestrian lift passes, visitors can get an instant highmountain experience and admire the panoramic view from the top of the Cime Caron, 3,200 metres above sea level. Once at the top, it's just a 45-minute ride down to Val Thorens, to arrive in the heart of the resort together with luggage.

Opened last winter, the brand new sports and leisure centre, Le Board, is a real asset for corporate events. Located in the centre of the resort, this $17,000~\text{m}^2$ venue contains leisure and wellness facilities, a conference centre with multiple meeting rooms, a coworking room and, above all, an extraordinary rooftop area. Never before seen in a ski resort, this panoramic roof terrace accommodates up to 2,400~people which makes it the perfect venue to organise all sorts of ambitious projects and unique events, from fun and games to sports meetings, incentive events to concerts and so on. The indoor facilities can also accommodate events of every kind, in the Auditorium (437 seats), the Arena (3,000~people), the lounge area ($166~\text{m}^2$) and the function room ($281~\text{m}^2$), which are all modular and can be adapted to clients' needs.



Designed to help organisations in all sectors, this ISO standard sets out practical means of reducing energy consumption and boosting efficiency by implementing an energy management system (EMS).


Measures already taken

In Val Thorens, an internal organisation has therefore been set up to help constantly improve performance in terms of the environment:

- Removal of second lifts where only one is needed.
- Eco-driving training for ski-lift and snow-groomer operators.
- Insulation of all buildings (walls and frames), including those on the ski slopes.
- Smart heating in all buildings which controls the maximum temperature and cuts out when doors and windows are open, and at night wherever heating isn't absolutely necessary.
- Recovery of waste heat from installation engines and converters.
- A roll-out programme for solar heating and photovoltaic panels.
- A hydroelectric power plant project.
- Geothermal energy systems for new buildings.
- Finest possible artificial snow management, based on a snow-cover gauging device fitted to snow groomers.
- Replacement of the resort's diesel fleet with GTL vehicles (Gas To Liquid which is synthetic diesel free from fine particles and sulphur dioxide).









A MORE ECO-FRIENDLY TOURISM AND LIFESTYLE

In keeping with strategic measures taken for the Flocon Vert certification, the village of Les Belleville is implementing specific actions to reconcile tourism with protection of the mountains and energy frugality.

The Espace Propriétaires/SEM Rénov and the local council's Sustainable Development Department have joined forces in a large-scale awareness campaign based on various tools that aim to encourage mountain residents, businesses and holidaymakers to appreciate the necessity for a change in behaviour and to adopt more eco-friendly practices.

In addition, in response to a call for expression of interest launched by the French government for its Plan Avenir Montagne, the council has created detailed architectural guidelines to ensure building and renovation projects comply with current local planning. This is the outcome of a long process to retrace the history and evolution of the region's architecture and facilitate energy transition for jointly-owned properties.


Alongside this policy and the technological innovations deployed, life at the resort revolves around more eco-friendly and responsible practices. On arrival in the semi-pedestrianised resort, holidaymakers and residents move around only on skis, on foot or by bus.

TECHNOLOGY TO SERVE ECOLOGY

As a pioneer and leader when it comes to digital transformation, the resort covers every sector in its implementation of technology-based innovations that serve both people and the environment:

- Smart slope preparation thanks to the snow groomers embedded with Snowsat GPS system has already reduced engine fuel consumption by 8% and snow production by 15%.
- Unique in France, Data Montagne is a specialised software solution for optimal management of mountain water resources. In the face of the issues of reconciling human consumption with the needs of snow cannons and other uses, this system enhances water management.





Innovative by nature, Val Thorens benefits from the expertise of its staff and, above all, their enthusiasm when it comes to developing technology in the interests of the safety, comfort and wellbeing of holidaymakers. Innovation abounds in these truly connected mountains: Snowsat, mapping system, GPS beacons for locating the ski patrol, drones that watch over the ski area... Val Thorens is a pioneer in this field.



A DRONE TO MONITOR THE SKI AREA, A EUROPEAN FIRST

Fitted with two cameras, one that uses thermal imaging, the other with a 180X zoom lens, the drone allows rapid detection of avalanches or other search zones where the situation has to be assessed in order to deploy the right operational or rescue strategy.

SNOWSAT. FOR SMARTER SNOW-GROOMING

A technology at the heart of sustainable, ethical tourism, Snowsat is fitted to all snow groomers. The software includes embedded GPS connected to a map of the ski area to then provide real-time information on the depth of snow cover on the slopes. This technology is also linked up to the snow-making canons which then operate automatically and intelligently to produce snow in a targeted manner.

SKI FLUX. THE WAZE OF THE SKI SLOPES

Real-time information about skier numbers on the slopes? This is possible in Val Thorens thanks to the new Ski Flux system which keeps skiers informed in real time! Unique in France, this system measures the flow of skiers via sensors located on the slopes and allows users to choose their itinerary accordingly.

GPS BEACONS. FOR GREATER EFFICIENCY

Responsiveness and performance are the watchwords behind this innovation! In Val Tho', every member of the ski patrol is equipped with a GPS beacon and radio, providing an efficient means of locating them and sending the nearest patroller to the zone where assistance is required.


Key projects for the future

THE CAIRN ECO-DISTRICT

Again with a view to innovation and development, Val Thorens plans to create an eco-district in an urbanised wilderness called the Cairn Plateau. The aim of this project is to boost winter tourism and develop summer activities, but also to support renewable energy and enable the construction of new housing for both permanent and seasonal residents.

THE CIME CARON SUMMIT
