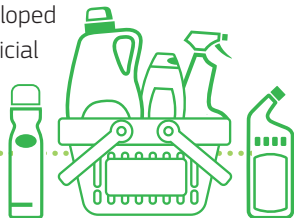


SMALL CHOICES MAKE A BIG IMPACT

Over **54 000 products and services** hold an EU Ecolabel by complying with a set of environmental criteria developed by experts, and verified by official bodies in Member States.



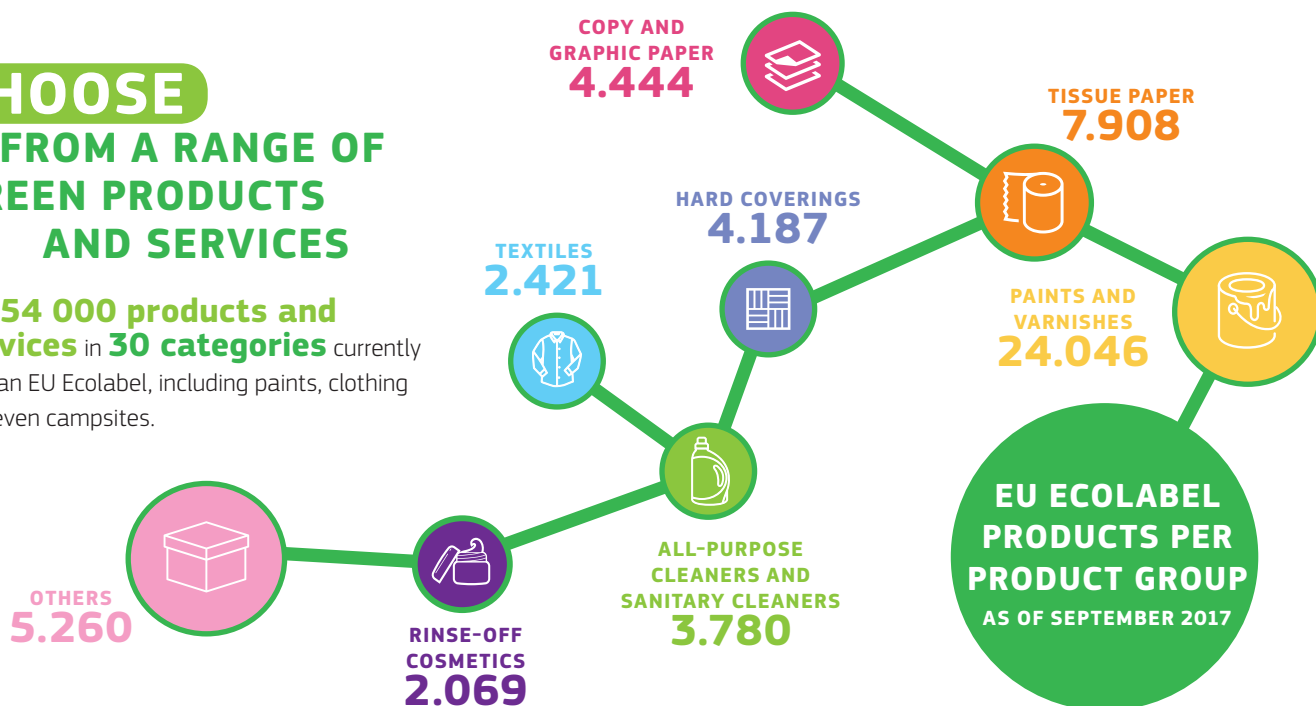
HOW IS THE EU ECOLABEL AWARDED?

- 1** The EU Ecolabel is a voluntary scheme. Products or services that have a reduced impact on the environment are eligible, as long as criteria for this type of product or service have been set.
- 2** Each product or service is tested against these criteria, developed with the entire life cycle of the product in mind by independent academics, scientists and experts.
- 3** The criteria are revised periodically to ensure that products and services have the most up-to-date stamp of **environmental approval**.

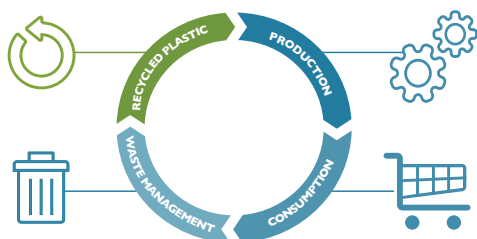
