

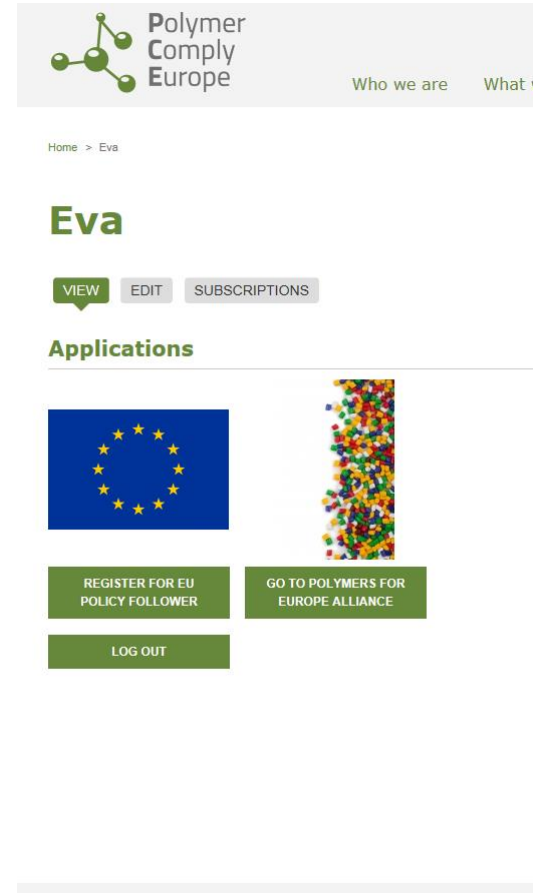



**Abstract**

The European Commission is set to review implementation of Directive 2004/35/EC on liability for environmental damage in the course of 2014. A Report will follow this review and may be accompanied by legislative proposals if deemed necessary. Under Dir. 2004/35/EC Member States must report to the EC on the implementation of the Directive by 30 April 2013. The EC will begin drafting its Report following the submission of national reports and its Report may be accompanied by legislative proposals in late 2013. To support this Report, the Commission has launched a study on the implementation of the Environmental Liability Directive and feasibility on fund to cover environmental liability. This study is due to be completed in 2013 and will feed into the overall Report. The study on "the implementation challenges and obstacles of the Environmental Liability Directive (ELD)" has been made available at LINK <http://eldimplement.bios.com/documents>. The results of this study will feed into the Commission Report reviewing the implementation of the Environmental Liability Directive (Directive 2004/35/EC) to be presented in 2014. The study was due to be discussed by Member State experts during a meeting of the Environmental Liability Directive (ELD) government experts group on 10 June 2013. The Report is now expected to be presented by 30 April 2014. The Report is expected to be presented by 30 April 2014. National experts are scheduled to discuss the expected Report on the implementation of the Environmental Liability Directive (ELD) at a meeting to take place on 3 February 2014. This meeting will see an exchange of views on the expected Commission Report before its adoption. The Commission has postponed the publication of this Report until after the 2015 summer recess.
