## Dream Gardens

Mother Nature can be your best friend, but she can also be your worst enemy. Stewart and Sandra Hart lost their home, garden and wonderful memories in the devastating Black Saturday bushfires of 2009.

Rather than face the painful process of rebuilding, the Harts bought a property in a bucolic, country valley an hour's drive from Melbourne. In search of inspiration for the garden, they visited Stonefields, the home of Paul Bangay, one of Australia's most in demand designers. Blown away by its beauty and idyllic setting they've tasked Paul with the job of recreating his magic in their own back yard.



The design is grand and ambitious with a focus on opening up the garden to the valley beyond and framing classic Australian views with well over a thousand plants and trees. As a tribute to the property's heritage Sandra and Stewart have salvaged some of the old garden's plants and challenged Paul to incorporate these into the plans.

The icing on the cake is a spectacular swimming pool: a source of water for their future bushfire prevention strategy and a place in which their grandkids can enjoy long summer days.

This is a story of regeneration and reward.

## My Year 12 Life

At the start of 2016, the ABC and Princess Pictures launched an unprecedented television experiment. After scouring the country and watching hundreds of auditions, they gave cameras to a diverse group of 14 teenagers to film the most dramatic 12 months of their lives – Year 12.

The resulting ‘vlogumentary’ series is packed with emotion, hilarity, heartbreak and suspense – what will their Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) numbers be? What will they go through to achieve these results?



Pioneering a new form of storytelling, there were no film crews, nor producers on the ground, just 14 teenagers self-documenting their stories straight to camera in their own way. The resulting footage captures the raw drama of their final year of school, and reminds us how pivotal Year 12 is, what the future looks like at 18, and shines a light on how this has changed over the years.

Inspired by the serious stress the ATAR is putting on kids, this series aims to start a national conversation about the pressures of Year 12 and explores how our education system prepares young people to enter further studies or the workforce.

In each episode the students talk about the issues they’re facing, including the pressure of the impending ATAR exams– and how they feel this will define their future; parental, cultural and school pressures; body image; stress and anxiety; and school and social life balance. The vlog diaries give the students an avenue to vent about these issues – their honest, candid, often humorous, and sometimes heartbreaking confessions will hit a nerve with all viewers.

ABC is offering My Year 12 Life across its on-air and digital platforms allowing viewers the opportunity to watch the series on a platform that best suits them:

Meet 14 students as they learn to document themselves going through their final year of high school through daily video diaries. From Sydney to the Kimberley, and everywhere in between, the stresses of this launch-pad year start on day one as they delve into the pressures of the big score they will receive at the end of the year – the ATAR.

**Episode two: Tuesday, February 21 at 7.30pm on ABC ME**

The countdown has begun with 36 weeks until final exams. Tom is finding it hard to make it to school on time juggling two jobs, photography expeditions and late nights but resolves to perfect a side flip. Charlie is stressed about passing his drivers' licence and Trianna feels the pressure of falling behind in subjects at her competitive school. Meanwhile, Shianna grapples with dropping modern history and raves about the injustice of creative subjects being marked down.

**Episode three: Wednesday, February 22 at 7.30pm on ABC ME**

With 33 weeks until final exams, the pressures of juggling school, family and a social life set in. Alfie knows he must curb his party-going ways if he's going to please his Mum but is finding study a challenge. Zoe struggles with the demands of homework and the need to move between her parent's houses. Kayla is stressed over an increasing workload and arguments with Mum but receives a terrific gift and Ben gets excited about his 18th birthday celebrations.

## Ice Wars

Australia has a problem with Crystal Methamphetamine. Street name: Ice.

*Ice Wars* is a four-part series exploring the fall out and community response to one of the most popular and dangerous drugs of our time, crystal methamphetamine, also known as ice. The program makers had unprecedented access to NSW Police front line operations in metropolitan as well as rural and remote communities. The program reveals the scale and scope of the challenges facing law enforcement, health workers, users, families, and the community as they grapple to mitigate the effects of ice use in Australia.

## Mountjoy Prison

This eye-opening, four-part documentary series follows the day-to-day activities of the governors, prison officers and inmates in Ireland's largest prison, the Mountjoy Campus in Dublin. Nicknamed 'The Joy', the campus comprises four main facilities and houses more than 750 male and female prisoners, convicted of everything from white-collar crime, drugs offences and robbery to violence, manslaughter and murder.

The Joy is home to a large number of gangs and rival factions. We spend time in D Wing with those inmates who have to be kept away from the main prison population for their safety, and that of others. With unprecedented access to both the campus and the most hardened criminals over a six-eight-month period, *Mountjoy Prison* shows moments of heartbreak, humanity and humour. It also provides an absorbing look at life behind bars and reveals the shocking truth of what it's like to serve time in prison.

In episode one, "City Within A City", day-to-day routine is interrupted by an extremely violent prisoner who is being moved to a specially-modified cell. Meanwhile, with one wing closed for refurbishment, Mountjoy Campus Governor Brian Murphy is faced with a prison that's dangerously close to overcrowding. James, a prisoner on C-Wing, is hoping for a transfer to the Training Unit, a semi-open facility within the complex, but first he has to prove that he is completely drug-free. Over in Mountjoy West, where mostly protection prisoners are housed, the massive drug problem on D-wing is getting out of control and management has a tough decision to make.
