A Chartered Accountant from the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales, she also holds further professional qualifications in banking and taxation. Ms Goh is also a Fellow of the Singapore Institute of Chartered Accountants and the Singapore Institute of Directors.

Ms Goh held various senior management positions in Standard Chartered Bank, travelling widely throughout the Group's operations in the course of her duties. Following her retirement, she has held non-executive appointments on various boards including Deputy Chairman and Senior Independent Director of Royal Dutch Shell plc, DBS Holdings Ltd, DBS Bank Ltd, Singapore Airlines Limited, Aviva plc, Singapore Exchange Limited, CapitaLand Limited, MediaCorp Pte Ltd, Standard Chartered Bank Thai pcl, Standard Chartered Bank Malaysia Berhad and Singapore Health Services Pte Ltd. She is the former Chairman of DBS Foundation, Singapore International Foundation, International Enterprise Singapore and Accounting Standards Council, Singapore as well as a former board member of Temasek Trustees Pte Ltd, and former member of the Management Advisory Board of the NUS Business School and former Rector of Cinnamon College.

Ms Goh was named as Her World Woman of the Year 2005. She was awarded a Public Service Medal in that same year and a Public Service Star in 2012.
