The extended Budget 2016 coverage will continue with Leigh Sales and Chris Uhlmann on ABC News 24 from 8.40-9.30pm AEST. This special extended broadcast will include interviews with Greens Leader, Richard Di Natale and Independent Senator, Nick Xenophon. There will be a full recap of the Budget's key points, as well as further analysis about how it affects you in this election year.

Grand Designs

This new series of Grand Designs features a diverse range of properties, including one of the biggest builds featured so far; the transformation of a derelict cowshed; a rusty 'floating' barn, and a giant fortress of a house on the beach on the Isle of Wight. There's an outback-style house on the marshes of East Sussex, and a sweeping curved straw-bale conversion of an old forge for a family in County Antrim. And there's a damp, dark cave in the Wyre Forest transformed into a home fit for 21st century living.

Clinton is attempting to build one of the largest homes ever featured on Grand Designs – a design inspired by the 1920s Barcelona Pavilion by the architect Mies van der Rohe. The Letdown tells the story of a struggling new mum and the local Mothers Group she thinks she doesn't need. It stars Alison Bell, Noni Hazlehurst, Lucy Durak, Sacha Horler, Leah Vandenberg, Celeste Barber, Taylor Ferguson, Ewen Leslie and Leon Ford with special guest appearances by Patrick Brammall and Brendan Cowell.

Audrey (Alison Bell) is a modern, first time mum for whom motherhood is proving a difficult transition. Determined not to be defined by her new role, she attempts to carry on as normal.

Against her better judgment she attends the local Mothers Group.

Here, she meets an unsympathetic Maternal health nurse (Noni Hazlehurst) and five very different, very hormonal women (and one man) each with their own set of judgments and opinions – some naïve, some passive aggressive, others just plain aggressive. The group includes; Martha, a 39 year old, last chance, stoic single mum; Ester, the Mother in denial workaholic; Ruben, her enthusiastic stay at home Dad; Sophie, the neglected trophy wife; Barbara, the straight talking, super relaxed, mother of three; and Jenna, the sweet smiling, judgmental hippie.

Desperate to reclaim her old life and attend best friend Emma's, birthday dinner, Audrey is let down by her unreliable support team. Husband, Jeremy (Ewan Leslie), has to travel interstate for work; her mother, the far from doting grandmother, contrives an excuse; and the sitter she finds on Facebook falls short of "ideal first babysitter" expectations.

Eventually, Audrey realises she may be in the market for a new support team, her sanity might just depend on it. Back to the Mothers Group she goes.

Trillion Dollar Island

Thousands of kilometres away from the United Kingdom lies a secretive slice of Britain; a small sun-soaked Caribbean paradise - the Cayman Islands.

Watched over by a governor appointed from London, the Caymans are well and truly British, but with one big difference: no-one seems to be paying a penny of tax! Not locals. Not expats. Not big global corporations. And thanks to this tax-free status, Cayman has built a finance industry that's brought one and a half trillion pounds into its banks. There are twice as many companies registered in the Caymans as there are people.

Growing increasingly impatient with the Commission's lack of results, the Attorney General, Lincoln Priest (Philip Quast) gives Janet an ultimatum: resign as Royal Commissioner or have her reputation ruined by the State Corruption Commission.

Janet refuses, but fortuitously for her, they quickly solve Todd Wilson's murder - a tragedy of errors involving Simon Hamilton (Aaron Jeffrey), Robbie (Josef Ber), Jane Carter, and a 3D-printed handgun.
